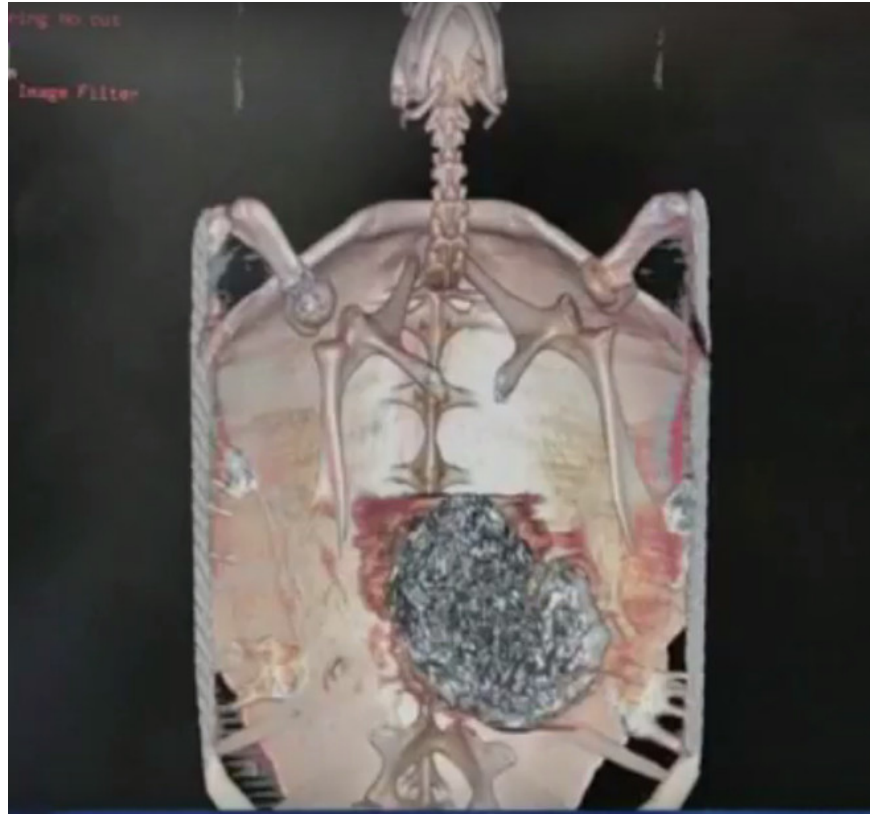
The doctors took him to the hospital to check, the results of the CT scan shocked them. Osmin's stomach is filled with lots of coins.
