

# Take beautiful photos on the plane with the following tips

Photos taken from above, especially shot through an airplane window, offer a completely different setting than ordinary photos. So how to create a picture from the plane with the most beautiful and standard angle?

Photos taken from above, especially shot through an airplane window, offer a completely different setting than ordinary photos. Although taking photos through the window on the plane does not require us too much shooting skills, as well as experience but to make the image more sharp, better quality you also need a lot of attention. Join the network administrator with some tips when taking photos from the airplane window.

## 1. Notice the glare of glass:

One of the mistakes of many people when taking this type of photo is that they put their hands or lenses on the glass doors in the hope that they will not be dazzled by the mirror and help them get better when shooting. However, this actually only corrects a part of the anti-glare, while holding the device firmly, this way is completely wrong. It even makes your device shake more because the aircraft when operating will have a lot of vibration.



If you use the camera, it is best to attach a bright speaker to the lens and then bring the lens close to the glass frame. Note not to touch the glass!

If there are no bright speakers, do not worry, use your other hand to cover one side of the lens until you are not dazzled. This method can be applied similarly to smartphones.

## **2. Switch to manual focus mode:**

Not to deny the camera's ability to autofocus is very good now. However, when shooting through the glass door, make sure your device will have difficulty to focus. Therefore, to save time, switch to manual focus mode, everything will be simpler.



For smartphones with manual focus mode, you should also use it to get a better photo. If your device does not have this mode, please force you to "live with the flood" and wait patiently for the device to get the right focus.

## **3. Should be taken early:**

Glass doors will be susceptible to steam clogging or fade away after a long flight time. So to get clear photos, take advantage of taking photos sooner.



## **4. Always wait for the plane to redirect moments:**

Shooting from above to the ground is difficult, but not without a way. Please wait for the plane to tilt to change direction, it is a golden moment for you to have a full view of the ground. Often these moments will happen when the plane has just taken off or is about to land. So remember this and always have the device on hand to take it!

## 5. Turn off Flash:

One of the darkest things when shooting through glass: never turn on Flash on your device, your photos will be completely dazzled!

## 6. Find good photo corners:

Sometimes the scenery outside the airplane window looks magical before the eyes but it doesn't really hold much in us.



If you're too bored with these types of photos, look around, maybe another corner is waiting for you to exploit. For example, an airplane engine, another plane flying nearby, or a sunrise / sunset scene or even what happens inside an airplane can make a good photo if you choose a moment engraving and composition.

Even if you do not need professional photography skills, but if you know more tips to be able to take better pictures, the photos from your plane window will be much more impressive.
