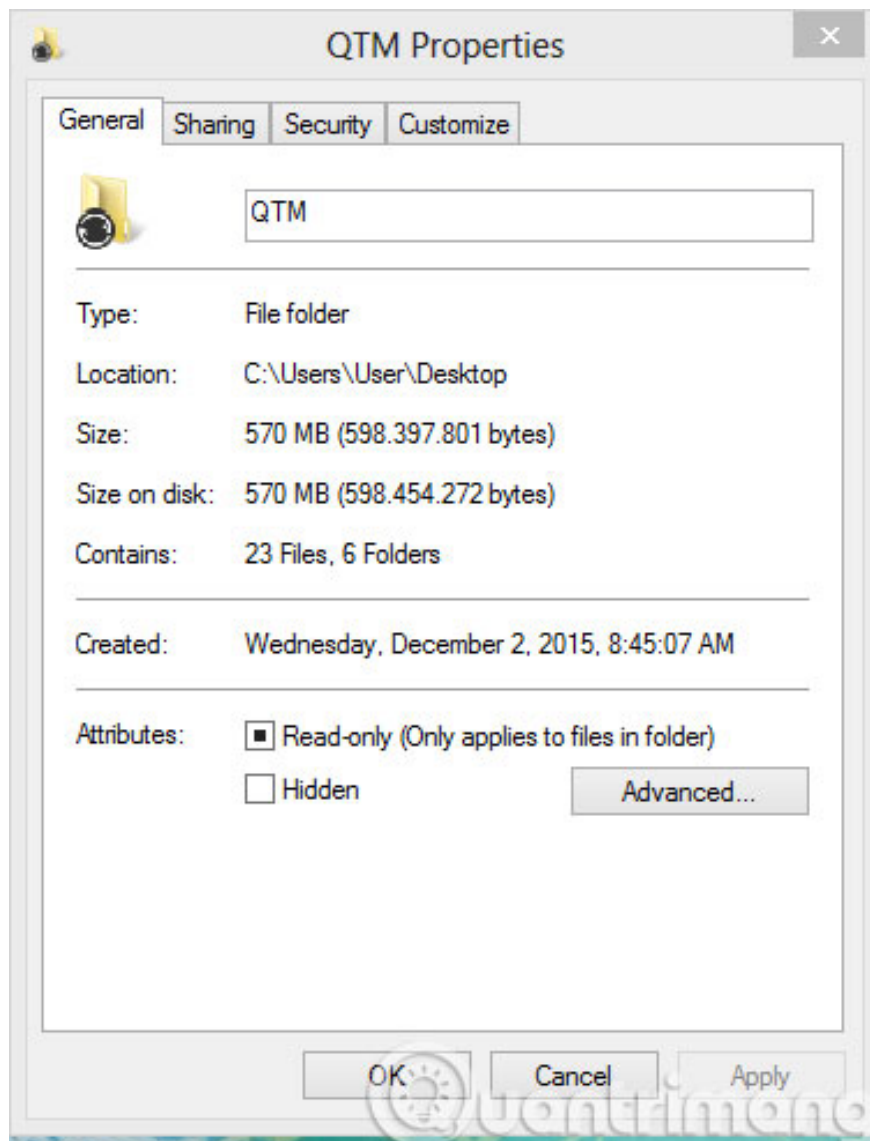


Test evaluation of 2 WinRar and 7Zip compression tools

Currently there are 2 tools of compression and decompression that are rated equally with each other are WinRar and 7Zip. Have you ever wondered which software is better? 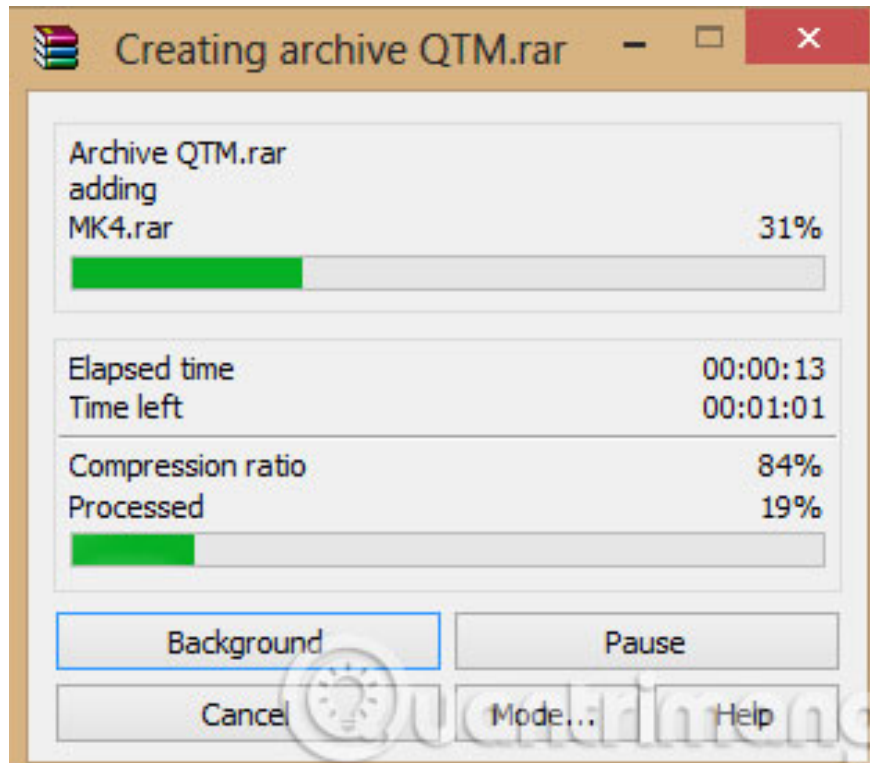
Currently there are 2 compression and decompression tools that are rated "equally powerful" each other are **WinRar** and **7Zip** . Have you ever wondered which software is better? Of course, all comparisons are lame because each software has its advantages and disadvantages. Let's TipsMake.com try doing the test with 2 tools offline.

Here, we use a file of **570 MB** for testing

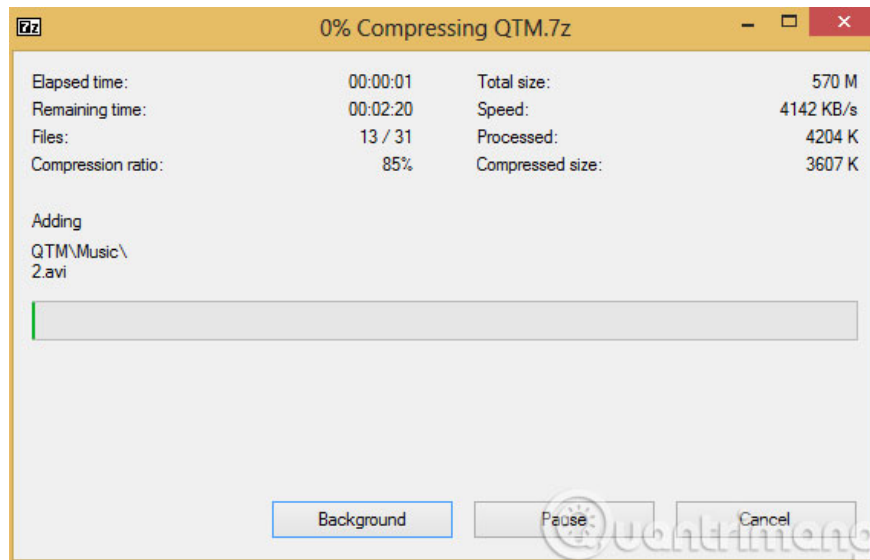


1. File compression speed

WinRAR 's 570MB file compression time is **1 minute 18 seconds**

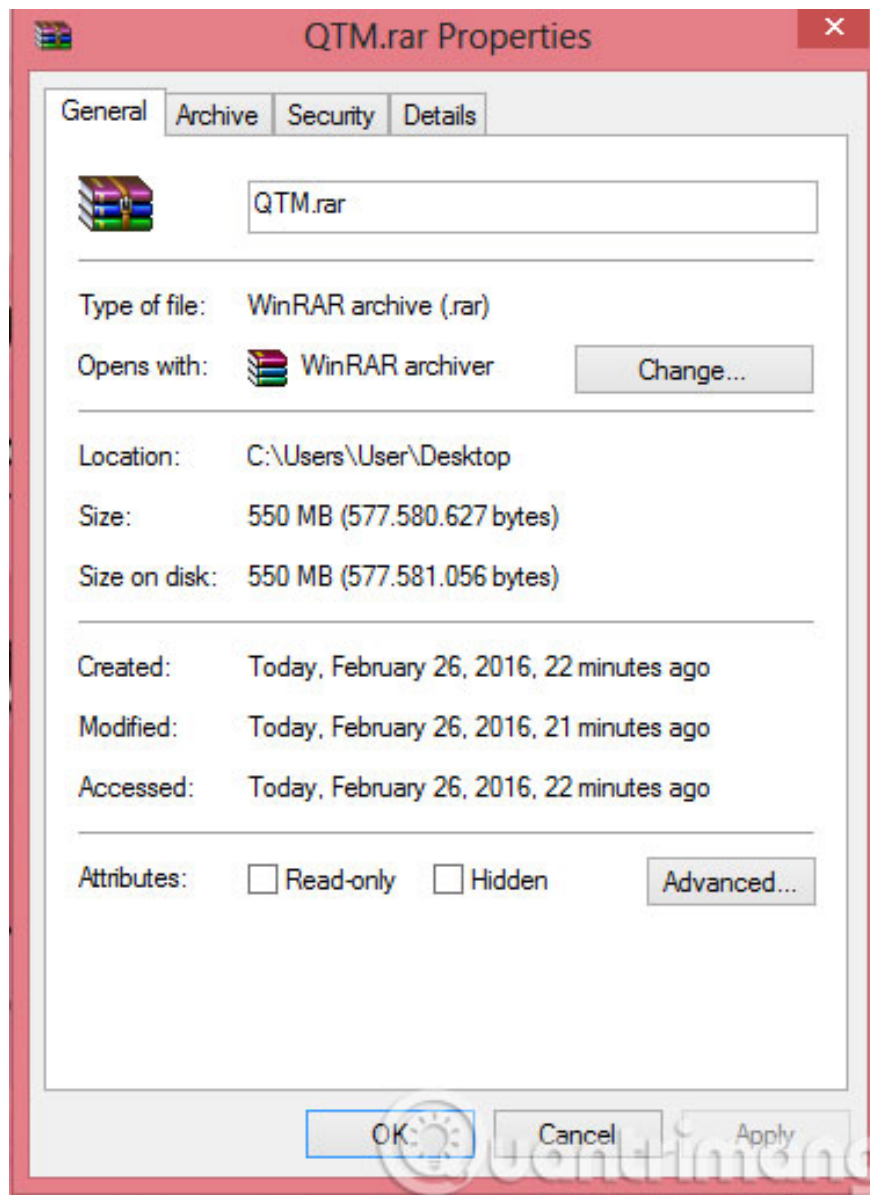


The **570MB** file compression time of **7Zip** is **2 minutes 21 seconds**

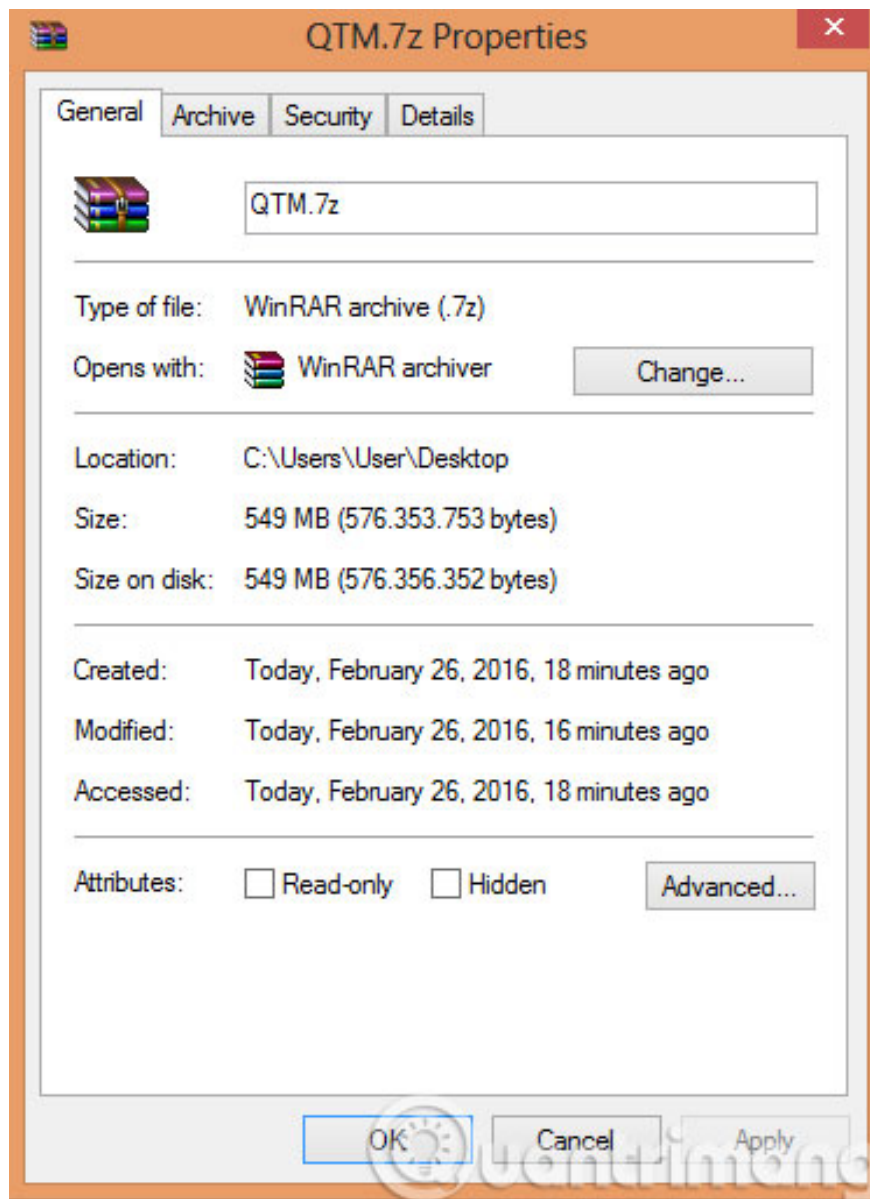


2. Quality of file compression

The file size after compression with **WinRAR** is **550MB** (original file 570MB)



And the file size after compression with **7Zip** is **549MB** (original file 570MB)



In summary, the 570 MB file compression test can draw conclusions: in terms of speed, WinRAR is proving to be "dominant" but in terms of quality, 7Zip is a little better. Therefore, depending on the need to use or you are familiar with which software you choose for yourself the right software.
