

Instructions on using Copilot suggestions in Microsoft Edge's on-page search feature.

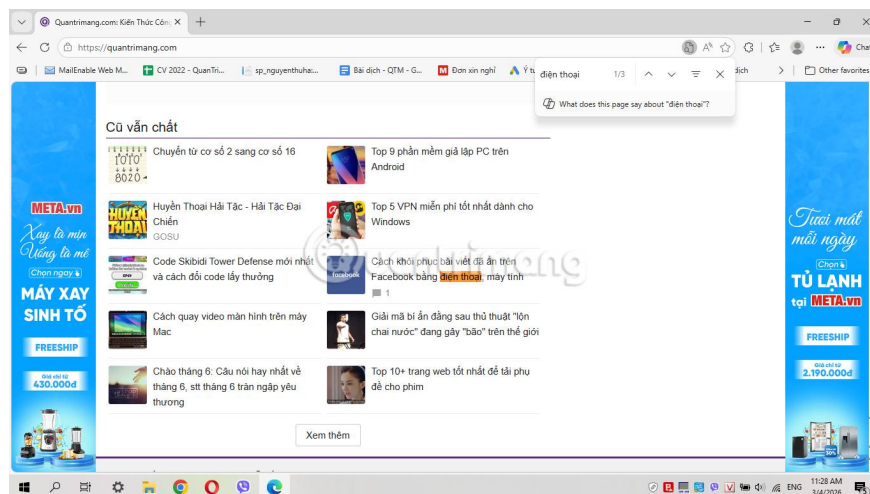
Finding a specific item on a website can sometimes feel like searching for a needle in a haystack. But with Microsoft Edge's Find on Page feature, it has become much easier.

Finding a specific search on a website can sometimes feel like searching for a needle in a haystack. But with Microsoft Edge's Find on Page feature, it's become much easier. And now, Microsoft is making it even easier by adding Copilot suggestions to Edge's Find on Page feature. This AI-powered tool upgrades your searches with clever ideas. Let's explore what it is, how to enable it, and how to use it.

What are Copilot suggestions in Search on Pages?

Initially, users used the **Ctrl + F** key combination to open and search on a webpage in Microsoft Edge. However, with Copilot Suggestions in Edge's Page Search, you not only get highlighted words; you also get intelligent questions.

For example, typing "phone" on a technology website might suggest questions like: "What does this page say about phones?" or "What does this page say about your type of phone?" .



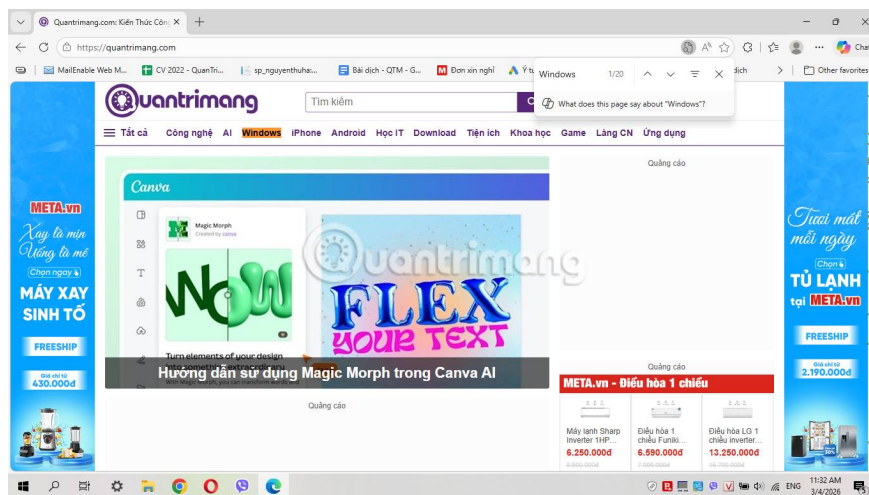
Additionally, these suggestions will appear in the search bar, and if you click on a suggestion, more information will appear with details from Copilot.

This feature is like having a friend who knows everything about the website explaining it to you. However, this feature isn't yet available on regular browsers. You can only access it on Edge Canary and use it like previewing cool tricks from Microsoft Copilot.

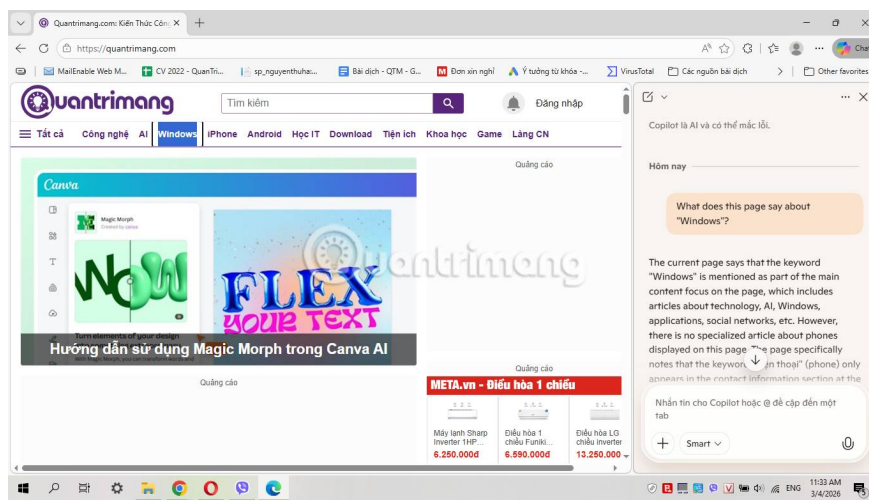
How to activate Copilot suggestions

If you want to try Copilot suggestions in Edge's Find on Pages feature, download Edge Canary from the Microsoft Insider website . This is an app that tests new browser tricks from Microsoft and doesn't affect the main Edge browser on your device. However, you can customize your Edge browser to make it look as fun as the Canary version.

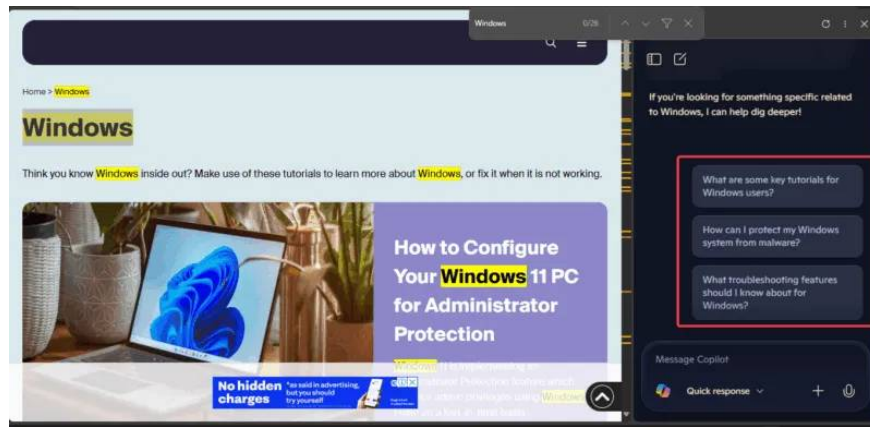
Now, open a website in Edge Canary. Then press **Ctrl + F** or navigate to **Menu -> Search on Page** . Enter a word into the search bar to begin. If you are in the test group, you will receive a suggestion pop-up window.



Now, click on it and the answers will appear in the sidebar.



You can explore more of the page by clicking on other Copilot suggestions below the initial summary.



However, if there are no suggestions, your Canary might need an update. Alternatively, the rollout might not have reached you yet. Therefore, you may need to wait.

Tips for using Copilot hints effectively

To make better use of Copilot suggestions in Edge Page Search, it's important to keep the following tips in mind:

1. Use clear and simple language that relates to what you want to find on the page. For example, search for words like 'AI' or 'technology' on a technology website.
2. Avoid using ambiguous language to ensure you receive helpful suggestions.
3. Check the sidebar for more questions that might help clarify what you're looking for.
4. Combine this feature with other features like Copilot on Edge's new tabs for a more engaging AI experience.
5. Since this is an experimental feature, it may sometimes be unstable. Therefore, always double-check the information.

Edge's Copilot Suggestions feature in Page Search makes finding websites easier and smarter. It's also a great way to try out AI features in the browser if you're new to it. Just download Edge Canary and give it a try.
