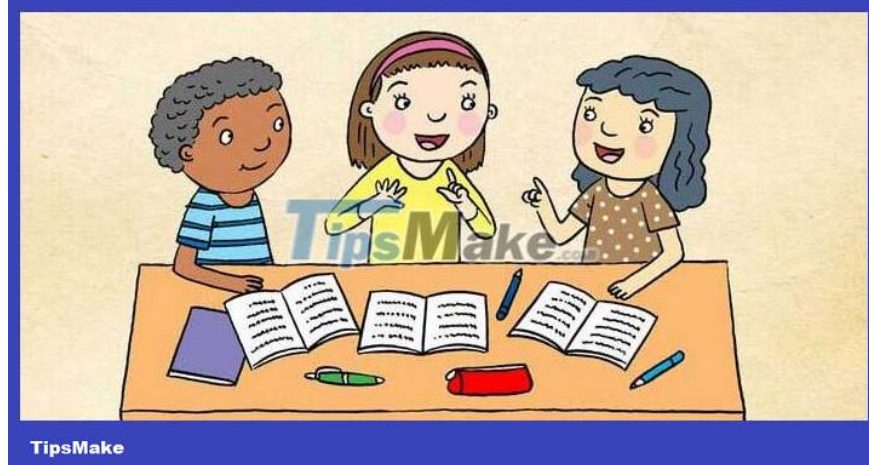
1. What movie or show are you watching lately?
