However, like some previous versions of Apple's operating system, OS X Lion still suffers from a number of frequent problems for users. In the following article, we will show you how to fix some of these problems.

Do not boot from DVD:

In this announcement, Apple decided to apply only download mode if users want to install Mac OS X Lion, but for many people or system models there are many computers that want to upgrade the operating system in the state. The speed of normal or slow Internet connection can still be applied below to boot - boot from DVD by applying the following method. First, we must download the Lion installer section from the Mac App Store (note that this step only needs to be done once):



After finishing this process, do not run the **Installer** file, otherwise we will not be able to create **Disk Image** in the next step. After that, connect a prepared USB flash drive or portable hard drive (at least **4GB of free space**), and copy the downloaded installation file to the computer here. When finished, remove the device's connection with the computer, but before you proceed with the upgrade, you should back up your old operating system with Time Machine support tool in case of a risk. :

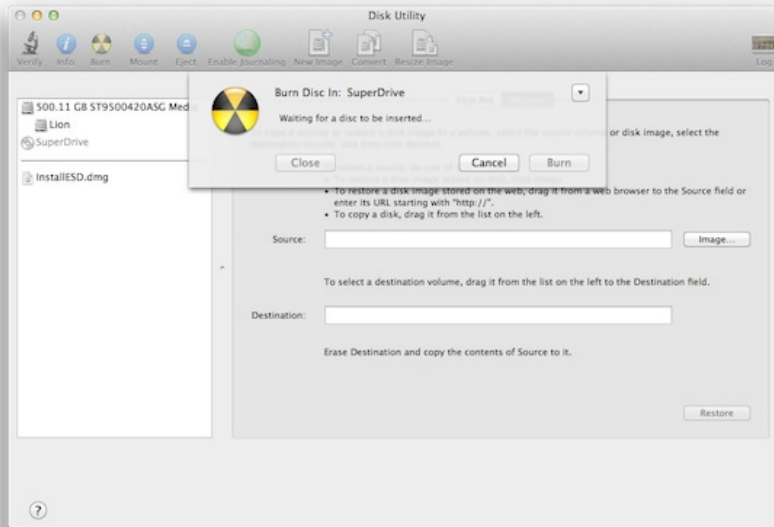


When this backup process is complete, we will continue with the main task - Lion upgrade. Drag the installation package into the **Applications** folder of the device to proceed, double-click here to start:



And you just need to follow the instructions shown on the screen

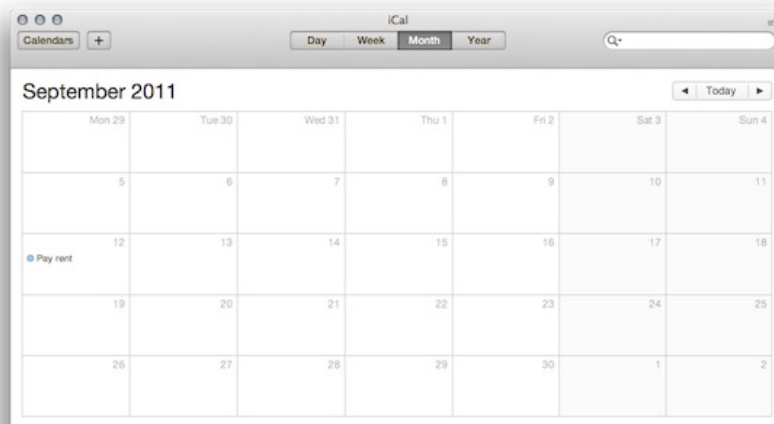
On the other hand, after completing a backup of the **Snow Leopard** system, open the **Mac App Store** and buy Lion's license. But before installing, open the Applications folder of Mac, right-click on Lion's installation file:



Select **Show Package Contents** and open the **Shared Support** folder, where we will see the image file named **InstallESD.dmg** - this is Lion's image file, copy this file to the Desktop. Start the **Disk Utility** , click the **Burn** button and when the system displays the process confirmation message, select the **InstallESD.dmg** file from the Desktop and burn it to DVD.

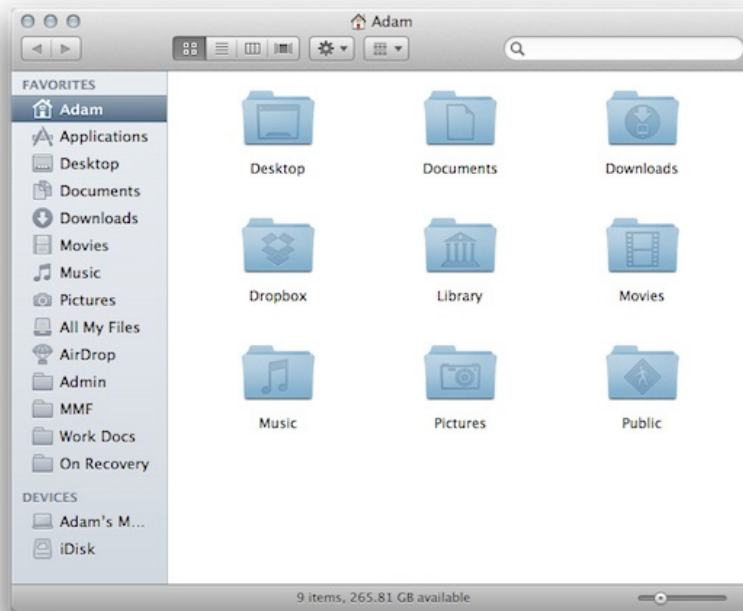
Interface of iCal and Address Book:

Until now, the effects of Lion have been undeniable, in terms of both technology and graphical interface, it is clear that Apple's progress is extremely solid. But there are still some minor problems, the appearance of **iCal** and **Address Book** is one of those problems.



However, you can use MacNix support tool to change the interface of iCal to be the same as the screenshot above, but you need to pay attention to backup the program before proceeding to prevent risk.

Finder issue:



Up to this point, Finder has not been able to get out of Apple's system, although its features sometimes go beyond the control of many users, for example, they cannot lock some folders, Library, cannot see the total remaining space . To restore access to the Library as usual, open Terminal and type the following command:

```
chflags nohidden ~ / Library /
```

If you want to check the volume of the partition, just open a new **Finder** window and select **View> Show Status Bar**.

Trackpad actions:

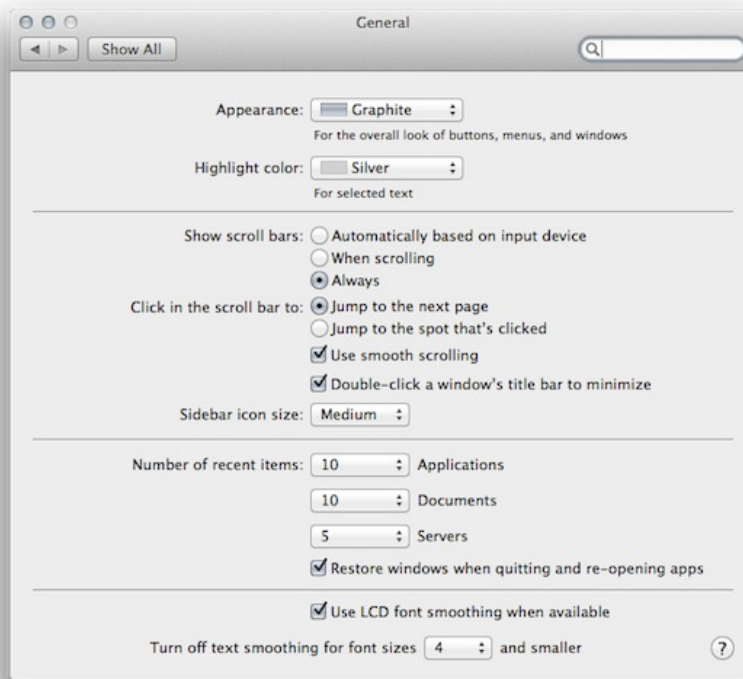


Next, the controversial change of Mac OS X Lion is to completely change Trackpad's original information processing. Most of these problems can be changed or fixed with just a few operations or Terminal commands, but with Trackpad it is not easy because this is a multi-touch processor. All you need to do is open **System Preferences > Trackpad > Scroll & Zoom > Scroll Direction: Natural**, then uncheck this box. Besides, you can refer and use Better Touch Tool support tool.

Compatibility of applications:

Along with the appearance of the Lion version this time, the developers will have to try harder to 'catch up' Lion. For sure, you should refer to the list of OS X Lion support programs here.

Scrollbar bar:



Similar to **Trackpad** , changes in the **Scrollbar** section bring no less hassle to users. And to change it, you just need to select **System Preferences > General** and change **Show Scroll Bars settings** to **Always** .

Arrange Mission Control:

Most Mac OS users use Spaces, and they do not like the way the operating system 'decides' the Desktop itself to organize programs or applications. To change it, open **System Preferences -> Mission Control** and uncheck the **Automatically rearrange spaces** box **based on most recent use**.
