First, you choose and open any video on YouTube. Choose the right time you want to share:

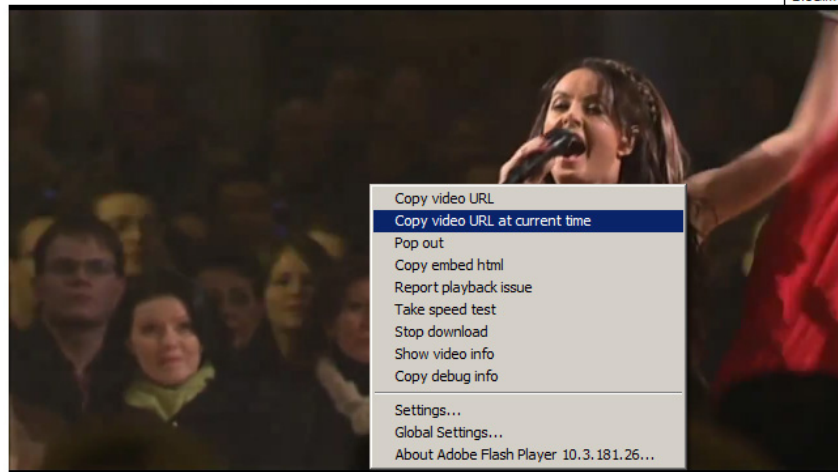


Right-click the displayed time bar and select **Copy Video URL at Current Time:**
