Sony has introduced 2 Ultrabook touch screen Vaio T series of 14 inches and 15 inches at CES 2013. Sony has now allowed to order these two products through its stores.

The technology page of *Endgadget* offers a clear picture showing us the price, parameters and timing of the two models of this ultrabook. Vaio T15 has 15.5 inch touch screen with 1920x1080 px resolution, owns Intel Core CPU i3-3227U, i5-3337U or i7-3537U at a price of 770 USD (about 16.1 million VND), 950 USD (about 19 , VND 9 million) and USD 1150 (about VND 24.1 million) respectively CPU configuration.

The Vaio T15 is also equipped with integrated Intel HD 4000 graphics, HDMI port, USB 3.0 port and DVD read / write drive. Core i3 model has 4GB RAM and 500GB HDD + 24GB SSD hybrid hard drive. The Core i5 model has 6GB of RAM and a similar hybrid hard drive on the Core i3 model. A high-end T15 model is equipped with 8GB of RAM and a 256GB SSD drive, Blu-ray optical drive at a price of \$ 1400 (about 29.4 million dong).

Meanwhile, Vaio T14 model owns 14-inch touch screen 1366x768 px resolution, Core i5-3337U CPU, 6GB RAM, 500GB + 24GB hybrid hard drive, DVD read / write drive, integrated Intel HD 4000 graphics , HDMI port, USB 3.0 port.

This model is sold for 900 USD (about 18.9 million VND) but of course you can fully customize the configuration (or choose T15) depending on your preferences and financial conditions. Sony will deliver the product to customers on February 19.
