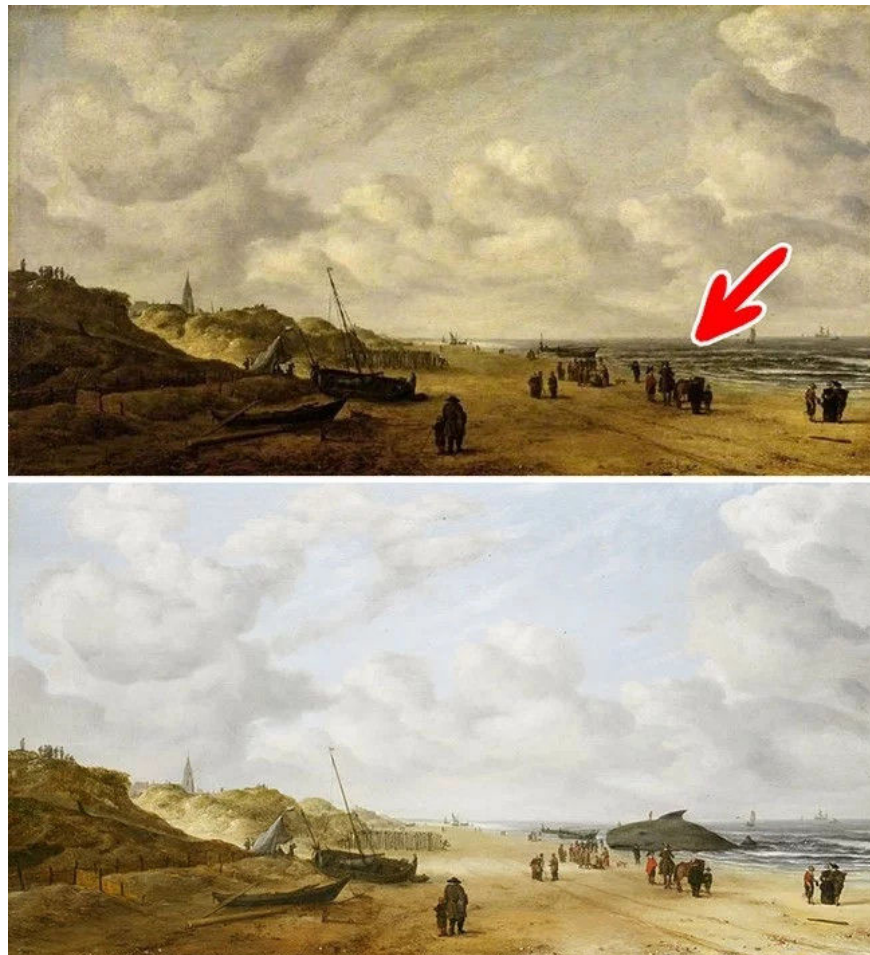


Surprise details no one paid attention to the key to decoding world famous paintings

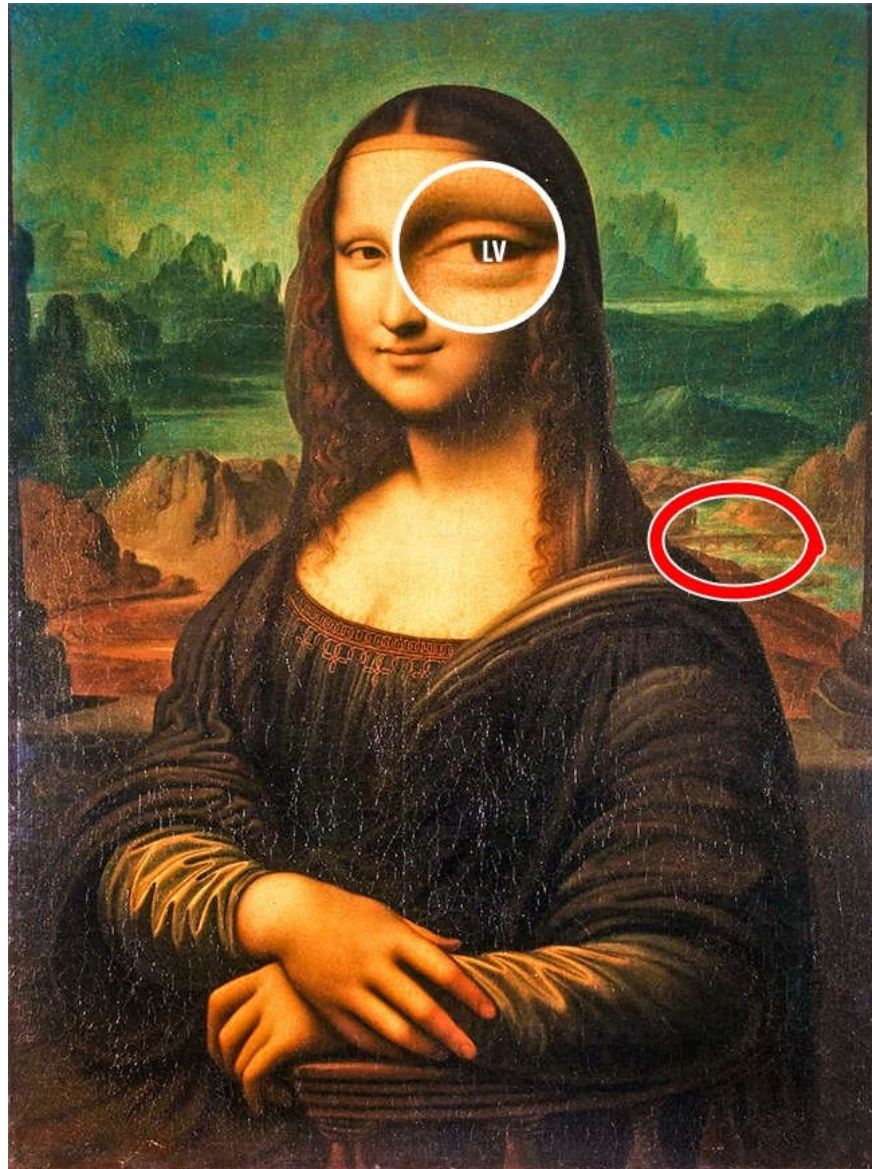

But after the painting was washed and cleaned, a giant whale appeared on the coast. It took 150 years to discover the hidden mystery in this painting.

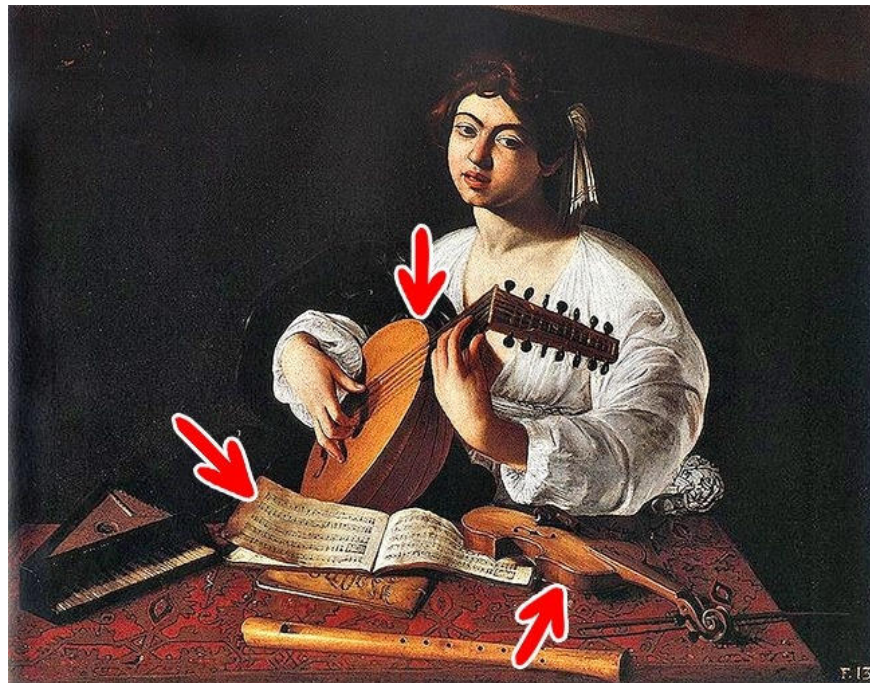
Artist Hendrick van Anthonissen thought that a work without a dead animal would be more popular and closer to the audience, so he concealed the giant whale.

In addition, they found two mysterious numbers 7 and 2 under the bridge in the picture. Many people believe that this may be the detail mentioned in 1472, the original time of the painting bridge in the village of Bobbio in Piacenza (Italy) was destroyed by the flood swept away.

This may be Leonardo da Vinci's suggestion of the scene of the famous painting.



For a long time, the famous painting of Caravaggio painter caused many to argue about the character's true gender. It was not until the early 20th century that art critics relied on musical instruments in the picture of a violin and a lute, a type of male instrument at the time of the Caravaggio painter's life that confirmed the character in the painting. The picture is a man who is composing music.
