In a brief report released earlier today, Stack Overflow has reportedly recorded an attack that led hackers to successfully access their production systems.

The website Stack Overflow is still in the online state and some public details have been provided by the system security team in a press release, stating that "some unauthorized access acts The production system, carried out on May 11, was recorded. " However, the identity of the attackers has yet to be revealed.

User data is completely unaffected

It is still unclear how unauthorized intruders can access the internal network of Stack Overflow. However, measures to control the situation have been implemented quickly immediately after detecting violations. At the same time, the security team Stack Overflow said it had patched all the vulnerabilities recorded to limit the risk to the maximum.

The case is detected internally on this site, and the initial review is without any customer or user data being affected.

'Customer safety is always our top priority. This is once again proved through the last incident. I would be pleased to announce absolutely no instances of user data affected by the attack. We will provide more details immediately after the end of the investigation, "said Mary Ferguson, deputy technical director at Stack Overflow.
