

Speed ??up Internet connection

In this article, we introduce some simple but quite effective methods to speed up your Internet connection.

1. Firewalls

Block programs that connect to the Internet (such as WinAmp player, one of the programs will automatically check for updates). You might be surprised at the number of applications that want to make connections to the Internet in this way. If you are interested, you can also get Windows Explorer to connect to the Internet; After observing the IP at first you will probably think it is a Trojan, but the truth is not.

2. Browse without photos

Set up your Internet browser so that your browser does not download or display images while browsing, this will help you open pages faster, allowing you to read articles and blogs without waiting up to a few minutes to load all images on that page. You can do this in Microsoft Internet Explorer and Firefox or other popular browsers. In Microsoft's IE, you can do this setting by going to **Tools / Internet Options / Advance Tab / Show Pictures;** then cancel the option.

3. Download Manager

Find a program with a **resume** option - continue after stopping. Resume options are a great feature to allow you to continue downloading a file even if your connection is down while downloading. Some download links are not direct links, so they do not support resume. In which **RapidShare** and **Megaupload** are hosting providers that do not provide direct links.

4. Cache

Do not delete your cache frequently or should not leave it without deleting it ever. So your cache will easily save up to GB of data, so they can slow down the connection.

5. Switch to high-speed connections

Another problem with speeding up your Internet access is to stop using dial-up connections. Upgrading your current Internet connection is the best way to optimize and speed up your connection. It's probably not necessary to mention dial-up connections today, but it might still exist if you live in remote areas. The best way is to ask people around to find a way to replace the dial-up connection with a faster connection like DSL or fiber optic if available.
