

# Textify tool copies all content on Windows

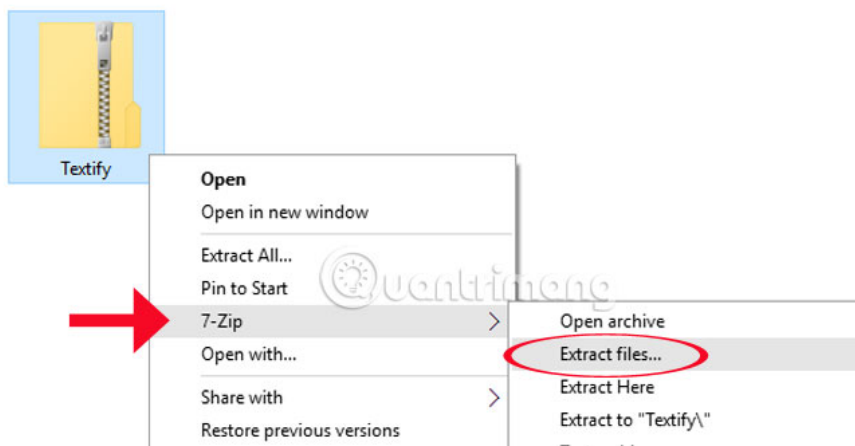

Not only does it support copying text content, but the software will help users copy all the content in the bulletin boards, machine information, etc. that appear on Windows. ## Step 1:

First you need to download the Textify tool to your computer using this link.

## Step 2:

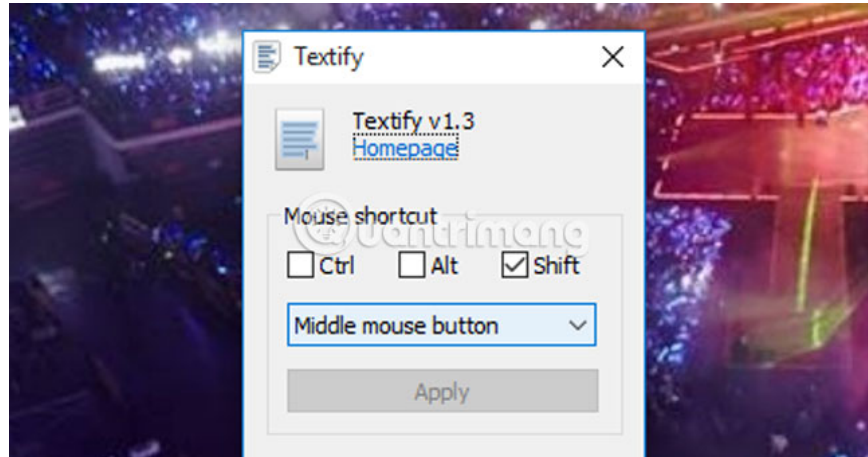
**Extract the downloaded file** Textify.



## Step 3:

Tools are portable, very small, so we can save them on any screen, or any folder. Can be run directly without installing on the computer.

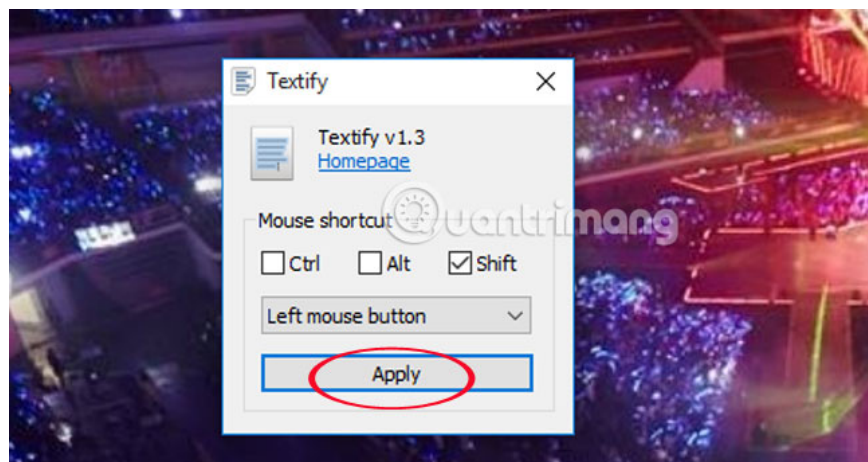
The interface of the program as shown below.



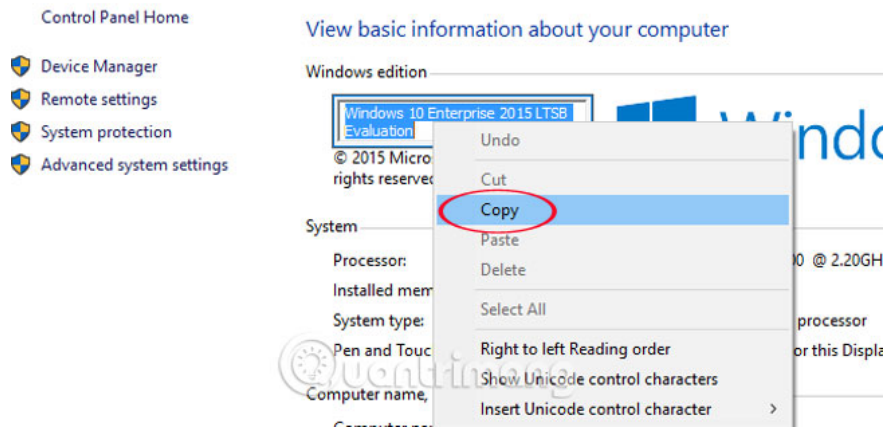
Textify provides **shortcut keys** including **Ctrl** , **Alt** , **Shift** , **left mouse**, **right mouse** or **scroll** .

## Step 4:

To copy a certain segment, press **Shift + left mouse button** , or you can optionally adjust the other combination according to the user and click **Apply** to set the new key combination.



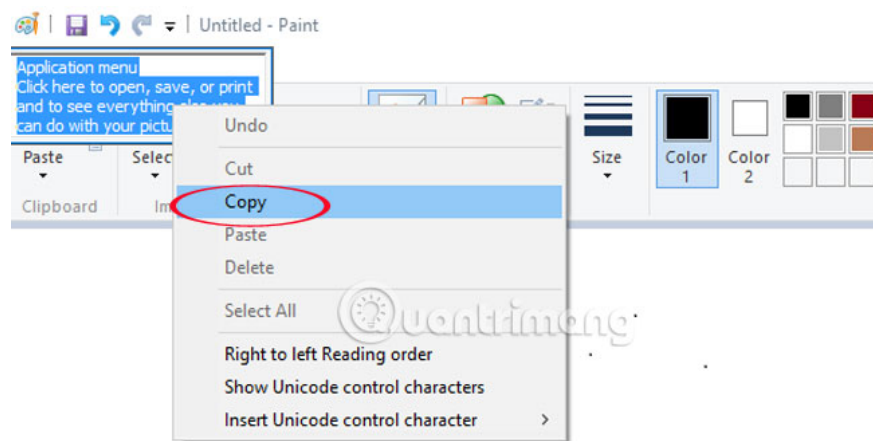
After blackening the content, click **Copy and Paste** as usual.



## Step 5:

With a long piece of content, use the mouse to drag the green rectangle over the content to copy.

With Clipboard, press **Ctrl + C**.



Thus, only with the compact Textify tool, users can copy every content they want, even if the content does not allow copying on Windows. If there is no need to use it, users can hide the tool on the computer and call out whenever needed. Too convenient, isn't it!
