1. Samsung Neo 4K QN90C



Neo 4K QN90C is the latest design of the QLED line at Samsung. It offers some interesting improvements over its predecessor, the QN90B, the most obvious of which is image quality. In fact, it challenges the picture standards set by OLED and beats them in terms of brightness.

The QN90C comes in a variety of sizes from 43 inches to a whopping 85 inches. The smaller 43- and 50-inch models get VA panels, while the larger models switch to IPS-ADS. The large screen provides a wider viewing angle, ideal for family movie night or watching football with the neighbors on Sunday.

Combined with the TV's excellent peak brightness and superior anti-glare coating, you also won't need to worry about having to draw the curtains on sunny afternoons.

2. TCL Q650G 4K

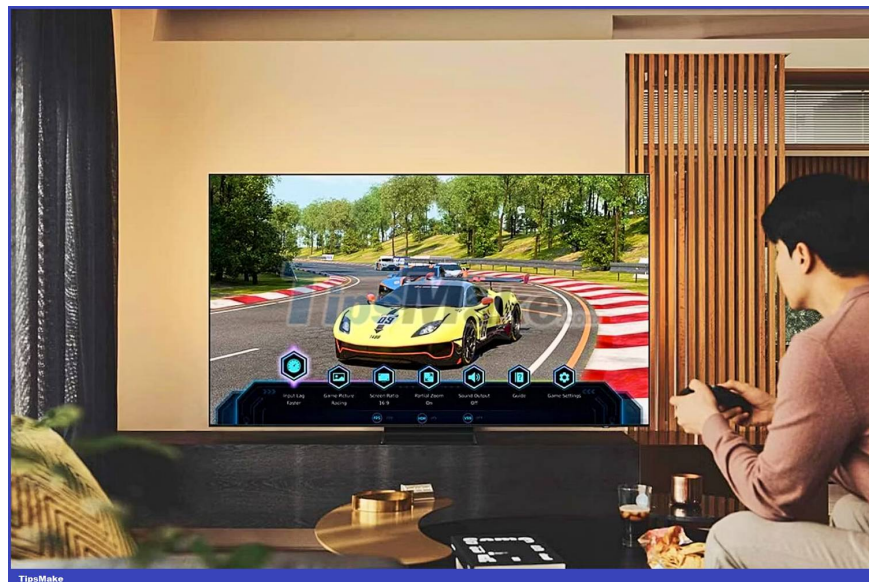


If you can overlook some of the complicated features, you're in for a real bargain with the TCL Q650G. Good brightness, surprisingly deep black levels and a wide color gamut, this TV offers excellent value.

Even though it doesn't have HDMI 2.1, it's still a decent choice for gamers. You can play 120Hz games in Full HD while enjoying extremely low input lag, pleasing those who care more about performance than the best possible picture quality.

With good response times, this is also a great choice for sports fans. Motion blur when watching fast action is barely noticeable. However, people may have to squeeze a bit on the couch when watching big matches due to this TV's average viewing angle.

3. Samsung Neo QLED 4K QN90B



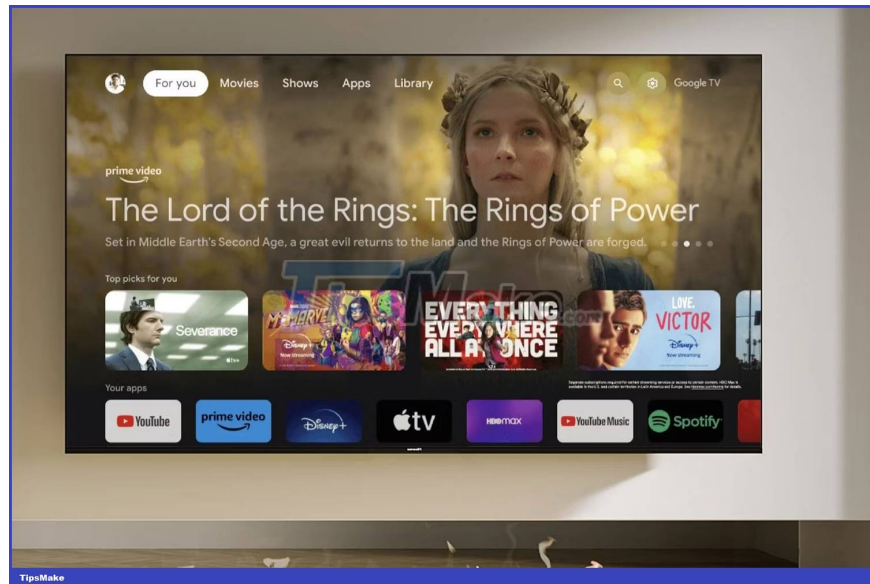
There isn't much difference between the Samsung QN90B and its new sibling, the QN90C. Both are great options for gaming, but with this TV's high peak brightness and slightly cheaper price, gamers can play in

brighter conditions, enjoy highlights and Save a little money in the process.

With ultra-fast response times and low input lag, support for all three VRR formats, and four HDMI 2.1 ports (one with eARC) for next-gen 4K/120Hz gaming, it's an ideal choice. .

However, movie lovers can also enjoy this TV. With incredible color diversity and excellent local dimming that delivers outstanding contrast, the picture quality is superior to most other QLED TVs.

4. Hisense U8K ULED 4K



While Samsung typically offers the best QLED TVs, it only supports the company's proprietary HDR technologies HDR10 and HDR10+. So one advantage other QLED TV manufacturers have over Samsung is support for Dolby Vision content, which is considered by many to be the ultimate HDR format. If watching movies is your primary concern, you may want to consider this option.

The Hisense U8K not only delivers pristine brightness, contrast, and color, but also comes at a pretty attractive price. And, if you're on a budget, there's a 100-inch option to keep you immersed while watching blockbuster movies. Gamers, including Xbox Series X and PS5 users, can also get in on the action with 4K/120Hz, VRR, and ALLM support.

5. Samsung Neo QLED 8K QN900C



Although there still isn't too much content to watch on the QLED 8K TV, the upscaling capabilities that the Samsung QN900C brings are truly outstanding. This TV delivers everything, including stunning brightness, true-to-life colors, outstanding brightness, deep contrast and of course the level of detail that only 8K can deliver. You also get an extremely wide viewing angle so the whole family can enjoy movie night from anywhere in the room.

It is available in two large sizes, 65 and 75 inches. However, the price is quite high and all Samsung TVs still do not support Dolby Vision.
