Technical specifications



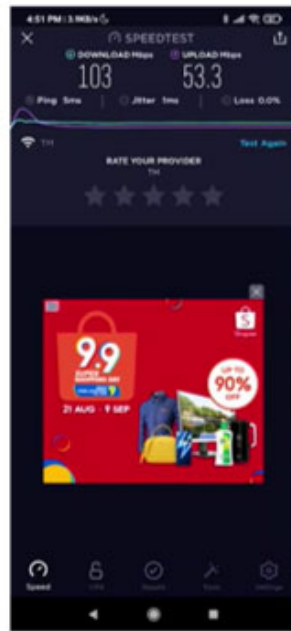
The Tenda AC23 is a powerful router that offers a host of the most sought-after features. Tenda AC23 AC2100 is a dual band Gigabit wireless router, therefore it works on both 2.4GHz and 5GHz bands. It features 802.11 ac Wave2 and can deliver speeds up to 2033Mbps (300Mbps for the 2.4GHz band and 1733Mbps for the 5GHz band).

The router has a great feature that is very useful in today's era, MU-MIMO 4 × 4 for the 5GHz band. MU-MIMO means 'Multiple User - Multiple Input, Multiple Output'. With the help of this feature, you can connect multiple devices simultaneously to this router and won't have any lag issues. You can play games or watch movies without interruption.

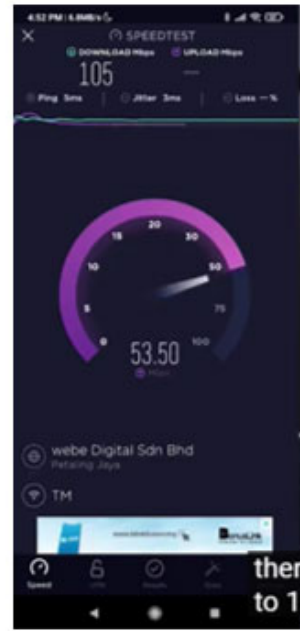
The 7 6dBi antennas also provide wider range and help for wall-to-wall transmission.

The router is equipped with Gigabit ports allowing up to 1000Mbps transmission capacity. That means it won't clog your connection.

With this feature, you can add a time limit to any gadget associated with the router and can block harmful websites for every connected gadget. This is a pretty good feature for parents / guardians who want their kids to be safe online.

Efficiency

After reviewing this wireless router and checking its hardware specifications, it can be said that the Tenda AC23 has the good features one would expect for an uninterrupted WiFi experience. Additionally, it has some of the top features that routers at this price point generally don't have. It is suitable for a household with at most 15 devices connected at the same time.

You can simultaneously play online games with steady ping while the other 2 TVs are streaming Netflix or YouTube. The most important software feature this router has is bandwidth control, meaning you can set the maximum upstream / downstream speed for each connected device, to provide more bandwidth for the devices. really need it.
