Specifically, the technical details are as follows: VIA CPU C7-M ULV processor 1.2GHz chip, 1GB DDR2 RAM, 40GB or 80GB HDD, high-definition audio, touch screen 7inch with maximum resolution of 800x600, Ethernet port, WiFi a / b / g, two USB 2.0 ports, DVI monitor output, 4in1 memory card reader . Especially the device also integrates phone call function VoIP via Skype service.

Currently the manufacturer has not disclosed any information regarding selling prices and plans to launch products. However, analysts said that if the price of TangoX is reasonable, this product will win a great victory in the market, challenging Asus Eee PC.
