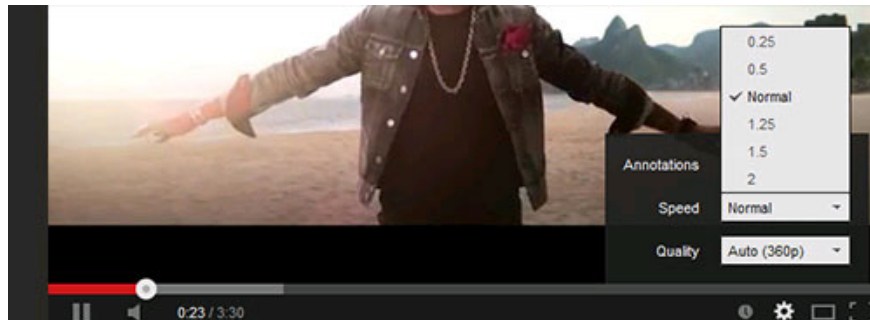

1- 5 utilities to make the most of YouTube



1. Block notifications Annotation:

1. Annotation is a small notice emerging on each user's video content to display links to related videos, in order to attract the interest of Google's top online video sharing service users.

1. Turn off AutoPlay feature:

1. With Chrome, you can find and download the add-on named StopAutoplay for your browser, then go to <chrome://extensions/> to activate this extension.

1. As for Firefox, to be able to turn off the Autoplay feature of YouTube, you will need the help of the add-on called YouTube Control Center.

1. Watch video in Slow-motion format:

1. To be able to use this feature, your browser must of course support HTML5 format.

1. Download video subtitles:

1. Besides the ability to download subtitles, KeepSub also supports subtitle translation feature using Google Translate tool.

1. Press YouTube to upload before the entire video:

1. Once you download this gadget, just below the YouTube content player interface, you will see additional expansion options.

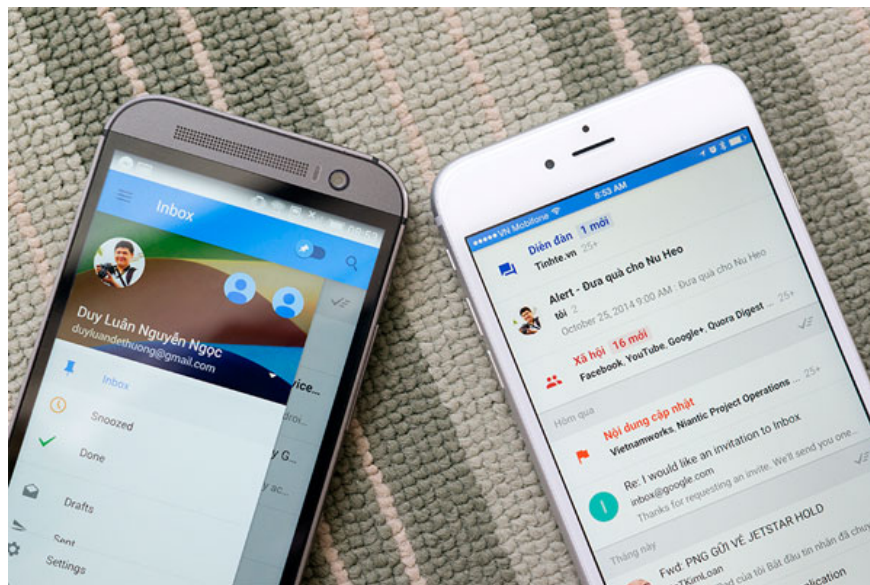
6- 6 things you may not know about Android
