Always prepare a backup plan

The other option is to use a local backup program to store a second copy of important content, be it on a flash drive or hard drive. However, this method sometimes makes your data easier to

lose because you will have to make sure to carry them with you at all times.

Meanwhile, Google Drive or OneDrive and similar applications are the perfect combination of the two solutions above. With these applications you can not only store and back up all your data online, but you can also access those data and continue working directly wherever you are, copper The data will be automatically re-synchronized with any changes occurring.

Submit exercises in PDF format

Install messaging software from computer

If you use an Android phone, install Android Messages on your phone, then access Messages for web from any web browser on your computer (except Internet Explorer), then follow a few steps Simple guide.

iPhone users can text from their Macs using the built-in Messaging application. Just log in to the Messaging application available on your Mac with Apple ID and you'll be able to read existing messages and send new messages on your iPhone right from your computer.

If your phone or computer does not support such features, you can use a third messaging application such as Zalo, WhatsApp, Telegram, Facebook Messenger or Google Hangouts. All of these applications also allow you to send messages from your computer. Now, you have a big screen to send and receive messages while working, obviously faster and more convenient than unplugging the phone and unlocking to see the message.

Try restarting when the device has problems

Android has Find My Device while the iPhone uses Find My iPhone. With both of these applications, you can not only locate the phone but also let the phone play sound (even if it is muted, vibrate or headset plugged in), electric lock voice or even delete all data on the remote device. However, the key point here is that while those features are really great, you have to actively activate those applications before losing your phone.

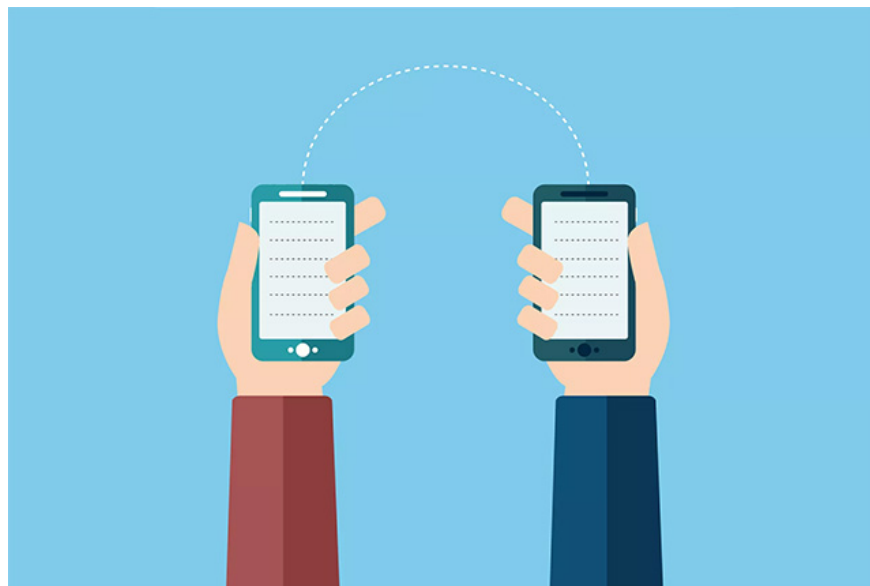
If you are using an Android phone, just have your phone logged in to your Google account, in a state of connecting to Wi-Fi or using mobile data and turn on GPS, you can easily determine Position your phone

through the application above. In other words, you have to leave your phone in a state of getting ready to get lost so you can find it again.

For iPhone, you must turn on the Find My iPhone feature - the feature is required to turn on when you first set up your iPhone, but because this is not a mandatory feature to use iPhone, maybe you can sometimes care about it. Use the online note application

Notes are an indispensable activity for students. There are two main reasons for you to switch to using the online note-taking application instead of the traditional note-taking application or note book: To make sure you don't lose notes if you accidentally lose your device and can leave View and update your notes from any device.



Suppose that in the morning you use a laptop to take notes during class, then in the afternoon you go to the library to do homework but forget about the laptop at home. If you use the online note application, you can get those notes right from your phone after a few seconds.

Similarly, if you are a frequent note-taking person, it is convenient to have all your notes synced to your online account, allowing you to read them even when your phone and device Your laptop is lost. Those notes will still be saved on the internet until you delete them.

Here is a list of some great note-taking apps. In addition, iPhone and iPad users using iCloud can also use iCloud Notes. As long as the notes on your iOS device are backed up with iCloud, you can access them from all your iOS devices as well as from [iCloud.com/notes](https://www.icloud.com/notes). You can even add other people to certain notes, so everyone can see the notes.

Meanwhile, Google Keep is not a bad choice for both Android and iOS users. You can view, edit, create and delete notes from the application and on the Google Keep page. There is also a collaboration feature and a built-in reminder option along with Chrome extensions that make it easy to add online content to your notes.

In addition, there are many free applications to pay for you to choose, can be mentioned as OneNote, Evernote, Simplenote and Bear .

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
