Domestic ebook store

1. Sachvui.com

Sachvui currently has more than 2,000 titles, shared completely free for the community. This ebook store does not require account registration, no ads. Link download ebook directly very fast, friendly website interface, easy to find books, diverse content, from philosophy, economics, health, psychology, language, especially epub files and mobi to read on the phone, in general in Vietnam, sachvui.com is the leading address to find and download ebooks.



2. Tve-4u.org

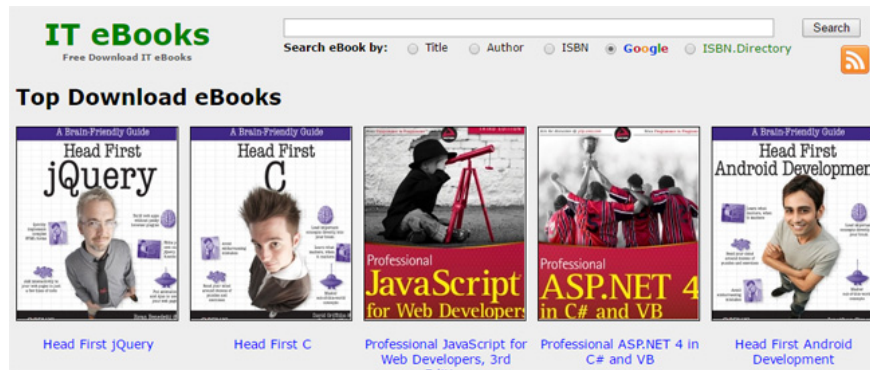
The website is built as a forum, members can share books together. To download books, you must register as a member (free). tve-4u.org also has all kinds of files to read on the phone, but the interface on the phone is not very friendly, access by phone to download will take some time.

Readers may wonder that there are quite a number of free ebook download sites in Vietnam, but I find these two pages to be the best, full of content categories.

Foreign ebook store

1. It-ebooks.info

Here it is, heaven for IT people! It is the leading ebook store with quality IT eBooks, almost all famous programming and IT books in the world are shared here. I put it on my head not because it was the best, but it was best suited for IT people so it was a bit biased;).



2. Gutenberg.org

This store has 50,000 free eBooks, no registration or login required, just find and choose books to download. If you use Kindle to read, you will be extremely familiar with this bookstore, it is rated as the world's top bookstore.

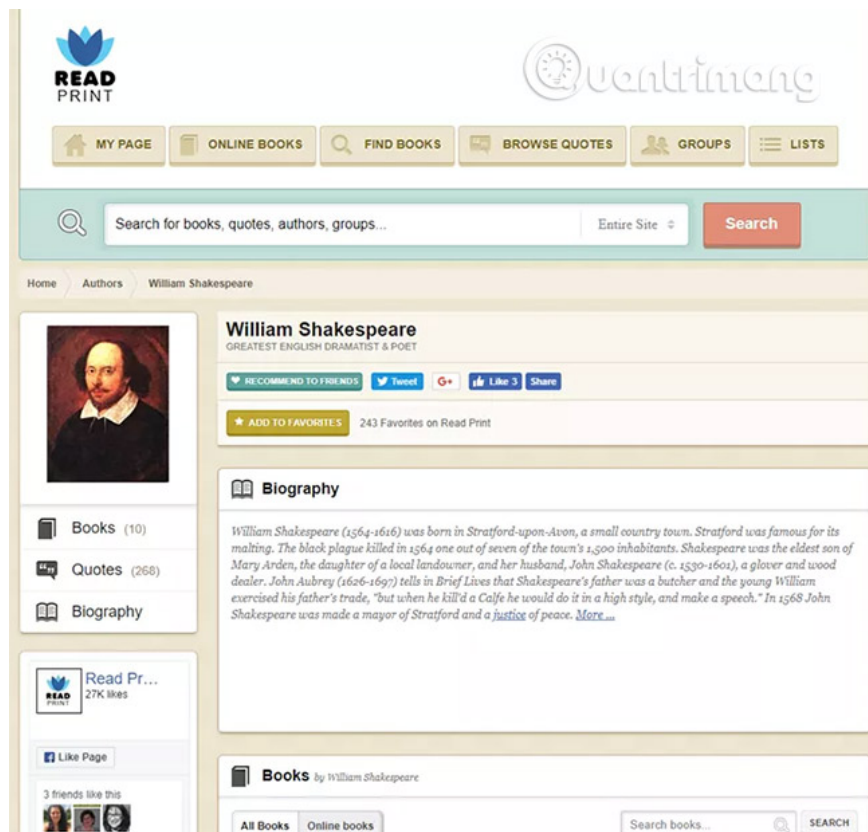
3. Loyalbooks.com

In addition to over 7000 eBooks, this bookstore also has audio for you to listen on the phone.

4. Free-ebooks.net

Even the homepage of the website is a long list of books such as electronics, entertainment, fiction, education, romance, non-fiction, short stories . and more. Choose your favorite genre to find books and download quite easily.

5. Readprint.com



Plus mark:

1. Easily search and provide many ways to find free books.
2. The free account gives you access to a personal page to manage your bookshelves, as well as interact with the community.
3. Comprehensive citation database.

Minus point:

1. Only classic books and books with Creative Commons licenses.
2. There is no way to download free books directly from this page.

Read Print is an online library where you can find thousands of free books to read. Classic books or Creative Commons licenses include all kinds of fiction, essays for fiction, drama and poetry.

Register for free at Read Print allows you to keep track of what you have read and what you want to read, write a review of the books you have read, add books to your favorites and join clubs Online books or discussion lists to review a literary work.

You can access books on Read Print without registering an account, however, you will not have access to the other features mentioned above.

Find free books on Read Print

There are several ways you can find what you want to read at Read Print:

1. Search keywords for titles, authors or quotes.

2. Search by type of published work (ie, essays, novels, fiction, plays, etc.)
3. See top books selected by readers.
4. Browse the author index in alphabetical order.
5. See 250 most famous authors on Read Print.

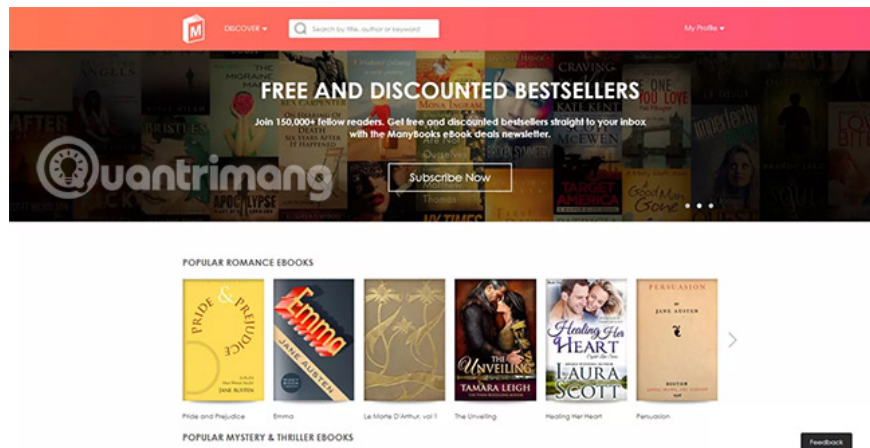
For example, if you are looking for William Shakespeare's book, a simple search will filter out all of Shakespeare's works, in a single position.

Read books at Read Print

Once you've found a book that interests you, click **Read Online** and the book will open in your web browser. You also have the option to launch the **Reading Mode**, if you don't like the website interface. Reading Mode looks like an open book, however, all free books on Read Print are divided by chapter, so you will have to go back and open it every time you switch to a new chapter.

If you find a free book that you really like and you want to download it to your mobile device, Read Print provides a link to Amazon, where readers can download it. However, when downloading books from Amazon, you may have to pay unless you are a member of Amazon Kindle Unlimited.

6. Manybooks.net



Plus mark:

1. Selection not only includes classic works and Creative Commons.
2. Excellent sorting feature makes it easier to find what you love.

Minus point:

1. Some functions may not be available on the new site.
2. Some areas have not been updated for more than a year.

ManyBooks is one of the best resources on the web to read free books in many different formats. There are hundreds of books available here with all interesting genres and they are completely free. One of the best features of this site is that not all books are classics or Creative Commons licenses.

Find free books on ManyBooks

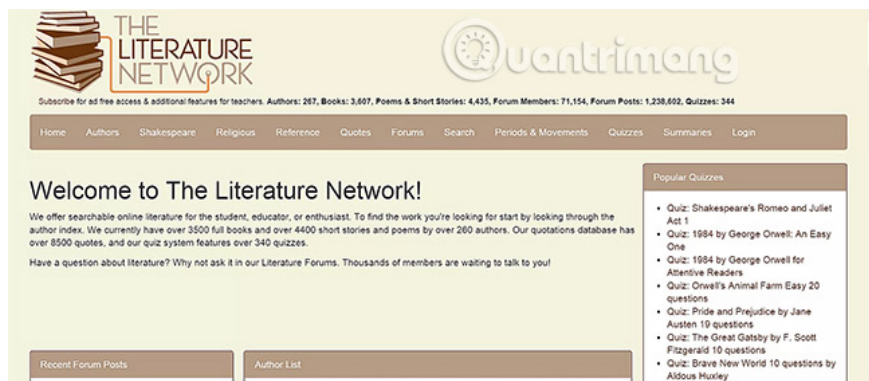
ManyBooks is in transition at the time of writing this article. The beta test version of the site is available with an available search feature. Readers can also find books by browsing categories, popular choices, authors and editors' choices. In addition, ManyBooks has gathered into book collections, so readers can explore topics in a more organized way.

In addition to these basic search options, you can also use **ManyBooks Advanced Search** (**ManyBooks Advanced Search**) to determine exactly what you are looking for. There are also RSS feeds, which can keep you up to date on new content, such as **All New Titles By Language** (All new titles by language).

Read books at ManyBooks

All ManyBooks free books can be downloaded - some are downloaded directly from the ManyBooks website, some from other websites (such as Amazon). When you register for the site, you are asked to choose the preferred format for the book. When you find a book you want to read, you can choose the format you want to download from the dropdown menu with dozens of different file formats.

7. Online-literature.com



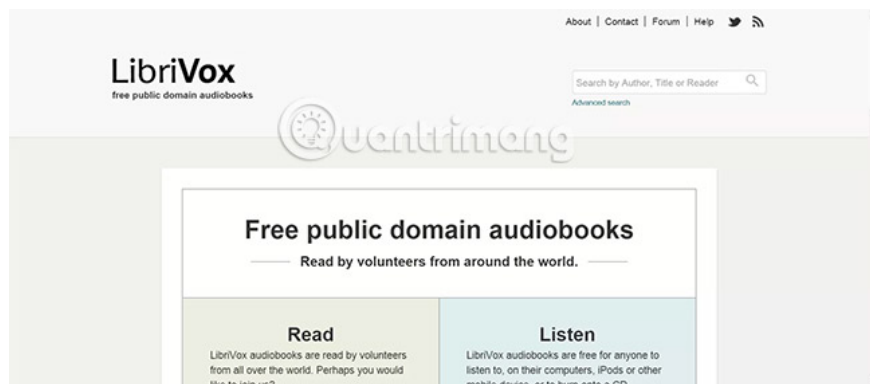
The Literature Network is arranged alphabetically based on the author's name. Click on the name of any author and you will see related profiles, links and articles, quizzes and forums. Most of the books here are free, but some downloads require a small fee.

8. Freecomputerbooks.com



Every computer-related theme and programming language you need will appear here. Free books, textbooks, as well as extended lecture notes are available at Free Computer Books.

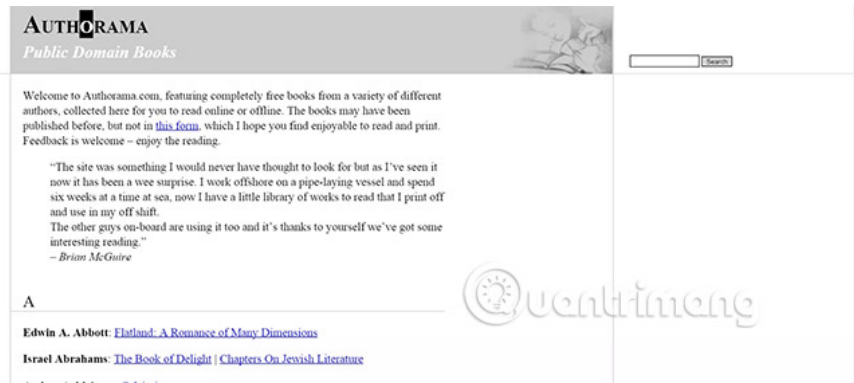
9. Librivox.org



Librivox.org is loved by audiobook lovers like a dream come true. All the books here are completely free - good news for those who have to pay high fees for poor quality audiobooks.

Librivox has many volunteers working to release quality recordings for classic books. All books are free to download. If you are looking for a great place to find free audiobooks, Librivox is a great choice.

10. Authorama.com



Authorama.com has a range of quality, free books written in HTML and XHTML (basically meaning they are easy to read). Most of the books here are written in English, but there are also a few books in German. Books are arranged in alphabetical order, based on the author's last name. Authorama offers a wide selection of free books from many authors, both current and classic.

Authorama offers readers a wide selection of high quality, free books that can be read in your browser or printed as you like. These are books in the public domain, which means they are free to access and allowed to distribute. In other words, you don't need to worry about whether you are breaking the law when reading and downloading books on Authorama.

How to find free books on Authorama?

Authorama is a very simple site to use. You can scroll down to the list of authors arranged alphabetically on the first page, or see the **Latest Additions** list at the top.

When you find a book you're interested in, click on the title of the book and you'll be taken to that book. You can choose to read chapters in your browser (easiest) or print book pages and read later.

If you are looking for an easy to use free online book, Authorama is definitely right for you. All books provided here are easy to find and easy to read.

11. Gutenberg.org



Project Gutenberg is one of the largest free book supplies on the web, with more than 30,000 free books available for download in various formats.

Project Gutenberg is the oldest (and possibly the largest) library on the web, with hundreds of thousands of free books available for download. Most of the books at Project Gutenberg are published in English, but there are also other languages.

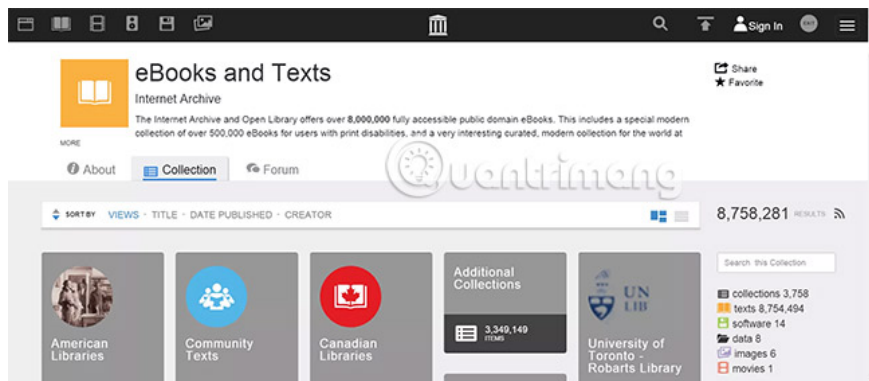
If you have determined what you are looking for, search the database by author's name, title, language or subject. You can also see the top 100 books list to know the general trends of other readers.

12. En.childrenslibrary.org



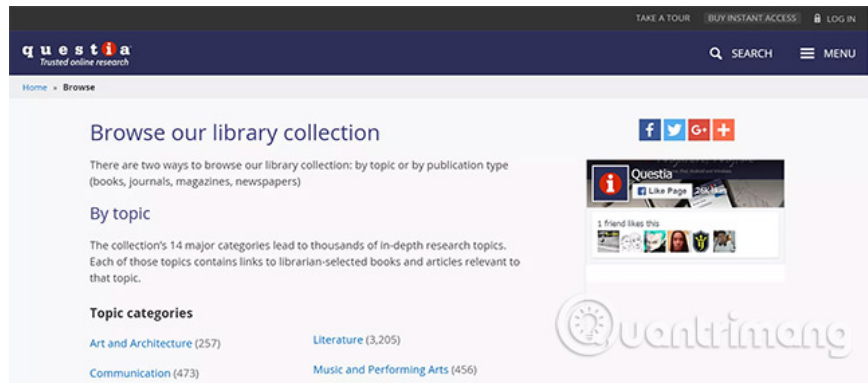

Ebooks and Text Archives have a wide variety of books such as novels, famous books, children's books, historical texts and textbooks. The free books on this site can meet all your reading preferences.

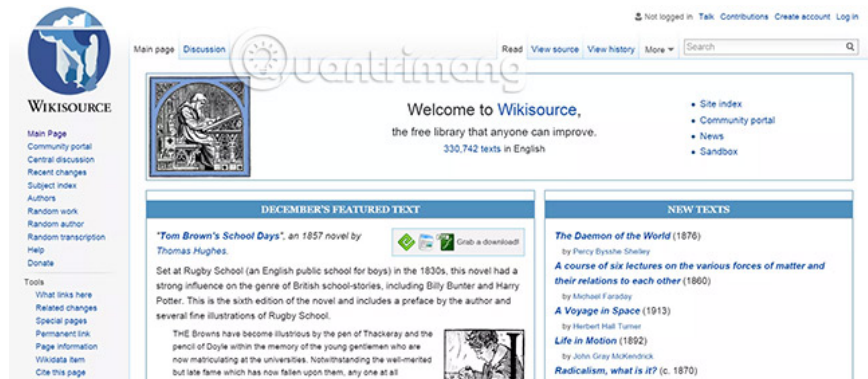
14. Questia.com



Questia Public Library has long been a favorite choice for book lovers and scholars need to find resources for research projects. Questia Public Library offers a world-class library, including free books of classics, rare and even textbooks.

More than 5,000 free books are available for download here, alphabetically, based on title and author's name.

15. En.wikisource.org



Wikisource is an online library with user-submitted and maintained content. Although you will not find free books on this site (until the time of writing), but there are more than 200,000 content available for reading.

16. En.wikibooks.org



Wikibooks is an open collection of textbooks ((mostly like that), in subjects, from Computer Science, Language to Science, you can see all Wikibooks offers in the section. **Books by Subject** .

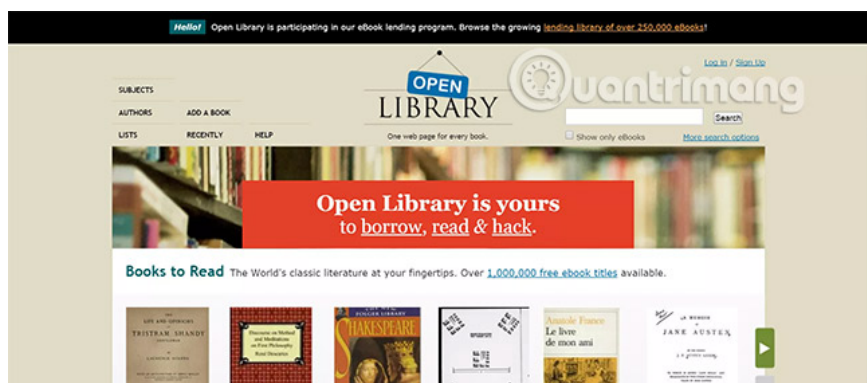

17. Bibliomania.ws



Bibliomania provides readers with more than 2,000 free classics, including literary notes, author biographies, book summaries and study guides. Free books are presented in chapter format.

18. Openlibrary.org



The Open Library has over a million free books. All are available in PDF, ePub, Daisy, DjVu and ASCII text formats.

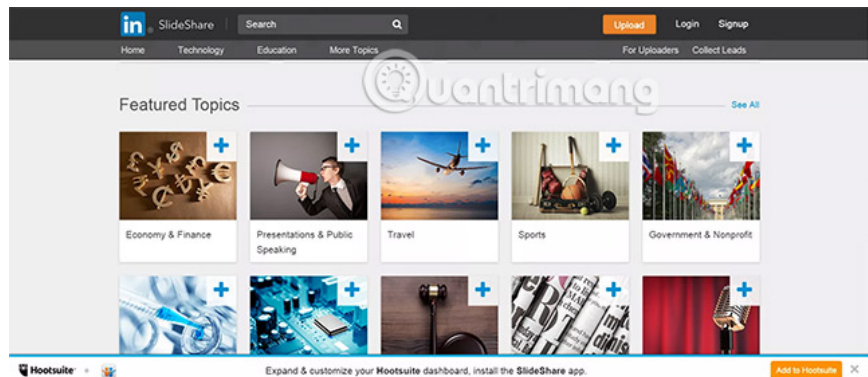
You can search for specific ebooks by selecting the **Show only ebooks option** in the main search box. Once you have found the ebook you need, you will find it available in many different formats.

Sacred Texts contains the largest collection of free books on the web about religion, myths, folklore and esoteric things in general.

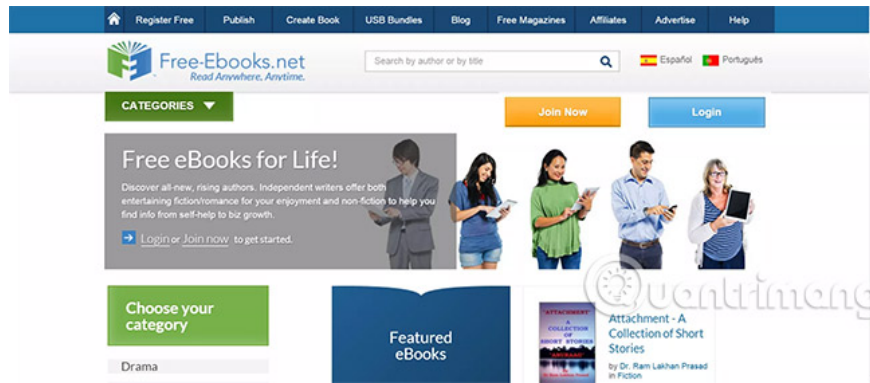
20. Slideshare.net



Slideshare is a website that doesn't just have free books. Slideshare provides a large amount of free content for readers. This is an online forum where people can upload digital presentations to any topic.

Millions of people use SlideShare to research, share ideas and learn about new technologies. SlideShare supports PDF documents and formats. All of these files are available for free download (after signing up for a free account).

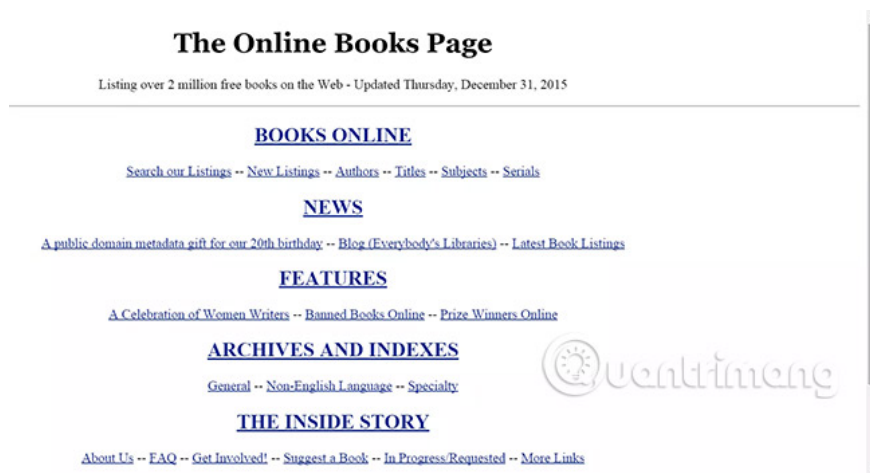
21. Free-ebooks.net



Free eBooks offers a variety of free books, ranging from books on advertising and health to web design. Signing up as a standard member (to download all content and take only a minute to complete) is completely free and gives users unlimited access to eBooks with HTML, but only 5 Book every month in PDF and TXT format.

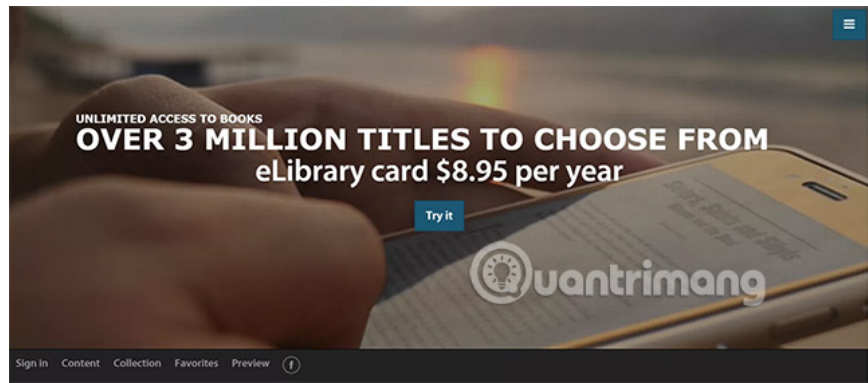
A VIP member on Free eBooks (\$ 39.95 for 1 year or \$ 49.95 for lifetime) gives you unlimited access to any book you want, in any format.

Maintained by the University of Pennsylvania, The Online Books Page lists over a million free books available for download in many different formats.

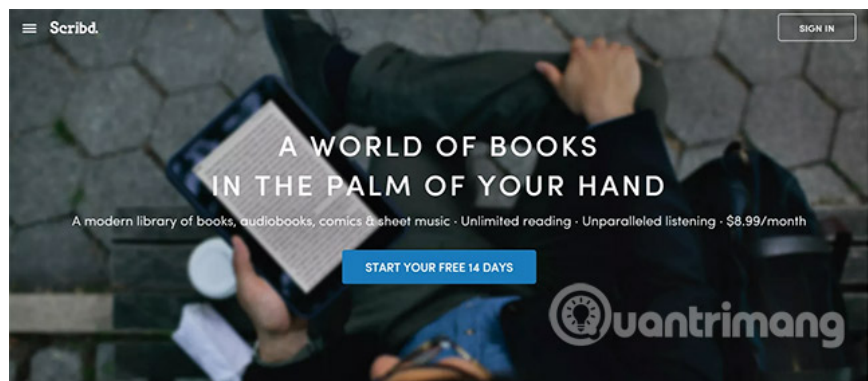
23. Worldpubliclibrary.org



Technically, World Public Library is NOT free. But for a fee of \$ 8.95 per year, you can access hundreds of thousands of books in over a hundred different languages. World Public Library also has more than a hundred different special collections, from American literature to Western Philosophy. A very good option to consider.

The World Public Library has a section called **Give Away Page** , with more than two hundred most popular book titles including audiobooks, technical books and books adapted into movies. Use it as a free member first and if you really like World Public Library's services, you can register as a member and have a whole collection.

24. Scribd.com



Scribd offers a compelling collection of all kinds of documents like presentations, textbooks, favorite books, and more (all arranged by topic). Scribd is one of the largest published content sources on the web, with millions of documents published monthly.

However, Scribd is not free. It offers a free trial for 30 days, but after trial, you will have to pay \$ 8.99 per month to maintain membership, to have access to the entire book database, audiobooks and magazines. This is still an acceptable option!
