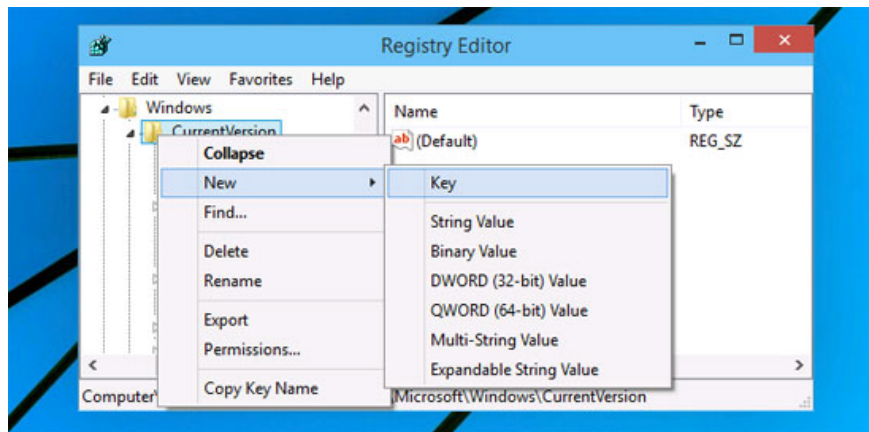

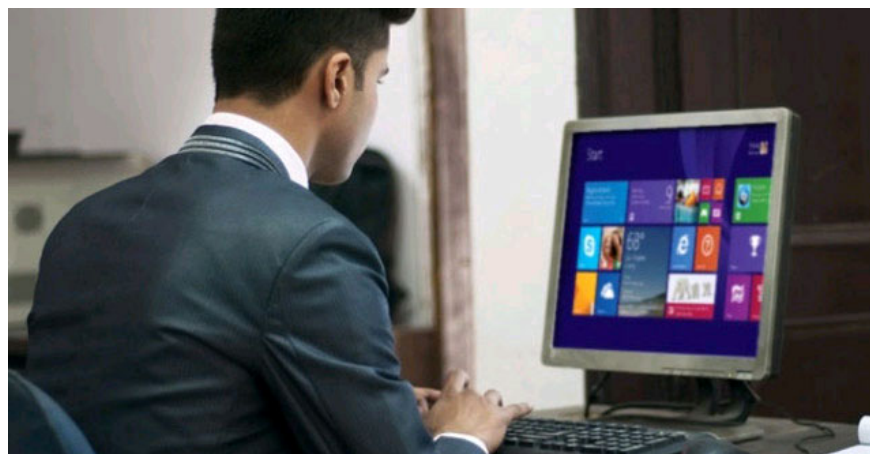
4- The first Microsoft branded Lumia phone came out

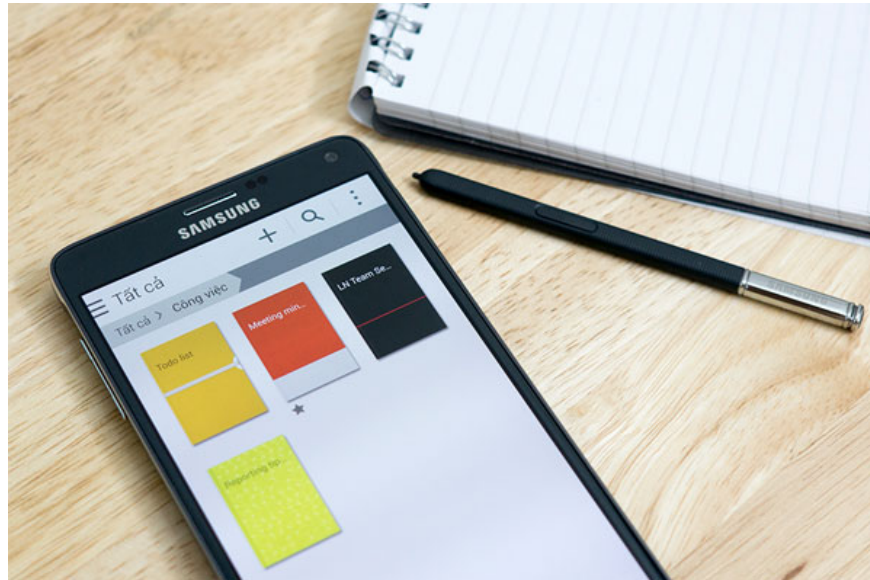
5- Useful tips for Windows users (Part 1)

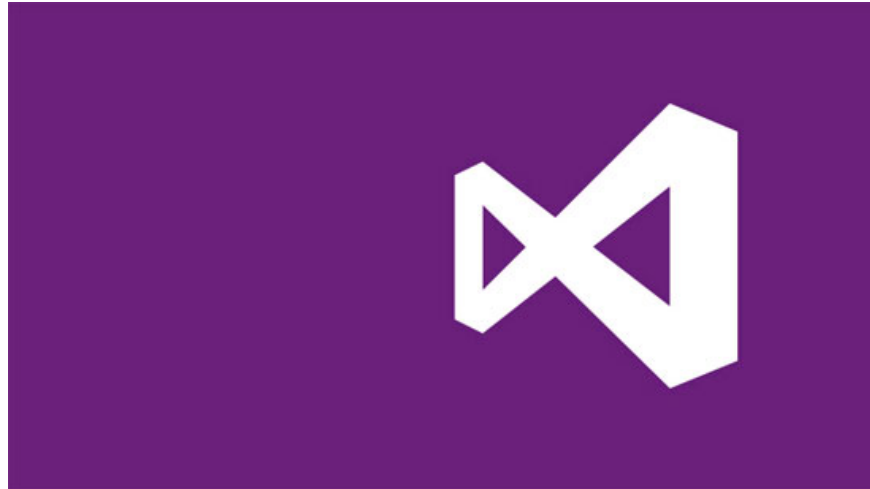

7- Microsoft releases critical patches that exist from Windows 95



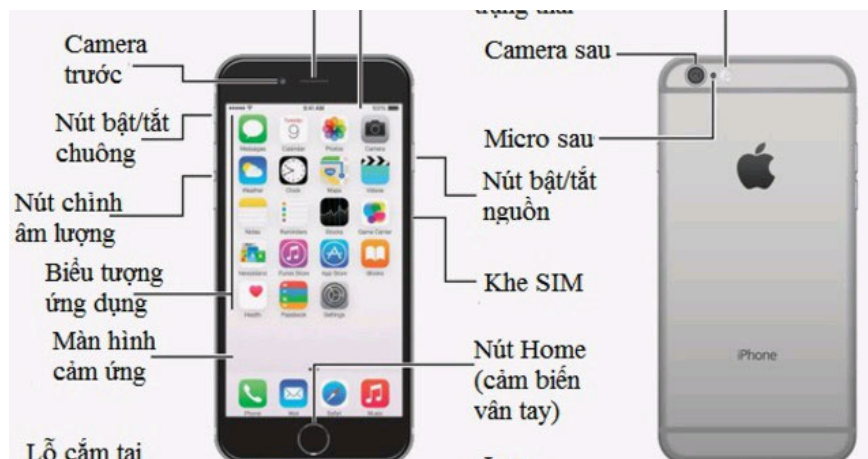
