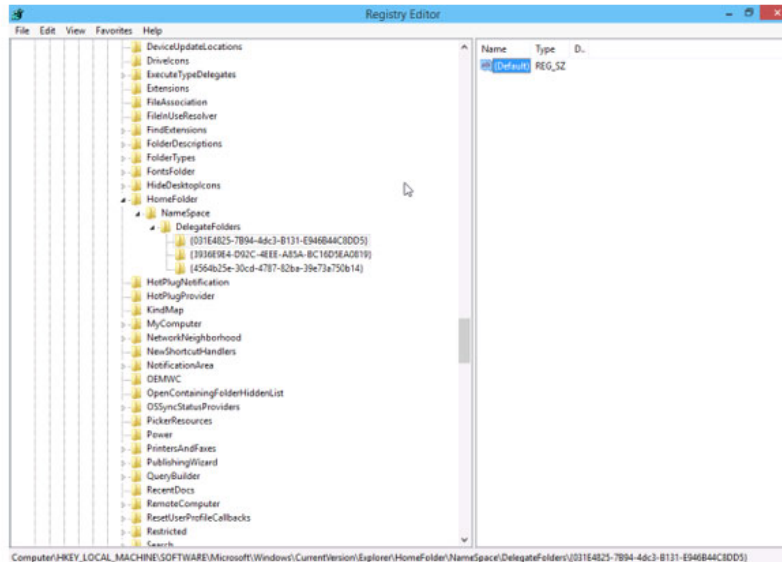
1- Instructions for using Snap feature on Windows 10 with shortcut

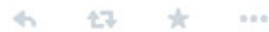

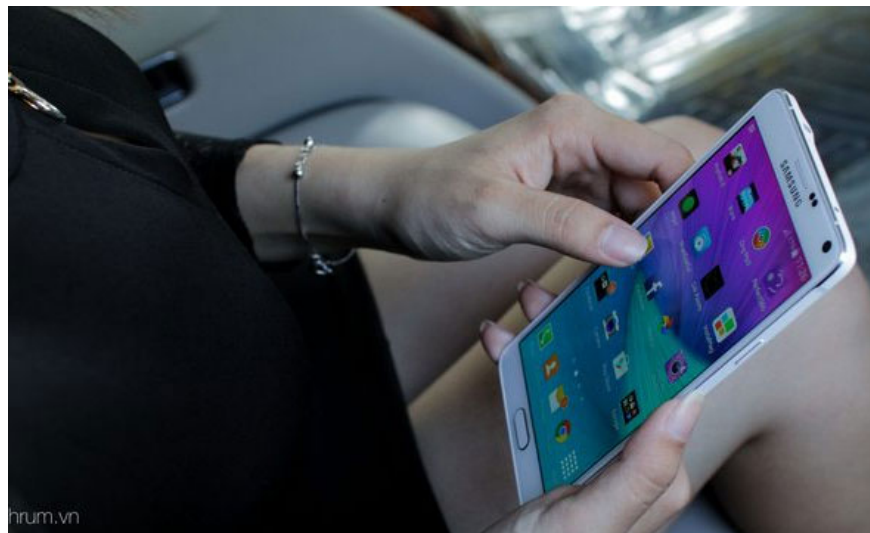
4- Why is the watch on an Apple Watch ad image only 10:09?

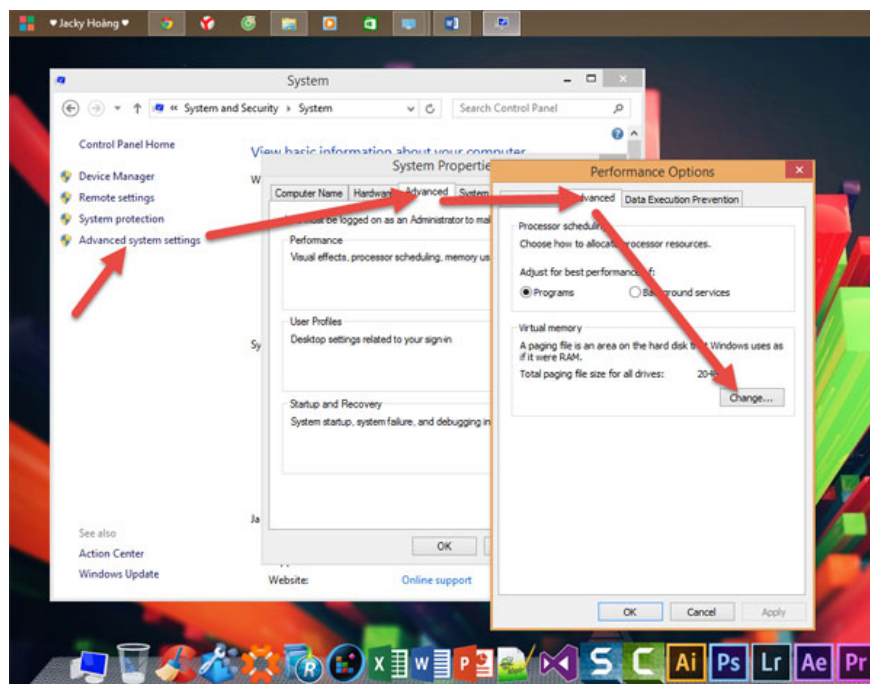
6- How to transfer data to friends at high speed
