A site showing great bonuses will get lots of traffic, this makes it appealing to advertisers that will then pay for the website so display their ad. Every time someone clicks the ad

or completes a pre-defined action, the bonus code site receives revenue.

## **There are different types of bonuses you can get from using casino bonus codes...**

### **Deposit bonus**

Deposit bonuses are an appealing and popular option for users of online casinos, they are most commonly used by new users trying out a particular casino for the first time.

With this type of code, when a new player makes a new deposit for the first time the casino operator may match that amount or contribute some more on top of the amount placed in the account. There are other types of bonuses that bonus codes may give you access to, but these two are by far the most common ones you will find across promo sites. When using these codes, make sure that you understand any time limits, wagering rules and which games are actually included in the deal.

The best way to make sure that you and your money is safe when playing online casino games is to only use websites that are fully licenced. If they are operating in the United Kingdom or available to UK players, then they must be licensed by the UK Gambling Commission.

Licensed websites will display the correct logos and accreditations to help customers identify that they are safe to use. You should also take note of the ways in which cash is deposited and withdrawn on the site.

Many sites will allow you to use payment providers such as PayPal, Skrill and Visa. These can help you make secure and recorded transactions.
