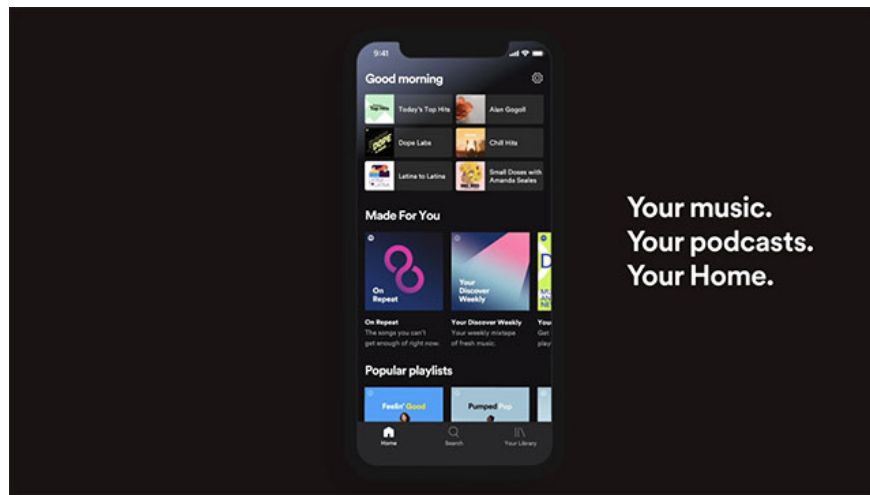


Spotify has a new home screen interface, making it easy for users to find their favorite content
