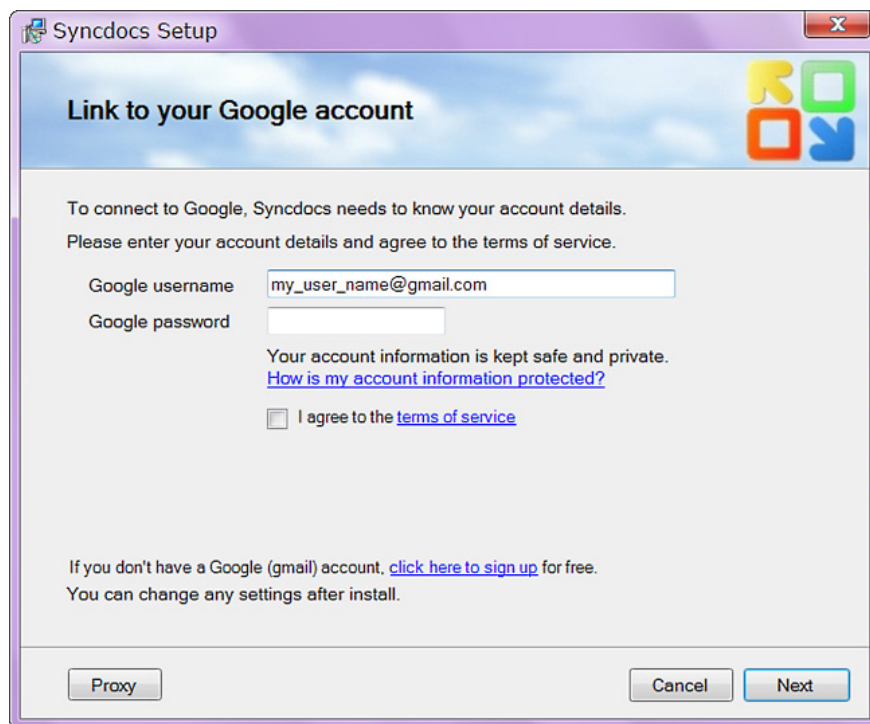


Sync data on computers and Google Docs accounts with SyncDocs

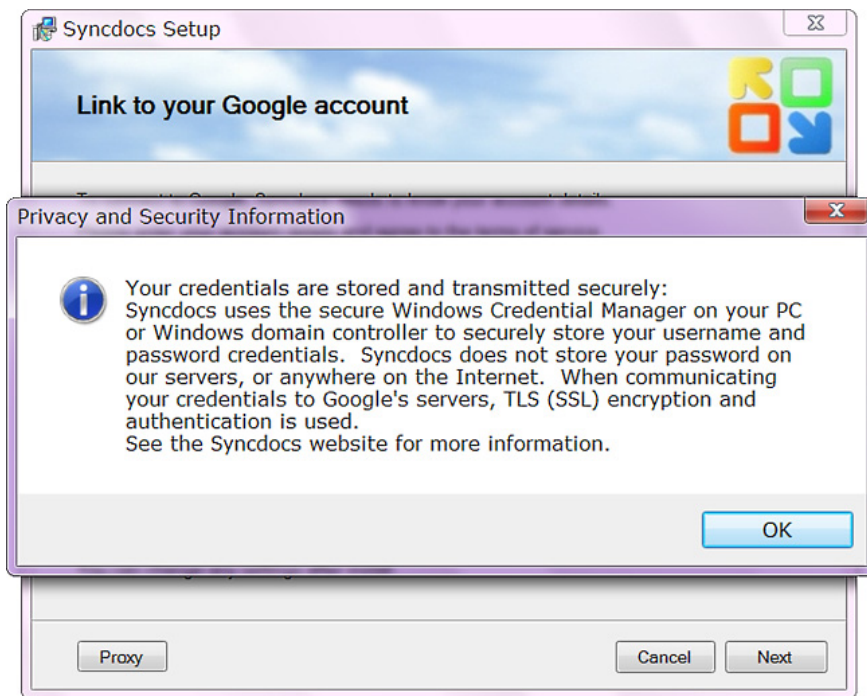

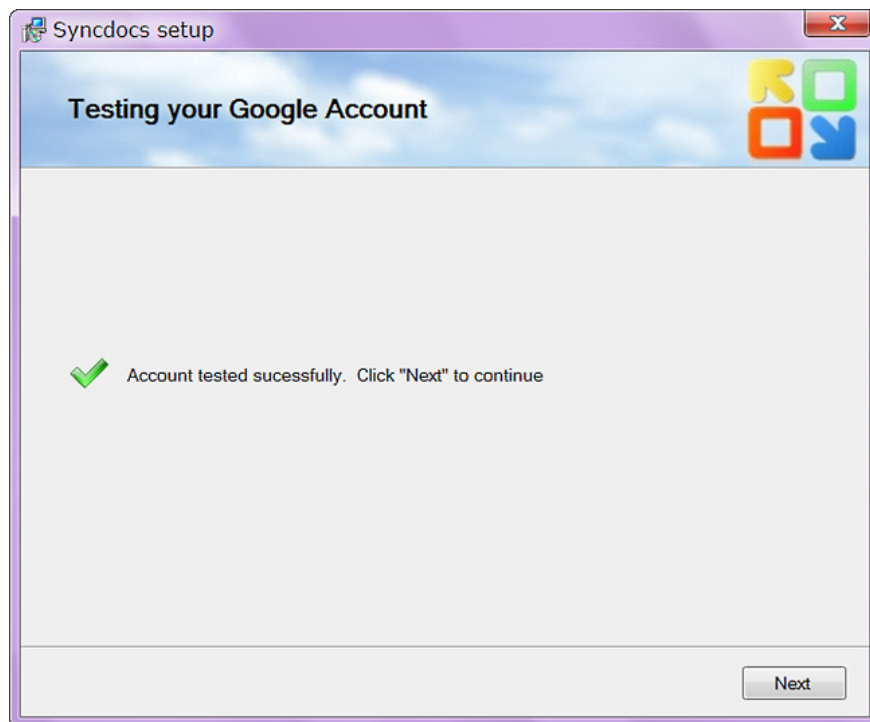
First, please access the above link, download and install the latest version. After finishing this process, we will start setting up the system configuration account:



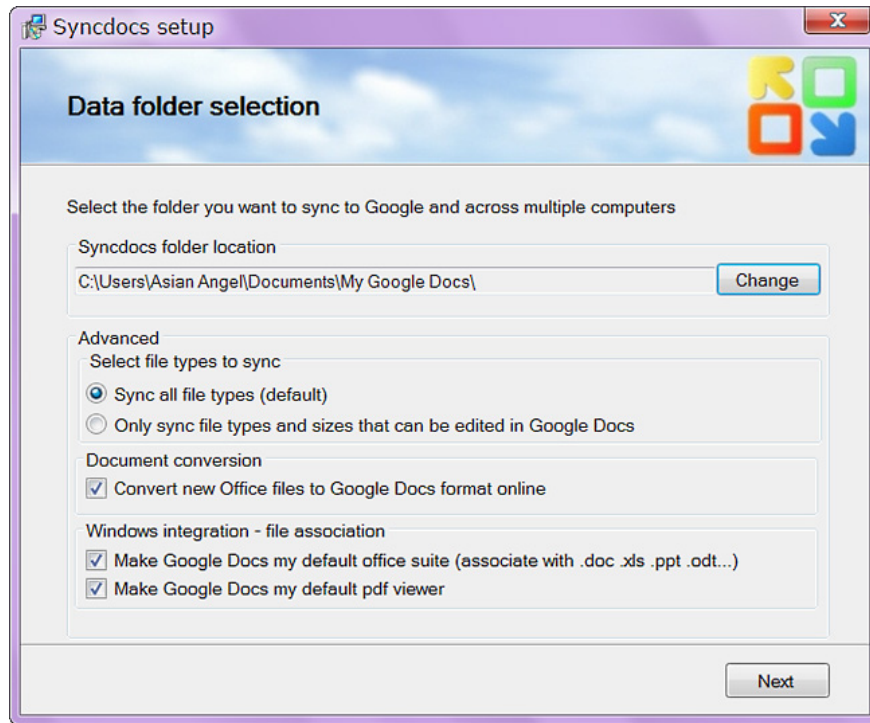
Accept the terms of use agreement developed by the developer:



After providing information of a **Google Account**, **SyncDocs** will conduct the authentication:

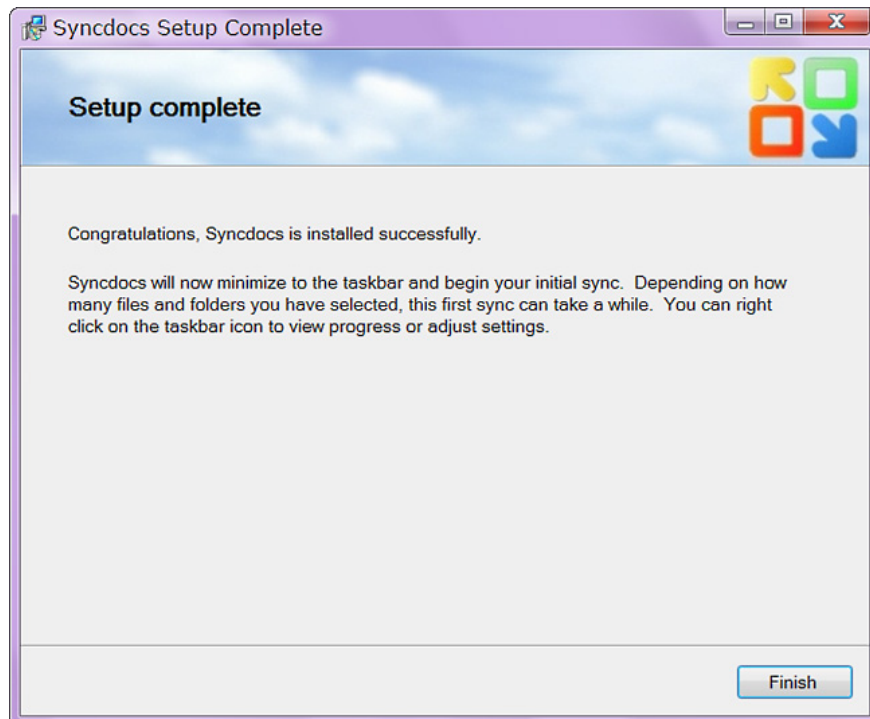


Process The next **Preferences Section** will ask you about the folder on your computer that needs to synchronize, set certain names and files, whether you want to switch back to **Google Docs** format, enable **Windows** compatibility features:

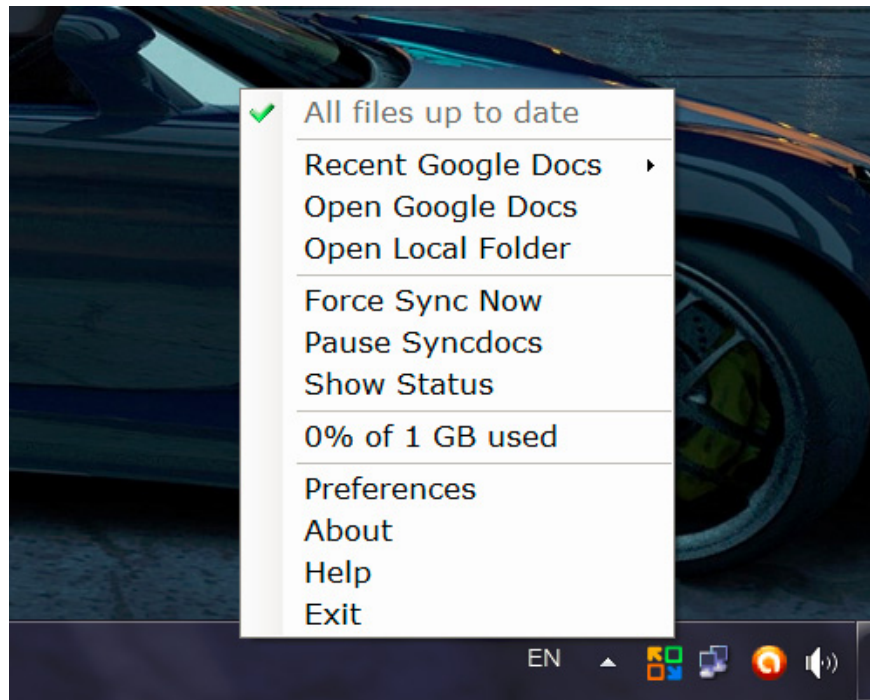


When clicking the Finish button, SyncDocs will start the data synchronization

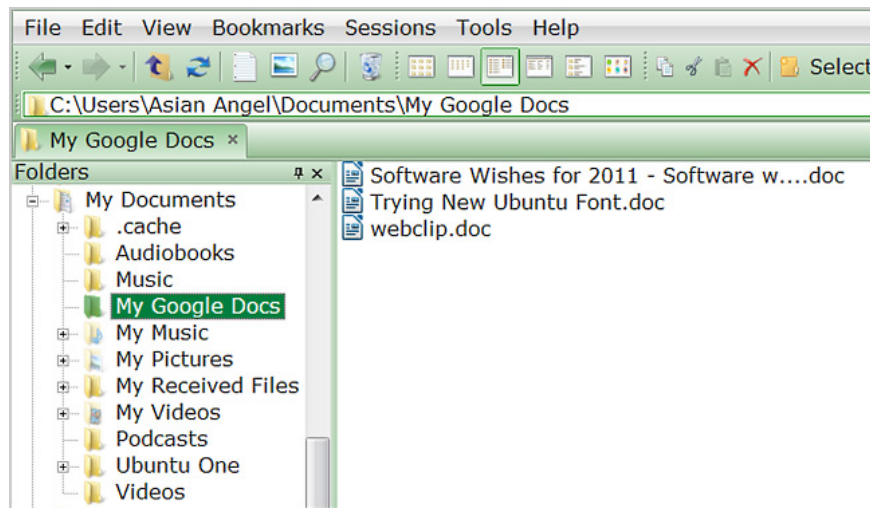
Please note that **SyncDocs** will automatically add the **Windows** boot process immediately after installation:



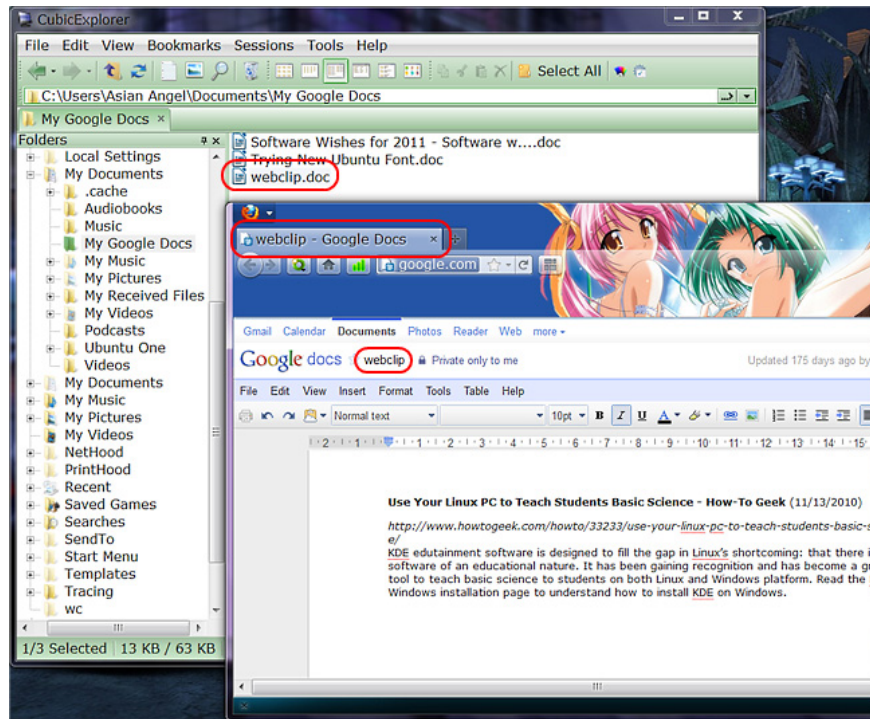
When right-clicking on the program icon under the system tray, we will have the following main functions:



For example, with the selected folder to synchronize data with **Google Docs** on the computer:



If you create, copy or move any file from outside to this folder, immediately a copy will be created on **SyncDocs**. When you choose to set up **Google Docs** as an application to open the default text file, when you double click on any file, the system will automatically open with the browser:

The program works compatible on **Windows 7, Vista, and XP, .Net Framework 3.5 or newer** . At this point, SyncDocs is still in testing and complete. It is expected that in the future, the developer will offer 2 main versions which are free and paid.
