In addition to the sequels of the Control and Alan Wake game series, in the past 2021, Remedy Entertainment also introduced to fans a brand new online co-op shooter project codenamed "Vanguard". .



And recently, this company has achieved an extremely important step in the development of this new game when officially partnering with Tencent - one of the "biggest" with the most blood in the gaming industry. world.



Specifically, Remedy will focus on handling game production and publishing in most regions, while Tencent will handle the localization of the project for release in select countries in the Asian market. Both companies will jointly fund additional development and handle the cost of maintaining the game in their respective regions.



On the Vanguard side, this game is currently being produced using the Unreal Engine toolkit for both PC and console platforms. In addition, Remedy Entertainment will give Tencent the rights to develop and publish the international mobile version of Vanguard.

Remedy Entertainment fan gamers have a lot to look forward to in the near future when a series of potential projects like CrossfireX, Alan Wake 2 will in turn reach the state of being ready for launch.
