

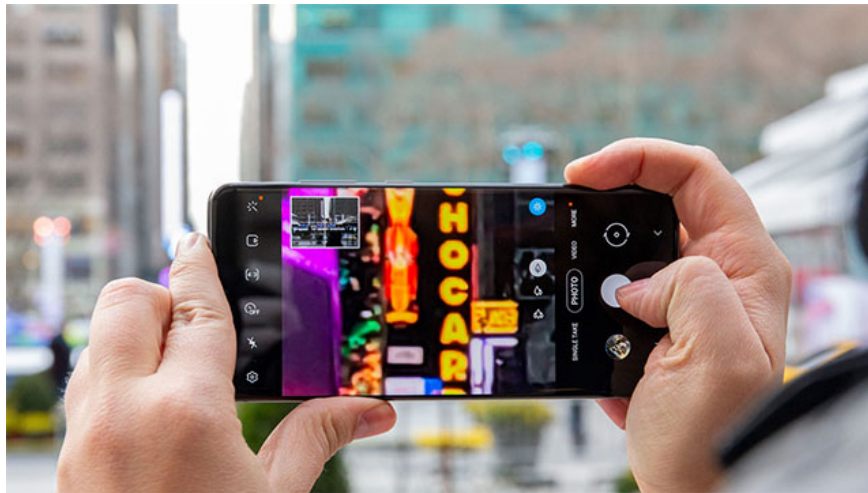
Some advanced Galaxy S20 features are about to be updated for Galaxy S10 and Note10

Quick Share: This is a content sharing feature developed by Samsung, inspired by AirDrop on iOS, that allows users to share photos, videos and extremely large files directly and seamlessly with Many Samsung users are around via Wi-Fi connection.

Music Sharing: True to its name, this feature will allow people around you to make the most of Bluetooth connectivity on your phone to stream music to paired connected speakers and headphones, so you will not have to disconnect before friends can play music.

As planned, Samsung will start rolling out the above features to Galaxy S10 and Galaxy Note10 users worldwide starting from April here as software updates. However, the actual update time will depend on the region.
