

Spyware detected behind Opera

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According to Trend Micro's security vendor on July 15, they have just discovered a case of the malware called **TSPY_FAREIT.ACU** , which has expired Opera certificate. Similar to what Opera just announced.

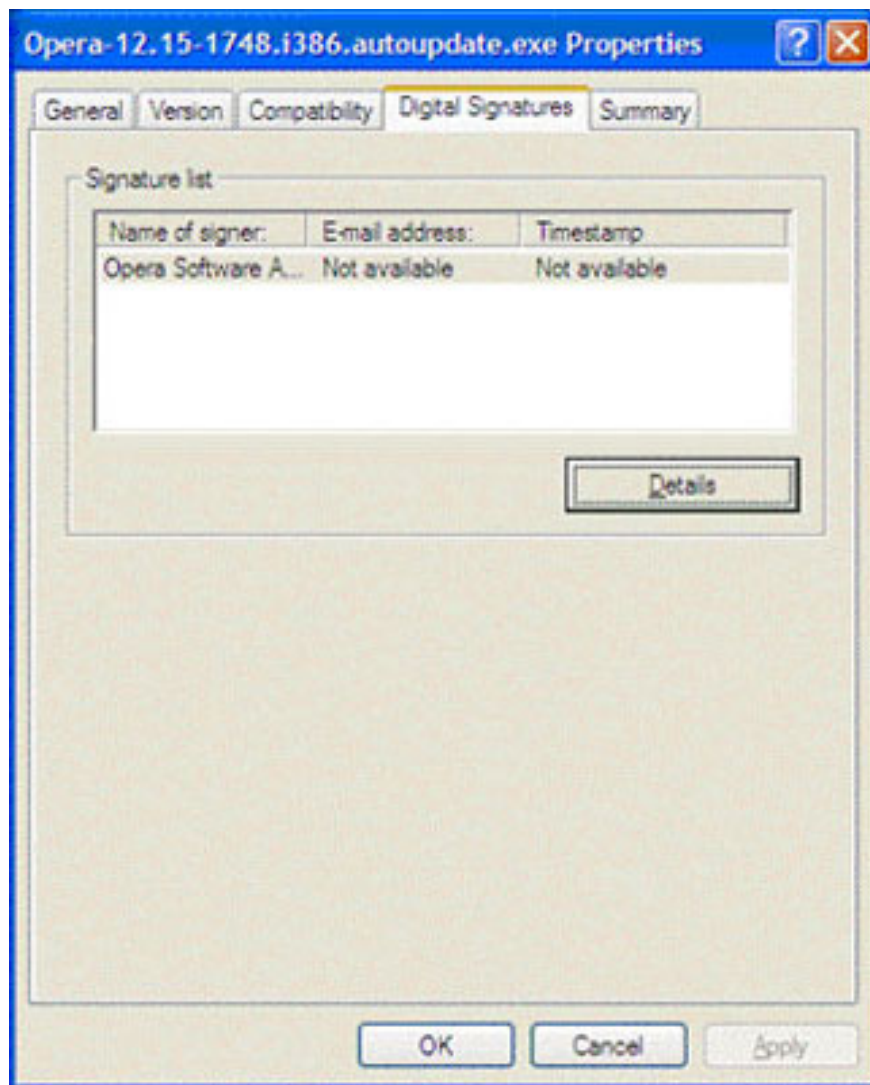


Photo of Opera's digital certificate has been stolen - *(Photo: Trend Micro)*

Once opened, **TSPY_FAREIT.ACU** will steal important information when users use the FTP protocol or file managers.

In addition, **TSPY_FAREIT.ACU** also collects more information from Internet browsers (**Mozilla Firefox** , **Google Chrome** and **Opera**). These data are usually login information to social networks, banks and e-commerce websites .

Opera announced it would soon release a new update to its web browser to fix the flaw.

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
