

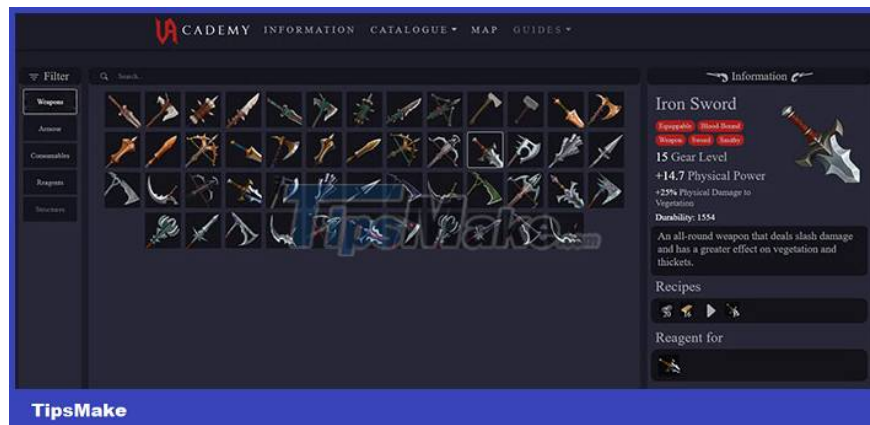
# Survival tips to know when playing V Rising

V Rising is a survival game in which the player plays the role of a vampire awakened from a long slumber. Gamers will explore Vardoran while hunting beasts, expanding their territories and conquering humanity.

Like other survival games, learning the location of the land can be very difficult for new players. Before diving into the enemy's blood, let's learn the survival tips you need to know when playing V Rising to experience the game more interesting and easier.

## Find everything and use specialized tools

V Rising is a survival game that comes with a rich crafting and collecting system. Players will need a variety of materials to build castles, craft equipment, and progress in quests. Therefore, it is very important to collect and hold many resources because they all have a purpose.



Each resource has a tool to help speed up the harvesting process: sword for vegetation, ax for wood, spear for creatures,. However, any weapon can harvest any resource. resource period of that weapon level.

If you don't have enough materials to craft each type of tool, craft your favorite tool or the tool that corresponds to the most needed resource. Pay attention to units with worker blood type as it will increase resource yield and speed up the collection process.

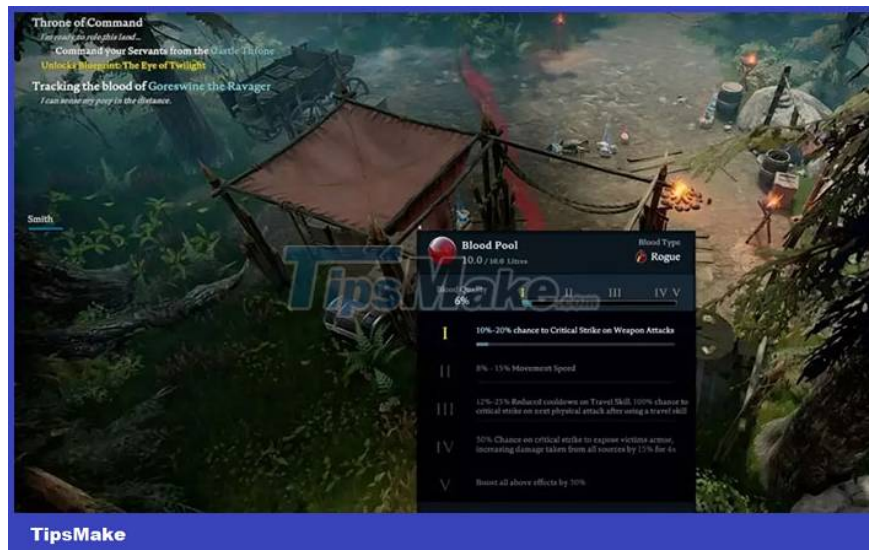


If you're having trouble finding a particular resource, use the map for easy navigation. Hover over each shaded area to see what resources are available in that area.

## Choose your blood type carefully

Blood is what makes the world grow in V Rising. Health passively restores health, keeping the castle steady and empowering vampires.

If the health is depleted, the player will start taking damage over time until there is only one health left. To fill up with blood, gamers need to feed humans or creatures with poor health, or eat the flesh and hearts of mice.



After that, everyone will gain the blood type depending on the enemy, but at the same time lose the currently equipped health type. Each enemy comes with their respective blood type, health quality and buffs as follows:

Blood Type	Benefit
Creature	Increases movement speed, sun resistance, damage reduction, and health recovery
Rogue	Increases critical hit chance and movement speed, and reduces cooldown for Travel Skill

Warrior	Increases physical strength and reduces damage taken and cooldowns of weapon skills
Brute	Increases health regeneration, primary attack speed, and primary damage
Worker	Increases resource output, damage to resources, and increases gallop speed
Scholar	Increases magic power and spells, reduces magic's cooldown
