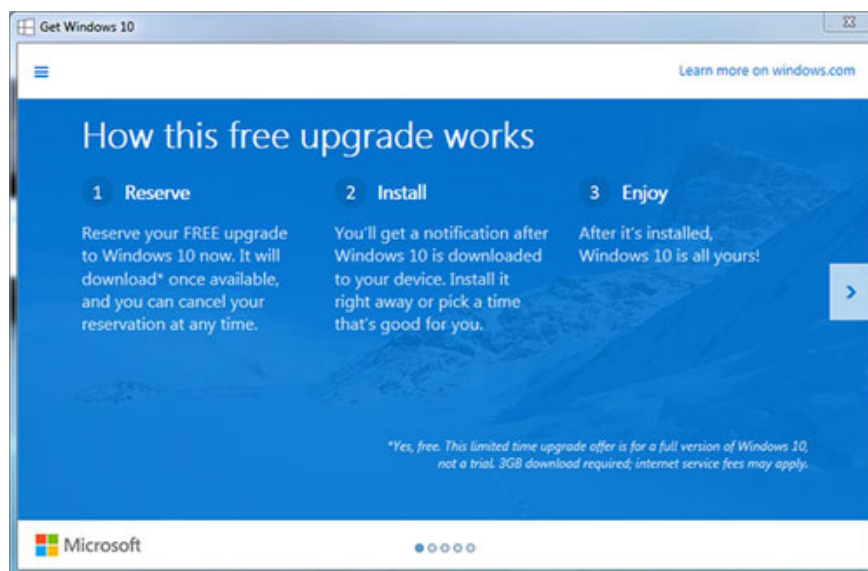

## 2- Actual photo Zenfone Selfie specializes in photography 'take a selfie'



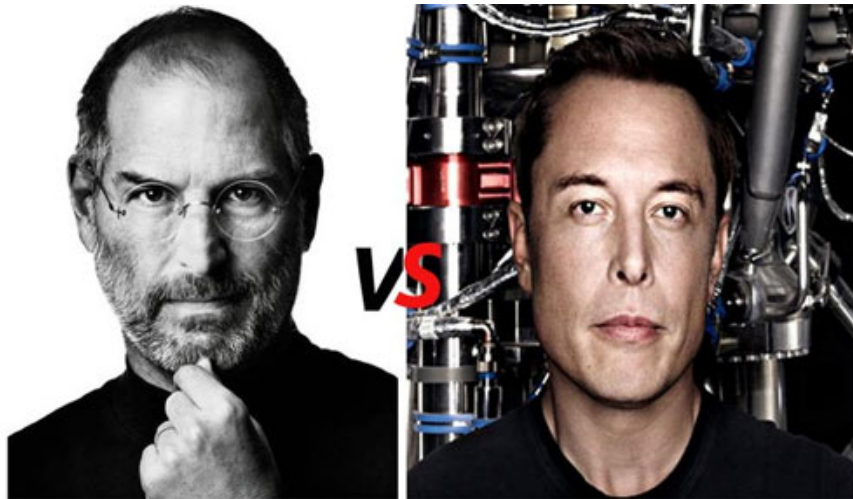

## 5- 8-year-old kid won the first prize in Google's Doodle drawing competition

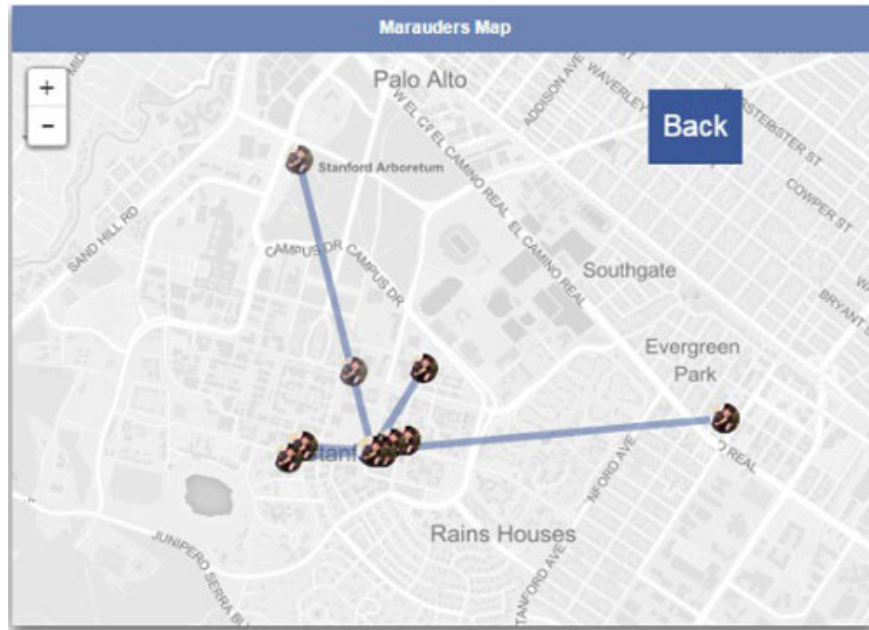

## **8- iPhone 6s can shove all consumption records**



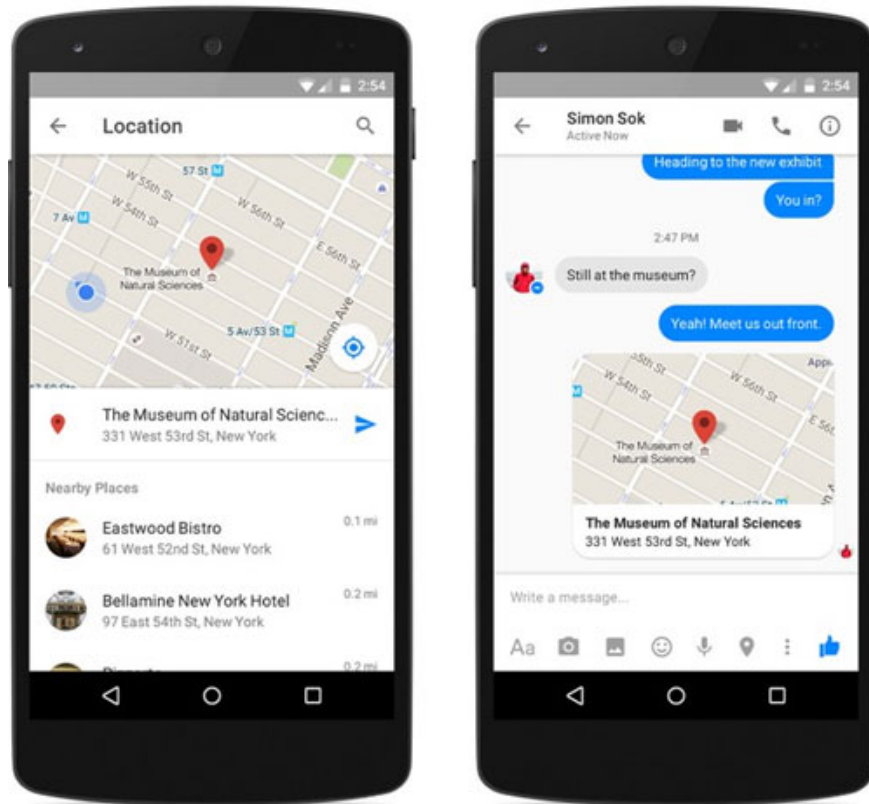
