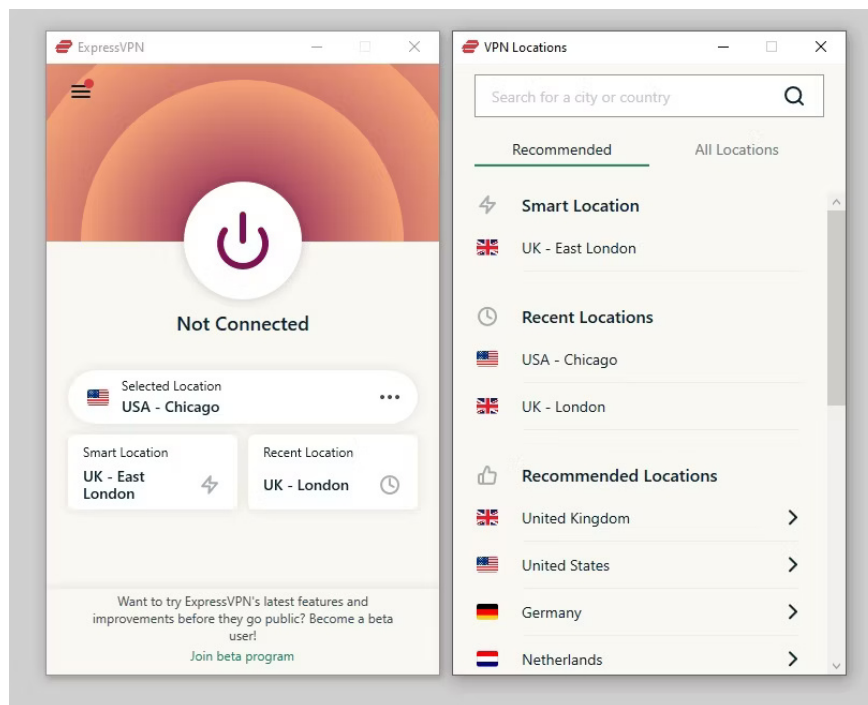

1. ExpressVPN : 30-day free trial, money-back guarantee.



Many VPNs offer free trials based on a money-back guarantee if you're not satisfied. One example of this type of trial is ExpressVPN. The VPN giant promises that after you sign up, *"If you're not satisfied, we'll refund your payment. No hassle, no risk . "*

This is a very attractive promise. ExpressVPN offers over 3,000 servers in more than 100 countries. ExpressVPN has unlimited bandwidth, an app for almost any device, top-quality encryption, and you can stream Netflix and download torrents. See the ExpressVPN review for more details. Importantly, ExpressVPN's 30-day money-back trial has no feature limitations.

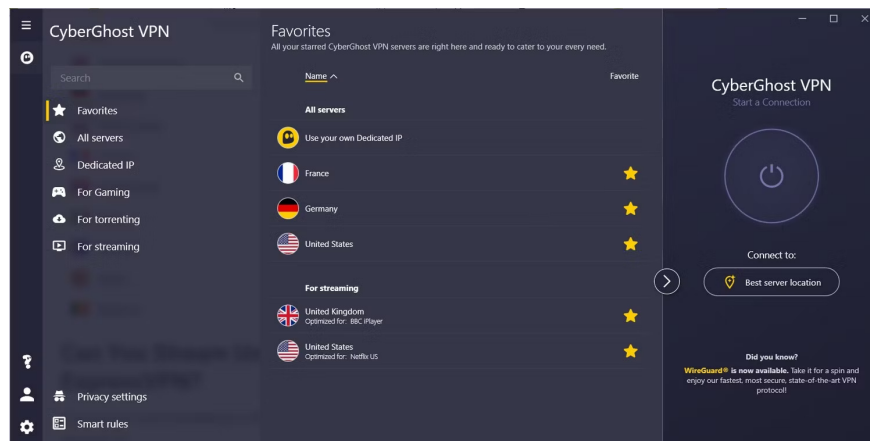


Like its main competitor, ExpressVPN, NordVPN offers a 30-day trial, so users can enjoy its features without risk.

Boasting over 6,400 servers in 111 countries and allowing up to 6 simultaneous connections, NordVPN has a no-logging policy. It also features a function called "Double VPN"—an enhanced security feature that encrypts data twice. This is an optional feature that can be enabled when required.

Fast and ideal for streaming and P2P video sharing, NordVPN has apps for almost every device you can think of. Take advantage of NordVPN's 30-day trial and see what they have to offer.

3. CyberGhost: Free trial available.



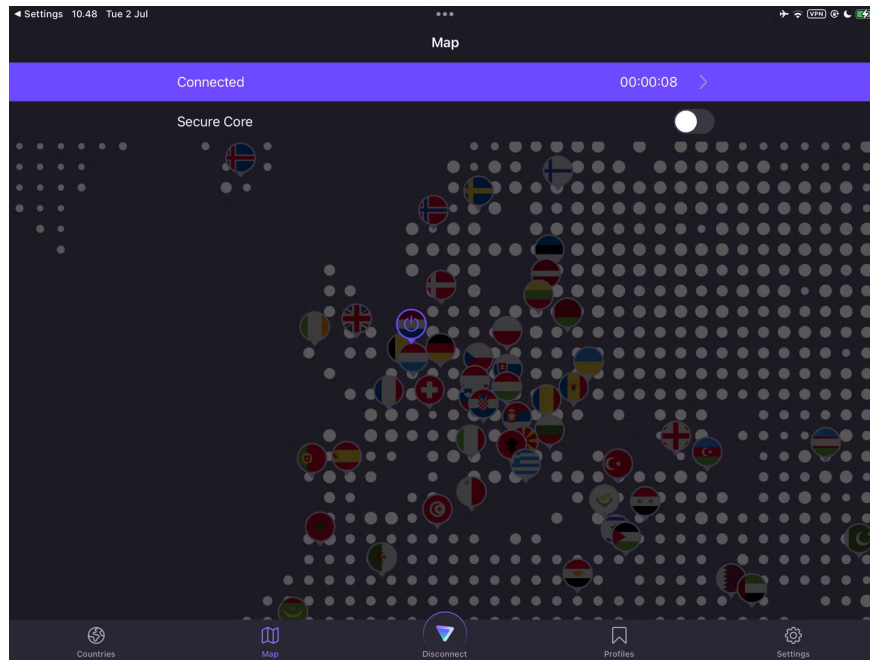
Unlike other VPN providers mentioned so far, CyberGhost offers a genuine free trial. If you're looking for a free VPN trial that doesn't require a credit card, this is the ideal option; most other services will at least require you to register a bank card before you can access the free trial.

Despite limitations, you can use a free one-day trial of CyberGhost and access the VPN server for streaming and torrenting.

CyberGhost divides its servers by purpose. So, some are optimized for streaming Netflix; others for BBC iPlayer. CyberGhost has servers better suited for torrenting, while the general-purpose servers for web browsing are encoded using standard encryption.

With over 6,100 servers, apps for most platforms, and simultaneous connections on up to 7 devices, CyberGhost is a great VPN. Try CyberGhost VPN before signing up.

4. ProtonVPN: Free trial, 30-day money-back guarantee.

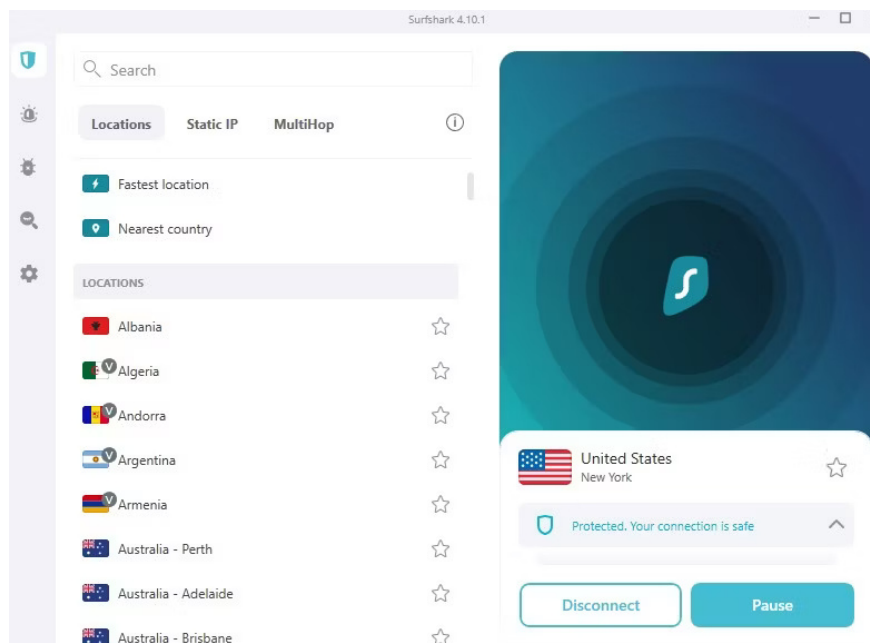


Unsure about signing up for a VPN? ProtonVPN offers two options for experiencing online encryption.

First, there's the free option for one device with limited usage by ProtonVPN. This gives you the chance to try the VPN at average speeds and choose from 3 servers per device. ProtonVPN also features Quick Connect, which quickly connects you to the most ideal server location.

ProtonVPN also offers a 30-day money-back trial. This gives you the chance to try the full ProtonVPN experience without any long-term commitment. If you subscribe to the full version of ProtonVPN, you'll have access to over 5,700 servers across 90 countries. Furthermore, you can use the VPN on up to 10 devices.

5. Surfshark: Free trial, 30-day money-back guarantee.



Another VPN you should consider is Surfshark, which offers a free trial and a 30-day money-back guarantee.

Surfshark offers apps for almost every device you can think of with unlimited connectivity. It allows torrenting and whitelisting (ideal for accessing banking websites and apps), but not ideal for streaming video. You also have access to over 3,000 servers spread across 100 countries.

Encryption is only one side of a VPN. You might need a service that helps bypass some form of censorship. That means you might not need a VPN at all. After all, online proxy servers can help you view blocked websites. Whether restricted by the government, workplace restrictions, or by the institution where you study or reside, websites can be unblocked without a VPN.

There are several proxy servers available here to help you. But be careful: many proxy websites are essentially unreliable. If you want to ensure you're not putting yourself at risk, you can create your own online proxy server in minutes.

In many cases, you can use a proxy if your goal is to bypass censorship rather than encrypt your online activity. You can learn about the difference between proxies and VPNs in a separate guide. If you can't find a VPN trial that suits you, luckily, there are several free VPNs available without a trial. While their features are limited, they offer encrypted browsing to enhance online privacy. You can also use VPNs that don't require registration or anonymity, but the features in these VPNs are often more limited compared to others.

How to choose a reliable VPN provider

The primary purpose of a VPN is to hide your most private data from prying eyes. Internet users should ensure that their VPN does not store their data. Today, most VPN providers claim that they do not keep any logs. However, this is not always true. Therefore, carefully reading the privacy policy of a VPN service is extremely important.

Reliable customer service

Unfortunately, this factor is often overlooked despite its importance. You should choose a VPN with 24/7 customer service. Resolving issues via email can take hours, so a VPN that offers live chat is a must.

Large number of servers

One of the deciding factors when choosing a provider is the number of servers it owns. If someone plans to travel or live in a sparsely populated country, it is extremely important to choose a VPN with servers located nearby.



Payment methods

For those who value online privacy, payment methods play a crucial role. Some VPN providers offer anonymous payment methods such as Bitcoin or gift cards. If price is an issue, consider using a VPN with a discount policy. A money-back guarantee is a great way to ensure you can opt out of using the VPN if you're not satisfied with

the service.

Of course, there are other factors to consider such as connection speed, interface, and supported platforms. First, new users should figure out what they need a VPN for.
