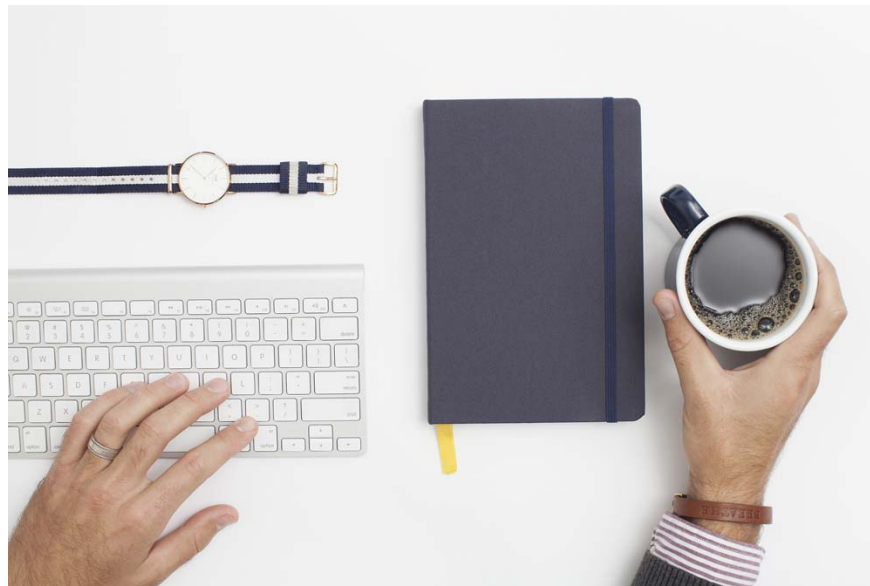


The 10 best 'jobs' are available only to those who know a foreign language

3. Community Representative (Community Representative)

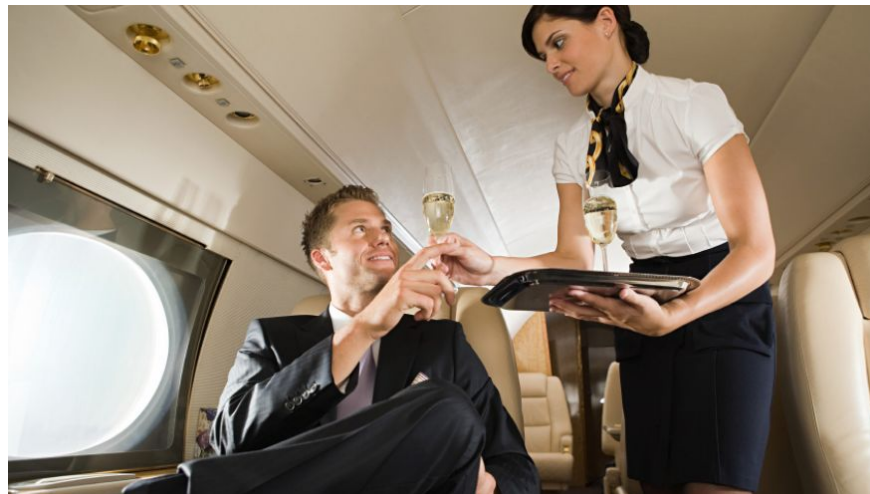
Field : Games / Business
