.unicorn



Access, register for free use: No

In technology, unicorn is a term referring to startups worth more than a billion dollars. However, in the world of extended domain names, it simply refers to a brand-name strange domain applied by an Czech-based IT company, Unicorn Systems. Unfortunately, the company then lost the right to use this domain after a fight with its rival. Currently this domain name has restricted free access.

.abc



Access, register for free use: No

The domain name itself is nothing unusual, the strange thing is that although Google's parent company - Alphabet is an extremely powerful name, can almost manipulate the entire Internet world but cannot take ownership of the .abc domain name from American Broadcasting Company - American Broadcasting Company. Instead, Alphabet had to pity the last three letters of the alphabet as xyz as its domain name (.xyz). Even worse, even alphabet.com is not owned by the billion-dollar corporation, but by BMW, and they have decided not to sell the rights to use the domain name.

.blockbuster



Access, register for free use: No

Dish Network TV is the owner of Blockbuster brand. This brand has almost disappeared from the market. In the early years of the 90s. This domain name has a very strong development due to the eating and making of Dish Network TV. However, until now, this domain name has gradually become forgotten and does not have any business activities. It is also no longer registered and allows free access.

.cancerresearch



Access, register for free use: No

Managed by the Australian Cancer Research Foundation, this is exactly what they claim is: A network of general-purpose websites is about cancer research. They are really well designed, but you will not be able to register to use this domain even if you prove you are interested in cancer or are researching the disease.

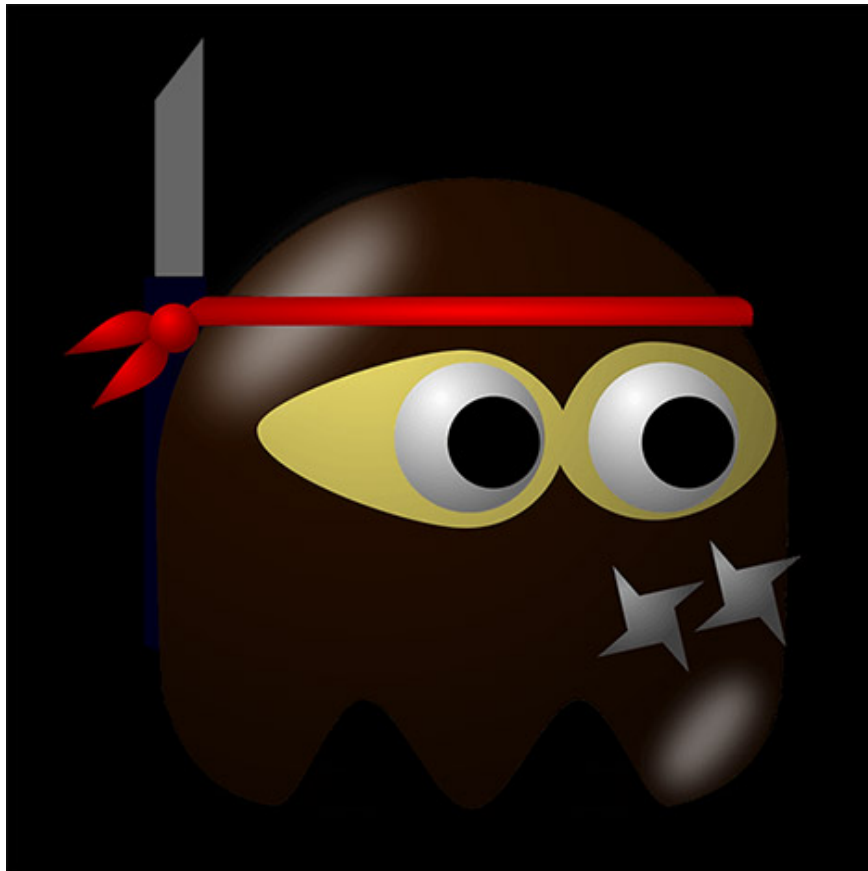
.cool



Free access: Yes

.cool is one of many interesting domain names owned by Donuts. The company's exclusive business is to create and run new top-level domains, and make analyzes and forecasts which domains will be widely used in the future. .cool is also such a case.

.ninja



Access, register for free use: Yes

Experts, organizations, or businesses use this domain to imply that they have a high level of expertise in a particular field, such as "HTML Ninja". And of course this unique domain name is also managed and exploited in part by Donuts.

.gripe, .sucks and extortion domain names



Access, register for free use: Yes

These two domains exist basically for one purpose only: To complain about deceptive practices. However, the main markets for these two domain names are companies and people who do not want to be targets ([name].sucks!). This has made them a controversial issue.

If you're the CEO of Apple, you probably won't want 'apple.sucks' to become something floating on the Internet. If you are a celebrity, you may want to continue and buy domain names like ".porn", ".xxx" and other meager domain names - although you'll have to pay a lot for Domain owner in exchange for these "defensive registration" types. Although it has not yet become a big problem, "extortion by domain name", or forcing people to pay to avoid bad PR is a real problem and will be mentioned a lot in the future.

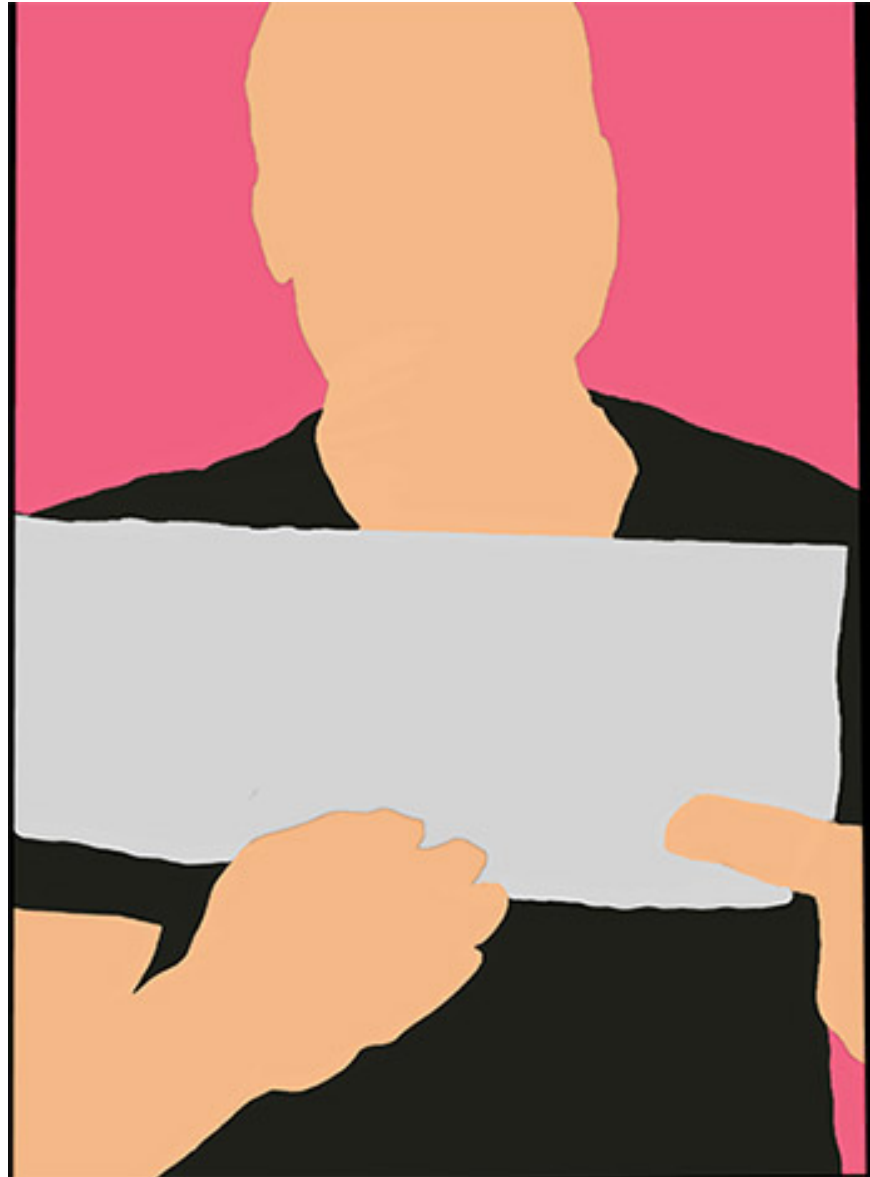
.degree, .university, .phd

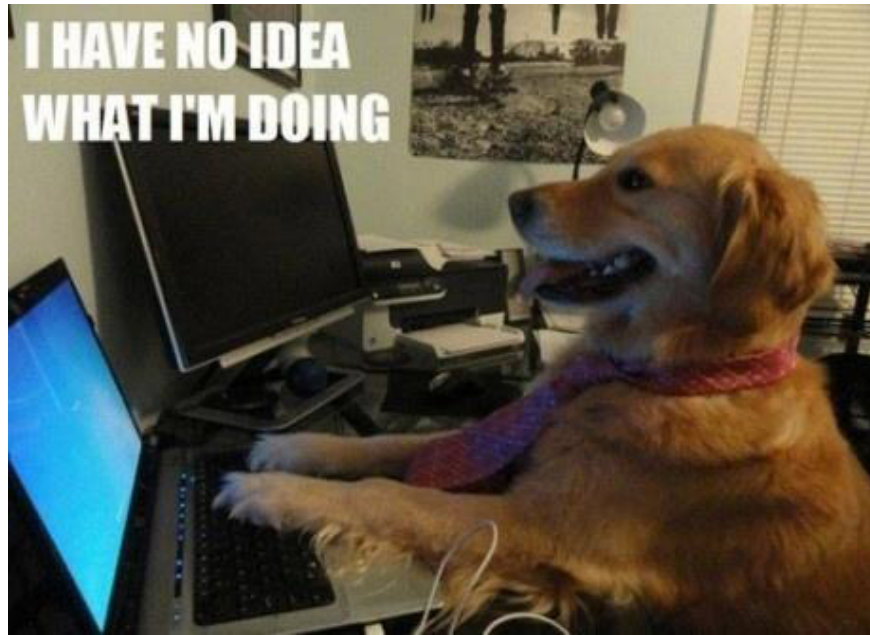
.dating, .date, .love, .singles, .social, .webcam .



Access, register for free use: Yes

This is the common domain name of some websites with 'shady' actions that are often hidden in advertisements. It is possible that some of these will be considered legitimate, but during the registration process, most domain extensions of this type are flagged as high-risk, potentially containing internal content. content does not match certain community standards or age groups.

.online, .website



Access, register for free use: Yes

Listing domains for domain names is quite important in restricting confusion. The .website domain name has for a long time been confused with the .ws representative domain of the Samoa island nation. As a result, .website has been blocked in this island nation to avoid possible mistakes.

.bible, .catholic, .church, .family, .faith

Welcome to the healthiest areas of the Internet, where no one can take advantage of extended domain names to serve any unclear reason.
