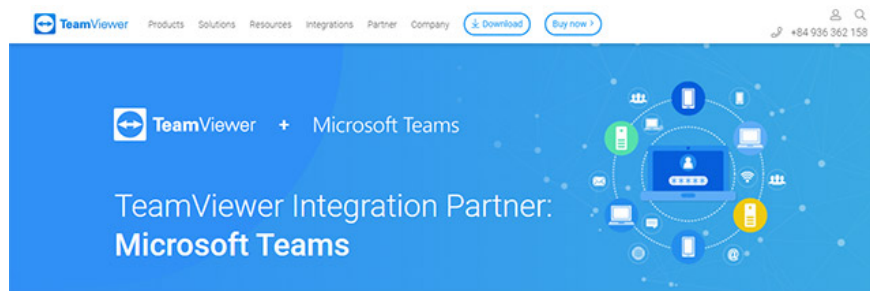


TeamViewer is already integrated with Microsoft Teams
