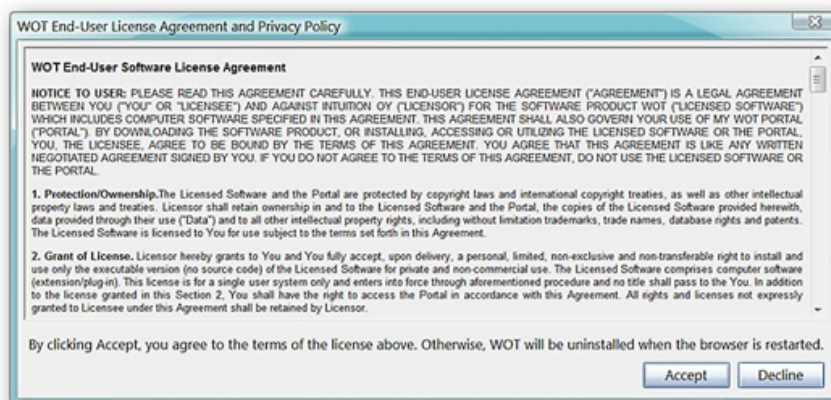

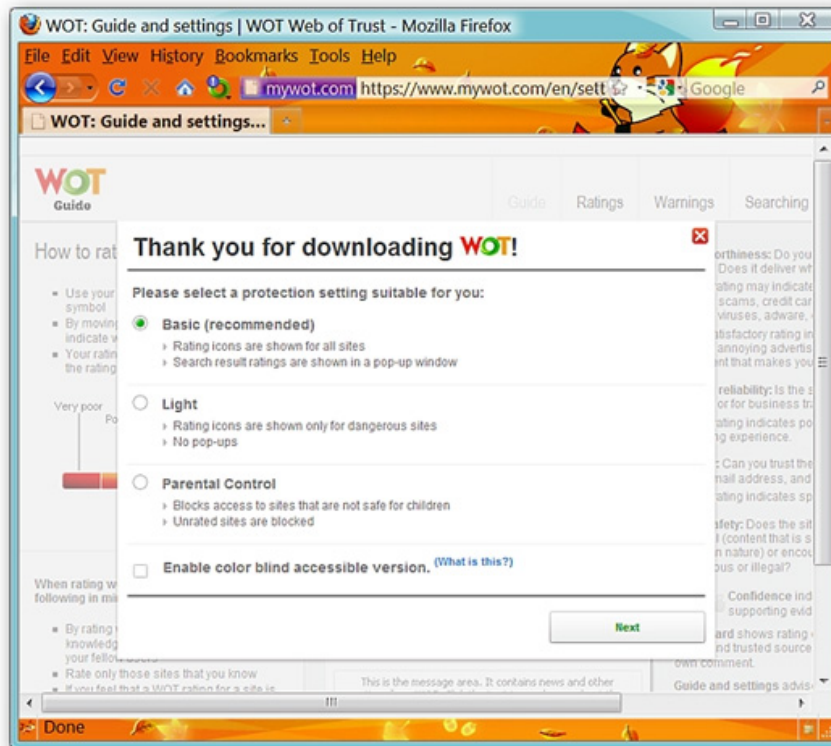
For Mozilla Firefox:

How to install similarly to other Firefox add-ons, after completing and restarting the browser, you will see the WOT End-User Software License Agreement notice, select **Accept** to start activation and use. WOT use:



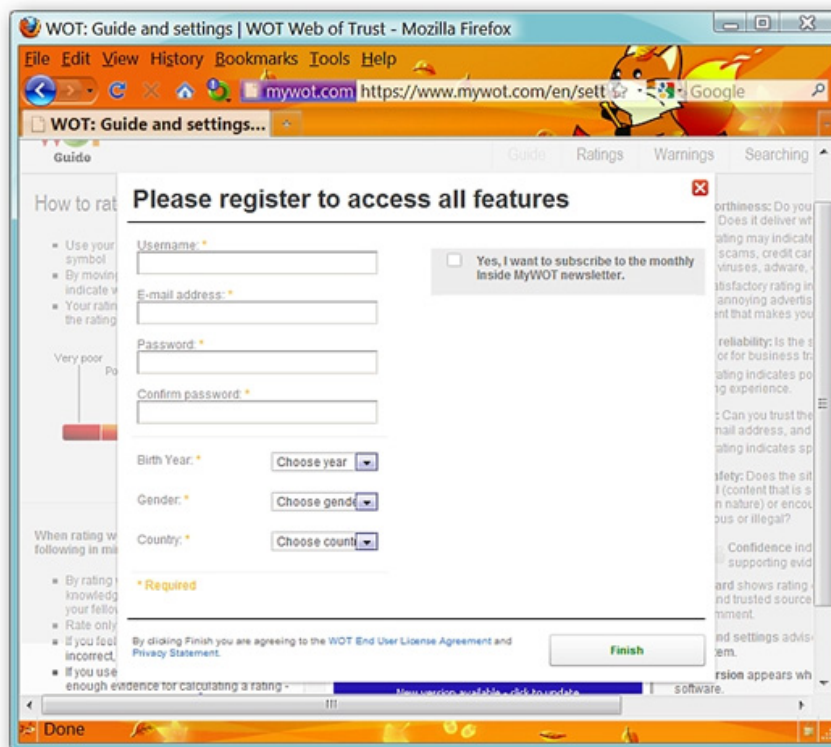
When this process is complete, the WOT button will be fixed on the left, near the address bar. With Firefox, users can move the location of this button accordingly.

After restarting the browser, you will see a notification window that selects the security level of the WOT, including 3 levels. Here, the author chooses the default level, *Basic (recommended)* and select **Next** :

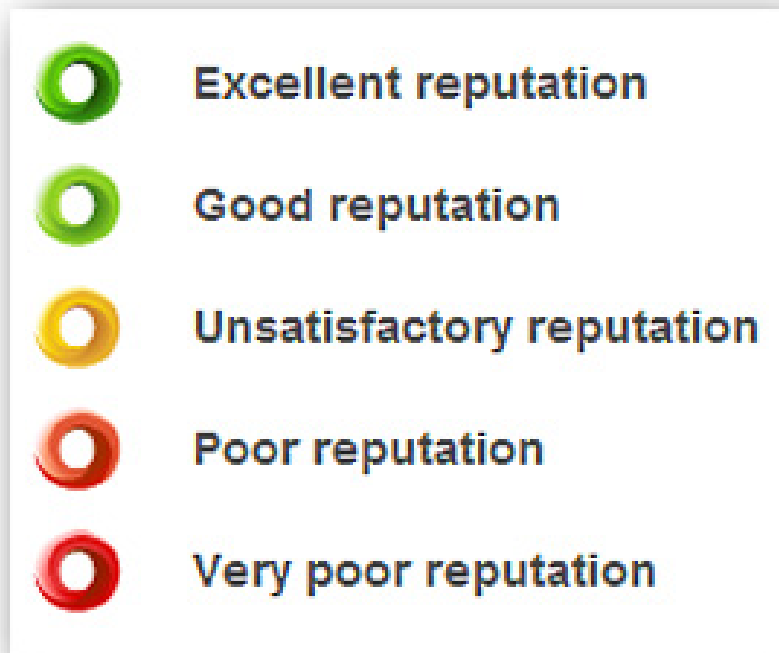


Next, you will be asked to choose to create a WOT account. When registering an account, you can access and use many functions of WOT, besides, you can also rate and evaluate websites directly on the browser.

Note: you can close this window, WOT is still active but you will not be able to use all the features of WOT.



For other browsers like Internet Explorer, Safari, Opera or Google Chrome, the same steps.



The colors above show the classification and ranking mechanism of WOT: green means that the website is reliable, yellow is normal, and red means that the website contains many dangerous, unreliable components. All of the above criteria are contributed by the WOT developer and the user community worldwide.
