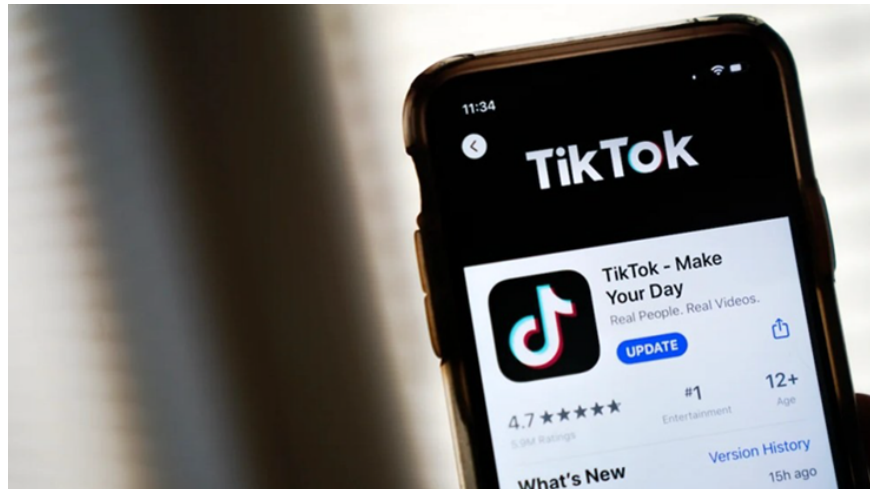


Spectacular revival: TikTok returns to App Store and Google Play after ban
