

# Summary of errors that occurred during the process of updating Windows 10 Anniversary and how to fix them (The last part)

If you install Anniversary Update with bootable media, during installation you will receive an error message that you cannot continue to install the update. This error usually occurs when you create a USB flash driver or DVD drive to install the operating system but contains some corrupted files.

## 7. Windows 10 active error

### Error:

1. Windows not activated

### Error description:

After installing Windows 10 Anniversary Update, Windows 10 prevents users from operating the operating system.

### Solution to fix errors:

To fix the active error during the installation of Windows 10 Anniversary Update, you can use the Activation Troubleshooter tool to reactivate the Windows 10 copy.

## 8. Error minimum system requirements

### Error:

1. 0xC1900200 - 0x20008
2. 0xC1900202 - 0x20008

### Error description:

During the installation of Windows 10 Anniversary Update update or in case if you are running Windows 10 on the device, Microsoft changes minimum system requirements. Your operating system requires 2 GB of RAM to run 32-bit versions of Windows 10.

Here are some minimum system requirements that Windows 10 Anniversary Update requires:

- Processor: 1GHz or fast processor or SoC
- RAM: 2GB for 32-bit or 64-bit versions
- Hard drive space: 16GB for 32-bit version or 20GB for 64-bit version
- Graphics card: DirectX 9 or higher with WDDM 1.0 driver
- Display: 1024 × 600

### **Solutions:**

In this case, the solution for users is to add more RAM on the system.

## **9. Incompatible application error during installation**

### **Error:**

1. 0xC1900208 - 0x4000C

### **Error description:**

If this error occurs during the installation process, it is likely that the application you installed on the computer is incompatible and blocks the upgrade process.

### **Solutions:**

Usually this error occurs because of applications, 3rd security software, such as programs, anti-virus software caused. To fix this problem, the easiest way is to uninstall those applications and try installing the update again.

## **10. Windows Update error while trying to install Anniversary Update**

### **Error description:**

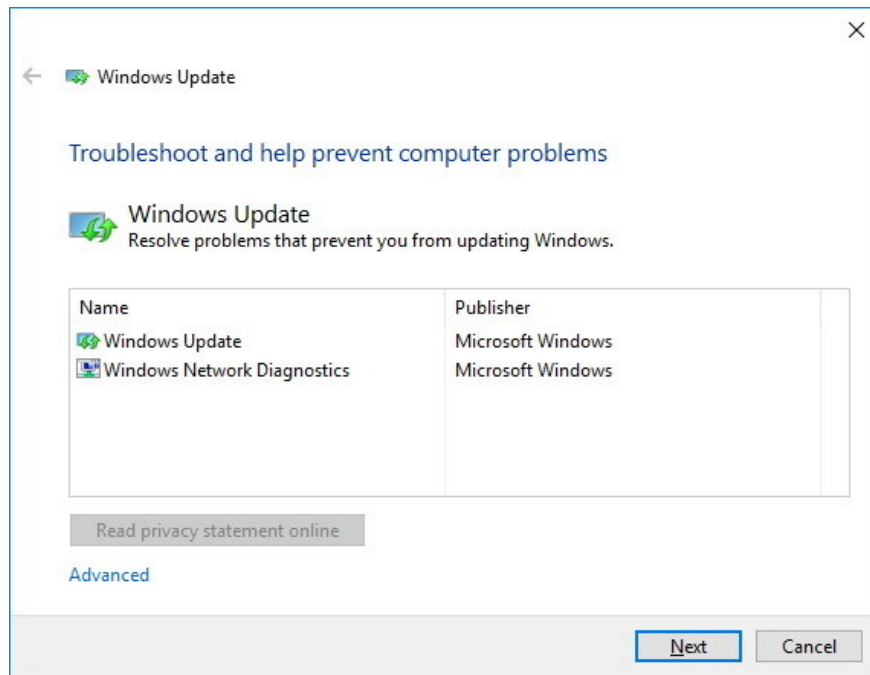
During the installation of the new update, you will receive some error messages stating that Windows Update will be blocked.

### **Solution to fix errors:**

There are many possible causes for errors, but to fix this you can use the Windows Update troubleshooter to reset Windows Update manually on your computer.

1. Download the Windows Update Troubleshooter tool from Microsoft.

2. Next select **Windows Update**.



3. Click **Next** to continue.

4. At this time on the screen you will receive a message, click the option **Try troubleshooting as an administrator**.

5. Select **Windows Update** again.

6. Click **Next** to continue.

7. The Windows Update Troubleshooter will fix the errors, and finally click **Close** to complete the process.

Alternatively, you can run the Troubleshooter again to reset the Network Adapter by using the Windows Networking Diagnostics option to fix network-related errors.

Note that you will have to restart your computer to complete the process and try installing Windows 10 Anniversary Update again.

If you still cannot install the Windows 10 Anniversary Update, you can use the Media Creation Tool to install the Windows 10 Anniversary Update update.

## 11. Files on Bootable Media are corrupted

**Error description:**

If you install Anniversary Update with bootable media, during installation you will receive an error message that you cannot continue to install the update. This error usually occurs when you create a USB flash driver or DVD drive to install the operating system but contains some corrupted files.

### **Solution to fix errors:**

The best way to fix errors is to reload the Windows ISO file and re-create bootable media.

If you're using the Media Creation Tool, make sure you use the Disk Cleanup tool and delete Windows Setup temporary files, then try creating the bootable media again.

## **12. Error Media Creation Tool during Windows 10 installation process**

### **Error description:**

When using the Media Creation Tool to start the installation process, you receive a DynamicUpdate error message or similar error messages. Although you restarted the Media Creation Tool to reset the download process, you still receive an error message.

### **Solutions:**

Open File Explorer, then go to **C: \$ Windows. ~ WSSourcesWindowsources** , double-click **Setupprep.exe** to start the update process.

## **13. Some settings cannot be converted during installation**

### **Error description:**

Some settings cannot be converted after installing the Windows 10 Anniversary Update update on a computer running the previous version of Windows 10 November Update.

### **Solution to fix errors:**

After installing Windows 10 version 1607, you will have to reconfigure some of the previous settings, including:

- Setting Pen: Personalize pen settings, go to Settings => Devices => Pen & Windows Ink.
- Set up notifications: personalize again by going to Settings => System => Notifications & actions => Notifications.
- Set up Tablet Mode: Personalize again by visiting Settings => System => Tablet Mode.
- Virtual Desktops: personalize Virtual Desktops by clicking the Task View icon in the Taskbar and selecting Add New Desktop.

## 14. Cannot install extension on Microsoft Edge after installing Anniversary Update

### Error:

1. App này bị lỗi? Vui lòng cài lại để sửa chữa

### Error description:

After installing the Windows 10 Anniversary Update, some users reflect that they cannot install the extension on the Edge browser, which includes Adblock, Adblock Plus, LastPass, Microsoft Translator, or OneNote Web Clipper.

### Solution to fix errors:

#### - Extension installation:

1. Open Microsoft Edge browser, then click **More (.) => Extensions => Get extensions from the store.**
2. Select the extension, then click **Free** to install.
3. After the installation process is complete, return to Microsoft Edge browser.
4. Read the message and select **Turn on.**

#### - Install extensions in incognito mode:

1. Open Microsoft Edge browser, then select **More (.) => New InPrivate window .**
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the extension.

#### - View and delete browsing history and cache:

1. Open Microsoft Edge browser, then select **More (.) => Settings.**
2. Select **Clear all history .**
3. Select items to delete, such as browsing history, data and cache files, .
4. Click the **Clear** button.

## 15. Cortana error "disappears" after installing Windows 10 build 14393.10

### Error:

Cortana is not available on Windows 10 or Microsoft Edge

## Error description:

After installing Windows 10 build 14393.10 (Anniversary Update), you don't see Cortana appear again. Cortana also doesn't work on Microsoft Edge browser.

## Solution to fix errors:

Microsoft still has no solution to fix this.

## 16. Error 0x8024200D

### Error:

1. Windows 10 b? l?i khi cài ??t sau update v?i l?i 0x80024200D

### Error description:

During the installation of Windows 10 Anniversary Update you receive the error message 0x80024200D. The cause of the error is due to problems related to the Windows Update installation file that you downloaded.

### Solution to fix errors:

To fix this error, follow the steps below:

1. Press the **Windows + R** key combination to open the Run command window.
2. On the Run command window, enter **msconfig** into it and press **Enter** or click **OK**.
3. On the next window, click the **Boot** tab.
4. Select **Safe Boot**.
5. Click **Apply** .
6. Click **OK** .
7. Start your computer in Safe Mode.
8. Open File Explorer and access the path **C: WindowsSoftwareDistributionDownload**.
9. Download the contents within the directory.
10. Press the **Windows + R** key combination to open the Run command window.
11. Enter **msconfig** and click **OK** .
12. Click on the **Boot** tab.

13. Remove **Safe Boot** item .
14. Click **Apply**.
15. Click **OK** .
16. Reboot your computer and try reinstalling the Update Update update again.

## 17. Screen error is black

### **Error:**

The picture is black after upgrading Windows 10.

### **Error description:**

After installing Windows 10 Anniversary Update and logging on your computer, the screen is black. This error may be caused by improper installation of updates or driver-related errors.

### **Solution to fix errors:**

#### **Solution 1:**

Try disabling all drivers on your computer, then connect again.

#### **Solution 2: Fix errors in Safe Mode**

1. Restart your computer.
2. On the login screen, press and hold the Shift key then click the Power button and select Restart.
3. After your computer has finished booting, go to **Troubleshoot => Advanced options => Startup settings** and then click the **Restart** button .
4. On the Restart screen, press **5** to start in Safe mode with networking.

After logging in to your account in Safe Mode, try reinstalling display adapter driver:

Press **Windows + X** key combination to open the Power User Menu, then select **Device Manager** .

2. On the Device Manager window, expand the **Display adapter section**.
3. Right-click the **Adapter** and select **Uninstall** .
4. Click **OK**.
5. Restart your computer to complete the process.

Also if the black screen error after upgrading Windows 10 Anniversary Update could be due to a certain process.

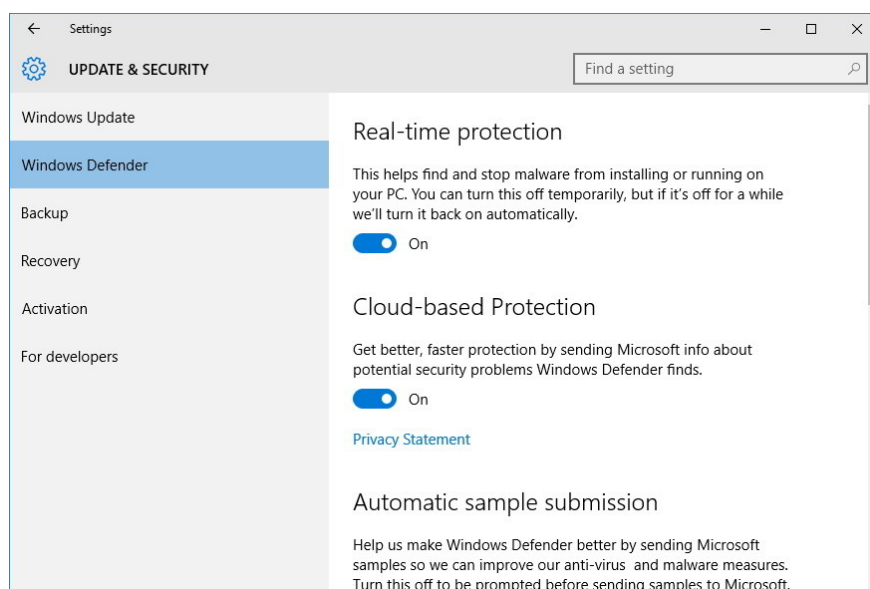
In Safe Mode, follow the steps below:

1. Press **Windows + X** key combination to open the Power User Menu, then click **Task Manager** .
2. On the Task Manager window, click the **Processes tab**.
3. Find and click **RunOnce32.exe** or **RunOnce.exe** .
4. Click **End task**.
5. Click the **Services tab** .
6. Find **RunOnce32.exe** or **RunOnce.exe** .
7. Right-click it and click **Stop**.
8. Restart your computer to complete the process.

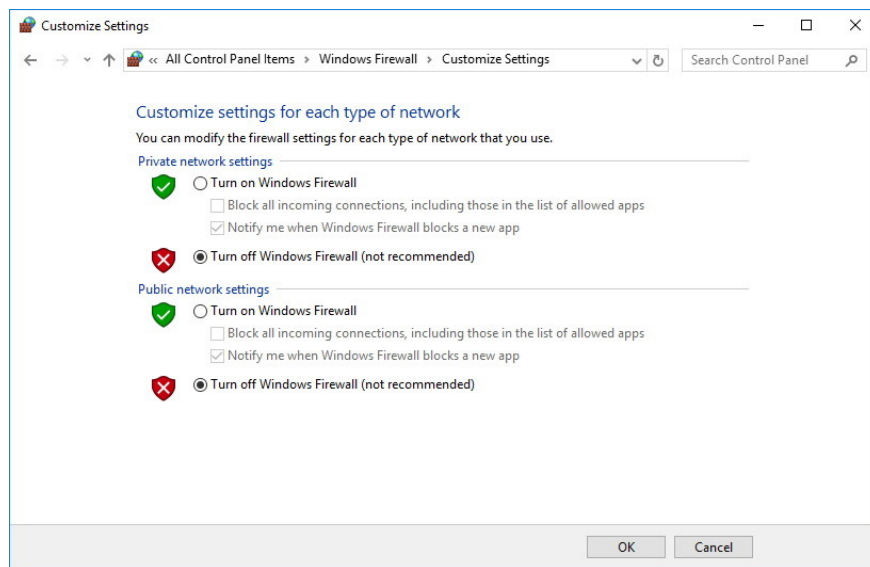
## 18. Disable security software

Antivirus programs are one of the top solutions and options to protect your computer from malware viruses. However, during the installation of Windows 10 Anniversary Update, anti-virus programs may cause errors during the installation process.

If using Windows Defender, go to **Settings => Update & security => Windows Defender** and turn off the **Real-time protection option** to temporarily disable the software.



In addition, Windows Firewall may be the cause of an error during the installation process. You can temporarily disable Windows Firewall by going to **Control Panel => All Control Panel Items => Windows Firewall => Customize Settings** and selecting **Turn off Windows Firewall**.
