Nokia 3310 (2000)

Nokia 3310 is rated as a durable device, classified as 'stone pot'. It has brought a fever to change the phone case.



Nokia 3310 (2017)



The Nokia 33 version of the 2017 version is still a simple feature phone, but has a slimmer body, upgraded to a color screen, and is even about to be upgraded with 4G technology!

Nokia 6310 (2001)



With a pretty professional look, the 6310, 6310i or 6210 (a similarly-shaped phone, which came out before) is very much loved by business people. Users can personalize the device by replacing plastic pieces at the bottom of the machine. The 6310i can connect three bands and has a backlight display.

Nokia Lumia 1020 (2013)



This is the last Lumia used by Nokia before being taken over by Microsoft. Nokia 1020 is a cameraphone running Windows Phone 8, equipped with PureView Pro camera with 41-megapixel image sensor.

Nokia 808 Pureview (2012)



808 is the first Nokia phone equipped with PureView Pro technology but also the last smartphone to run Nokia's Symbian.

Nokia 1280 (2010)



In 2010, Nokia continued to release the Nokia 1280 super dual band GSM phone despite the fact that the smartphone has grown so strongly.

Nokia N-Gage (2002)



This is a device that combines mobile phones, but does not receive the support of gamers.

Nokia N95 (2007)



When launched, the Nokia N95 is considered a true smart phone because it is equipped with Wi-Fi, Bluetooth and 3G connections. But that also causes its battery to drain very quickly and is forced to charge the battery regularly.

Nokia N81 (2007)



This is a portable gaming device and is the only N-Gage 2.0 device equipped with special buttons for the game.

Nokia 5300 (2006)



The 5300 belongs to the XpressMusic line, the phone is designed to listen to music of Nokia.

Nokia N70 (2005)



N70 is a 3G mobile phone, belonging to Nokia's multimedia product line.

Nokia 6280 (2005)



It is also a Nokia 3G phone with a slider design and is equipped with a 2.2-inch TFT color screen.

Nokia 3250 (2005)



With a unique twist design, the Nokia 3250 is one of Nokia's most exotic mobile phones.

Nokia 1100 (2005)



This is a basic GSM mobile phone. Nokia 1100 is the most popular phone in the world in 2011 with 250 million users.

Nokia 8800 (2005)



A prominent slider phone at the time with stainless steel cover and scratch-resistant screen.

Nokia N90 (2005)



The N90 stands out because it can transform the device into 4 different uses thanks to a dedicated joint.

Nokia 7710 (2005)



This is Nokia's first touchscreen smartphone with a separate plastic stylus hidden in the lower right corner of the screen.

Nokia 7280 (2004)



With a lipstick design, no keyboard, a screen that can turn into a mirror when needed, the Nokia 7280 is the most unique phone ever.

Nokia 7600 (2004)



With the teardrop-shaped design, the Nokia 7600 can be replaced with the aim of targeting the fashion market.

Nokia 3300 (2003)



This is a music phone, with a nice QWERTY keyboard.

Nokia 5100 (2002)



It is equipped with a fairly colorful rubber cover and integrated FM Stereo.

Nokia 6800 (2002)



The 6800 is equipped with a fold-in QWERTY keyboard that opens up to look quite monstrous.

Nokia 3600/3650 (2002)



3600/3650 has a strong impression on users by being equipped with a fancy circular keyboard. This is also the first phone in North America to have an integrated camera.

Nokia 5510 (2001)



5510 is equipped with extremely large internal memory of up to 64MB for storing audio files, an impressive number in 2001.

Nokia 7650 (2001)



This is the first smartphone from Nokia running Symbian operating system.

Nokia 8210 (1999)



At the time of its launch in 1999, the 8210 was its smallest, lightest phone.

Nokia 7110 (1999)



7110 is the first mobile phone with a WAP browser. It was used by actor John Travolta in the action movie Swordfish so it is also called the 'Swordfish phone'.

Nokia 3210 (1999)



3210 is one of the most popular and successful phones in history. This is Nokia's first mobile phone with a colorful and changeable cover.

Nokia 5110 (1998)



5110 is one of the first phones to have the addictive game of Snakes!

Nokia 9000 Communicator (1996)



This is a famous texting phone used by many famous actors in movies.

Nokia 8110 (1996)



8110 is the first phone designed by Nokia in the form of a sliding keyboard. It is nicknamed "banana phone" due to its curved shape.

Nokia 1011 (1993)



This is the first GSM phone to be mass produced.

Nokia Cityman (1987)



Cityman is one of the first compact phones in the world. This is the phone used by Mikhail Gorbachev - the leader of the Soviet Union - to call back to Moscow in a press conference.

Nokia Mobira Talkman (1985)



Mobira Talkman phones are manufactured and distributed by Nokia from 1985 to 1992. The phone is quite heavy and bulky.
