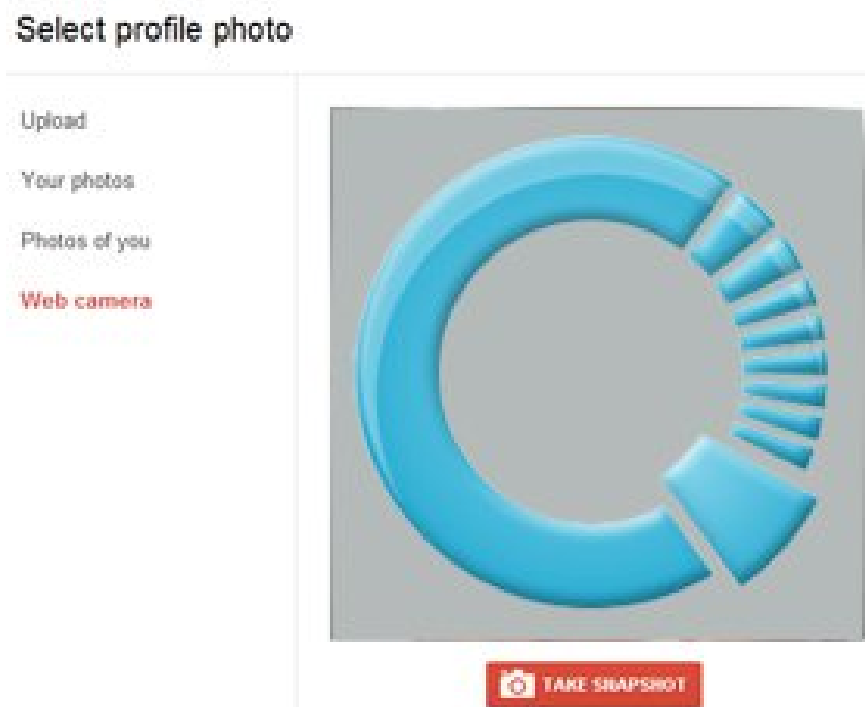


Take photos from webcam to post on Google+ profile
