

Summarize the term PUBG Mobile that gamers often use

This is the glossary of PUBG Mobile that is most often used by players in the game

The term PUBG Mobile, which newbie heard in the microphone, didn't understand. Yes, because the term refers to slang words, only those who have played long in PUBG Mobile can understand what they mean.

Often speaking through microphones, most gamers will not use the main words of that thing or thing but will use their own terminology. Causing new players to play sometimes does not understand and from that coordination with teammates will not be effective.

Summary of slang words used in PUBG Mobile

Pi-Gi

Slang refers to the game name, some are called "Pup-Gi" or "Pe U Be Geo". Some are lazy, call each Pup or Poke.

Clad



This term refers to the sniper rifle Sniper Rifle AWM, not only in PUBG Mobile and PUBG. Many games with the appearance of this gun were also called by "gamers".

Bo ring

Only the ring in the game, bo consists of two parts, one white circle is the inner ring and the green one is the outer board. If the board is white, but in the green, you will not lose blood.

At the end of the game, the bo ring will eat your blood even more and the boating time will be lower than the beginning of the game.

Camp, Camper



This word has been around for a long time, before PUBG and PUBG Mobile came out. The first time I knew it was in Battlefield 3. Camp or Camper was the only one who "camped" in one position without moving, just waiting for the enemy to pass by to attack.

Often the Camper used the Sniper Rifle and hid in high positions, on hills, in high-rise buildings to get a general view of the position from above.

Loot



Action only to collect items, weapons in many places, indoor loot, loot corpses, loot "hearing". This is the term PUBG Mobile was used from the beginning when PUBG was just Early Access and used instead of the word "picked up" until now.

"Loot stroll" is a common term for teammates to go with the team, but the only task is to pick up items.

Shipper

This term refers to talented gamers who search, loot a lot of worthwhile items. Even the loot was audible, but before he could use any of his loot items, he died when he was ambushed by the enemy.

Then how many items have loot before being used to transfer to the enemy who just killed me. Just like shipping to an enemy, it is the term shipper for gamers who encounter this situation.

Felt



Only heal items with the name First Aid Kit in the game, read Ph? út Kít, but because it is too long, the player decides to shorten it to Felt for compact.

Check

"Hey, check the house", "Check the other car", "Check the other side of the hill" . This term refers to checking the area, vehicles or wherever there is doubt signs of the enemy.

Nade

Correctly, it is Grenade and in the game, there are people who call it Sticky, Slapped or Stout. Only weapons are pieces of grenades in PUBG Mobile.

Clear



Also known as the Clear Team, pronouncing is a flag. This term is used only after fighting, but there is no one who survives in that area. Or when checking a certain building without seeing any enemies hiding inside. So Clear means no signs of the enemy.

Drying, Tap



It is the term PUBG Mobile that is taken from the Spray to indicate the continuous action in **Auto** mode on the team or an enemy.

And Tap is the only one to shoot one by one in **Single** mode into the enemy. Many people also called click.

Ho Lo



The term refers to HoloSight sight accessories for close-range weapons. Gamers shortened to Ho lot for compact.

Bandage



The common term for PUBG Mobile is "bandage" or "bandage". Used to indicate items recovered with the least amount of hp in the game. A bandage only regains 10 HP after 4 seconds of use, but in return, this item is always available everywhere.

Green bullets

Also called a five bullet, only the type of ammunition used for some AR and DMR guns with 5.56mm bullets

Yellow bullets

Also known as a seven bullet, only 7.62mm ammunition and used for some weapons such as AR, DMR and Sniper Rifle in the game.

Nurse



The term refers to the action of calling for help from a team member who has been knocked out, or missing items to recover. Just call the Nurse your partner know and will pay attention to who is knocked off to save. But depending on the circumstances, it is possible to save.

Ka



Another term for weapons, the Sniper Rifle Kar98K that gamers usually call is Ka. Sniper rifles are the easiest to find in the game and use 7.62mm bullets.
