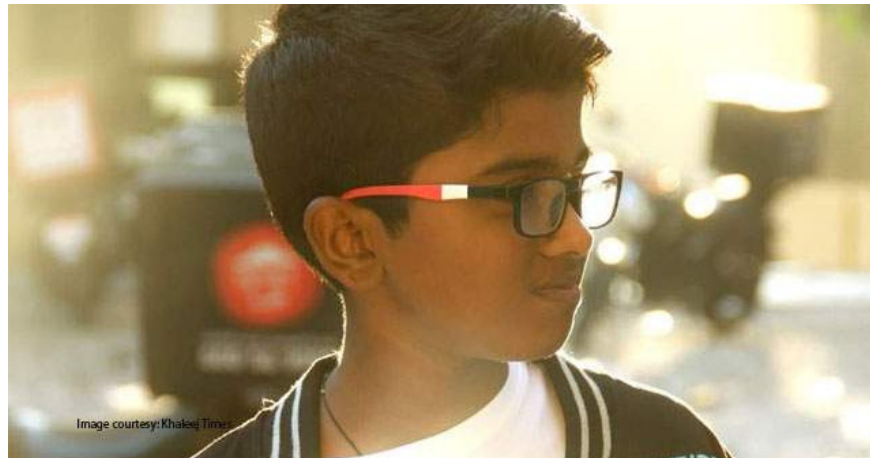


# The 9-year-old boy has created a mobile application and at the age of 13 established his own software development company
