

Star Fox was unexpectedly announced.

At the recent Nintendo Direct event, Nintendo officially announced a brand new Star Fox game for the Switch 2.

Nintendo has officially announced **Star Fox**, a cinematic remake of the classic game Star Fox 64, exclusively for the next-generation Switch 2 console.

Notably, this is also the first game to be released since Zero was launched on Wii U in 2016.

In the event's promotional video, we get a glimpse of the game's eye-catching graphics along with some story footage, as well as how the game will utilize the features of the Joy-Con 2 controller.

Currently, Star Fox is scheduled to launch exclusively on Switch 2 on June 25th.

In this installment, players will continue to accompany the skilled pilot Fox McCloud and the **Star Fox** team on their mission to stop the mad scientist Andross, who harbors ambitions to take over the Lylat star system. Piloting the legendary Arwing fighter jet, gamers will engage in breathtaking dogfights, performing spectacular aerobatic maneuvers such as circular loops to evade enemies. The game also encourages exploration by offering multiple routes through the Lylat system, unlocking countless diverse missions and challenges with each replay.

Besides its engaging campaign mode, Star Fox also offers a brand-new multiplayer Battle Mode. With a 4 vs 4 online format, players can team up with friends and participate in incredibly fierce aerial competitions.

7. Supports Joy-Con 2 mouse control and GameChat feature.

As Fox McCloud, along with your high-performance Arwing space fighter, you charge into intense space battles with relentless laser fire. During combat, you can switch between quick braking (leaving enemies no time to turn around), activating Boosts (to increase Arwing's thrust), or performing somersaults and barrel rolls to defend against incoming firepower.

Experience the game through a variety of engaging modes, including:

Campaign Mode

Travel to diverse planets, control Arwing through asteroid fields, and engage in free-for-all aerial combat. You can choose the difficulty level from Easy to Normal when you start honing your skills to earn medals. Once you've accumulated enough, the Expert mode will automatically unlock. In this mode, once the objective is completed, the enemy has been defeated, and necessary actions have been taken, players can change their route and freely do what they like in each level. Note: choosing different routes may affect subsequent levels in the Lylat System, meaning you may want to replay multiple times to experience different levels corresponding to different route choices.

Challenge Mode

Replay completed levels and face new objectives and challenges, including those not present in Campaign Mode, in Normal or Expert difficulty.

Battle Mode

Team up and compete in brand-new 4-vs-4 dogfights, with up to 8 players split between Team Star Fox and Team Star Wolf. This mode features three stages with different objectives: gain control of a designated area in Corneria, collect energy crystals in Fichina, or retrieve cargo from space pirates in Sector Y. This mode supports GameShare3, allowing up to 4 players to fly together online or offline via GameChat. Note: Online GameShare only works between Nintendo Switch 2 devices, while local GameShare works for both Nintendo Switch 2 and Nintendo Switch.

In addition, Star Fox also has extra features exclusive to the Nintendo Switch 2:

Joy-Con 2 mouse controller

– When playing solo in Campaign Mode and/or Challenge Mode, you can freely switch between button and mouse controls with the Joy-Con 2 controller. Mouse controls provide a more intuitive aiming experience, and if a friend joins, whether on the same system or via GameShare through GameChat, your friend can be the marksman while you focus on piloting the aircraft, or vice versa.

GameChat character avatar and AR filter

This feature allows players to appear as Fox McCloud or any team member when chatting with friends using an interactive avatar that mirrors expressions and movements in GameChat4. With the game's AR filters, players can also add a pair of ears like Star Fox or a beak inspired by Falco, with these parts moving in sync with the words spoken during chat.
