

Sony launched the TWS WF-SP800N headset with IP55 waterproof and active noise canceling, priced at \$ 200

Battery life is also the strength of this pair of headphones, can be up to 26 hours.

Sony has recently added another option to its collection of complete wireless headsets (TWS), the **WF-SP800N** pair . This will be a direct upgrade of the WF-SP700N pair that was launched in 2018 with dust and water resistance, especially active noise cancellation ANC.



Like its predecessor, the WF-SP800N is designed to be aimed at people who exercise or sport, so there is an extra ear cup to hold onto the user's ears and cannot be dropped even if the user is active. How strong. We also have IP55 waterproof and dustproof, upgraded compared to the IPX4 standard of the WF-SP700N.



The powerful active noise cancellation technology from the high-end WF-1000xm3 will also be fitted to the SP800N, helping to eliminate unwanted background noise for a quieter listening space. In terms of battery life, the pair can play up to 9 hours of noise-canceling music (up to 13 if ANC is turned off), the charging box provides an additional 18 hours of noise-canceling (and up to 26 hours when noise canceling is turned off), included Accordingly, the ability to quickly charge 10 minutes to continue listening to music 1 hour.



In terms of sound, the SP800N will have the same processor chip as the high-end WF-1000xm3, but the final sound will be more bass-based because these headphones belong to Sony's eXtra Bass product line. We will have basic Bluetooth CODECs like SBC and AAC, without apt-X, apt-X HD or LDAC.

Sony WF-SP800N will be available in 3 colors: blue, orange and red, sold for \$ 200.
