1- Apple iOS 9: smarter, faster, better battery



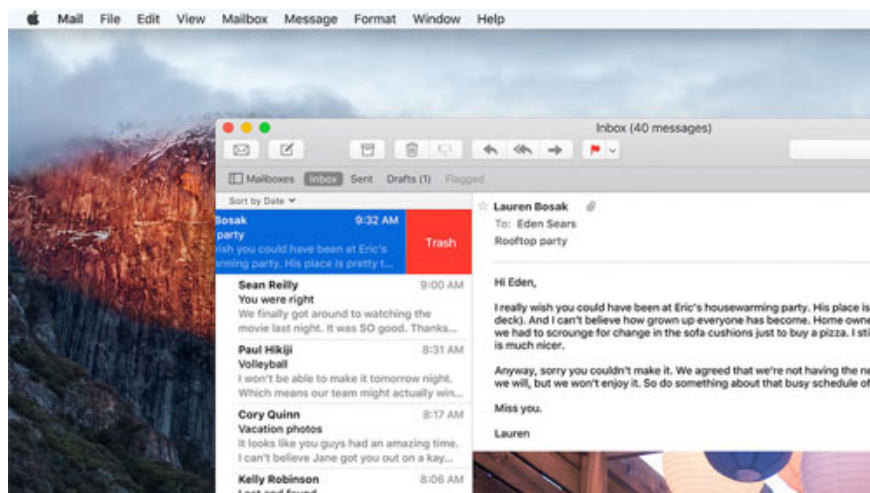

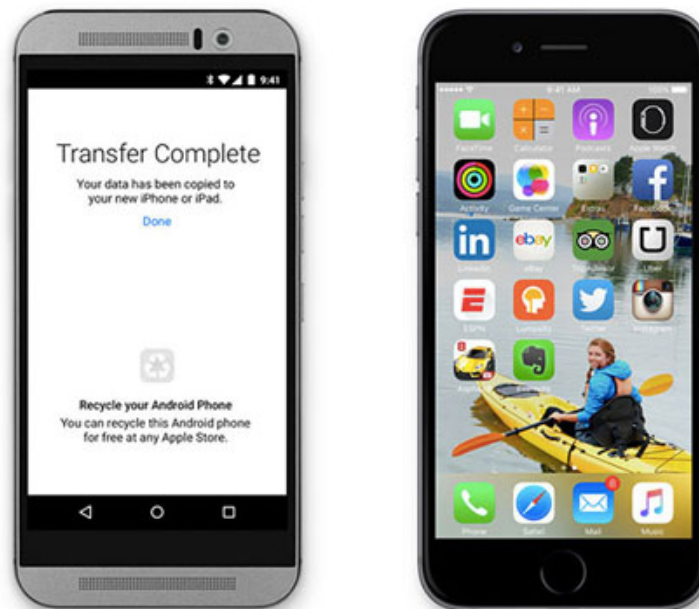

6- Important notes when cleaning smartphones



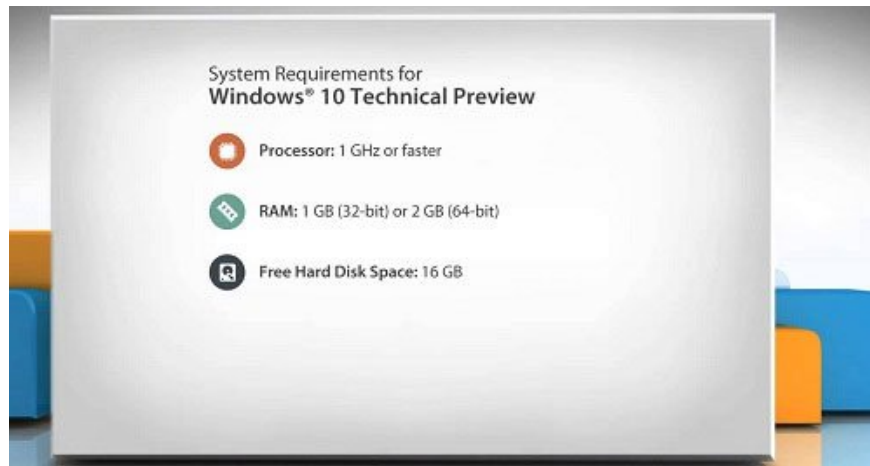

7- Apple launches a data transfer application from Android to iOS



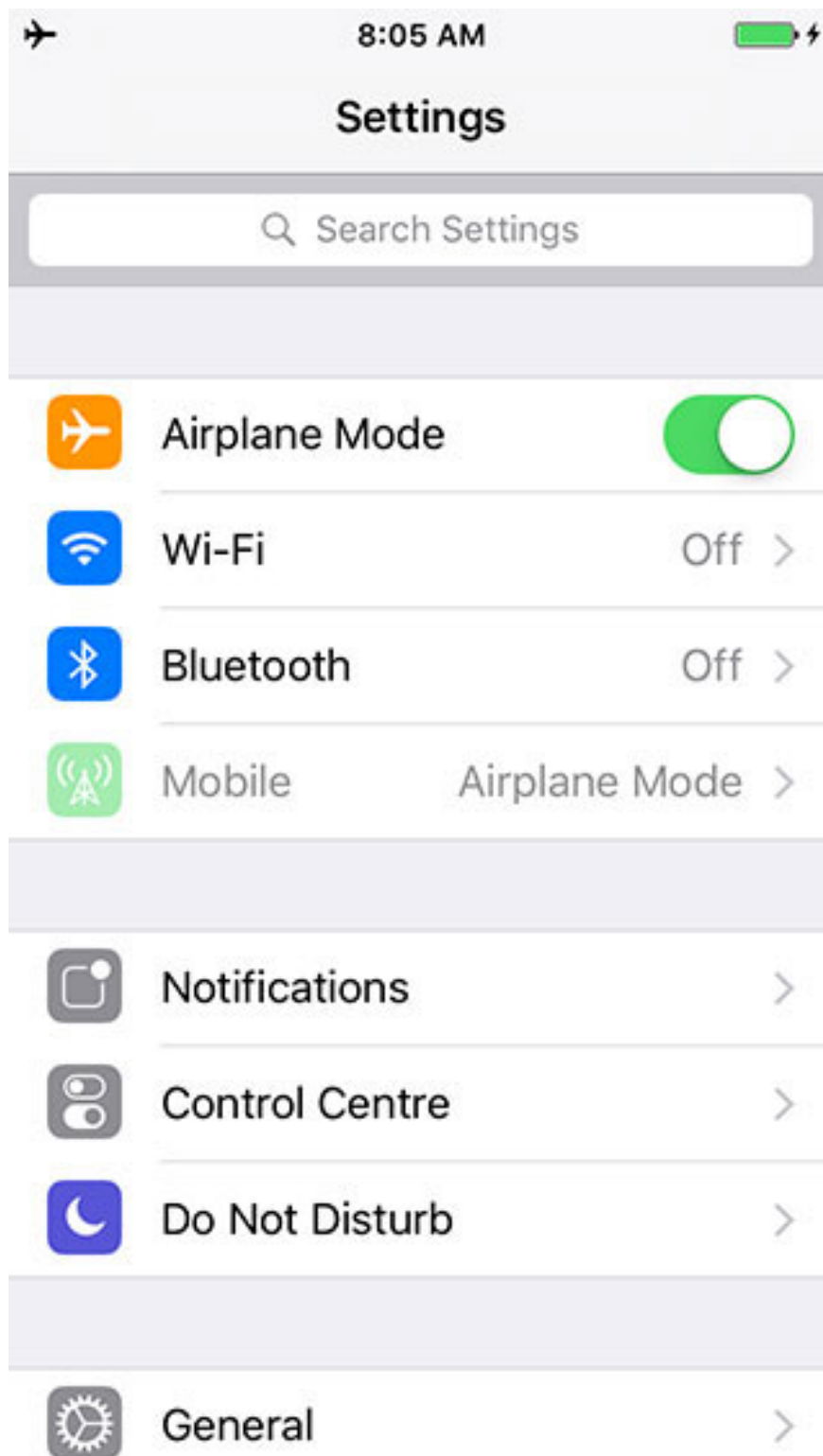
