

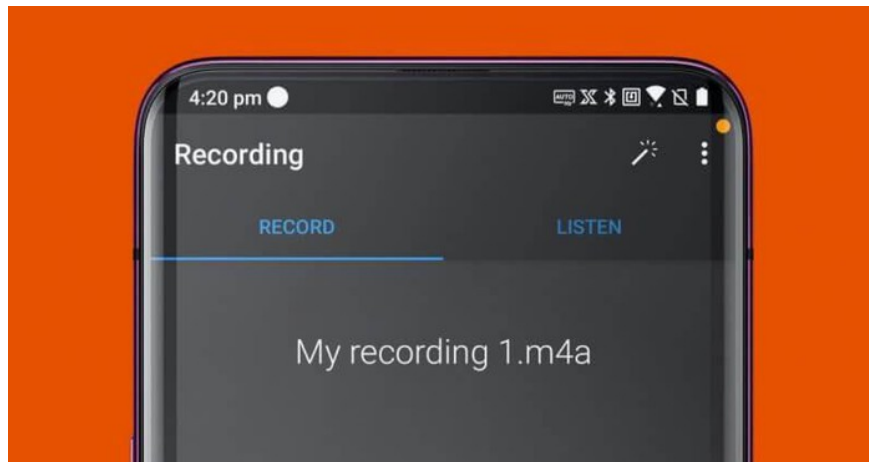
# The application alerts when the camera and microphone are hacked

If you are concerned about leaking photos and private information when using an Android phone, Access Dots will be an application to help limit this situation.

In iOS 14, Apple added a warning feature when an application on the phone uses a camera or microphone. This will help users to avoid being filmed or recorded illegally.

Countless malicious applications have been discovered on Google Play over the years, and Google has worked hard to address these issues, while also giving users greater control over application access. However, that is not enough, if you want better security, Access Dots will be the appropriate choice.

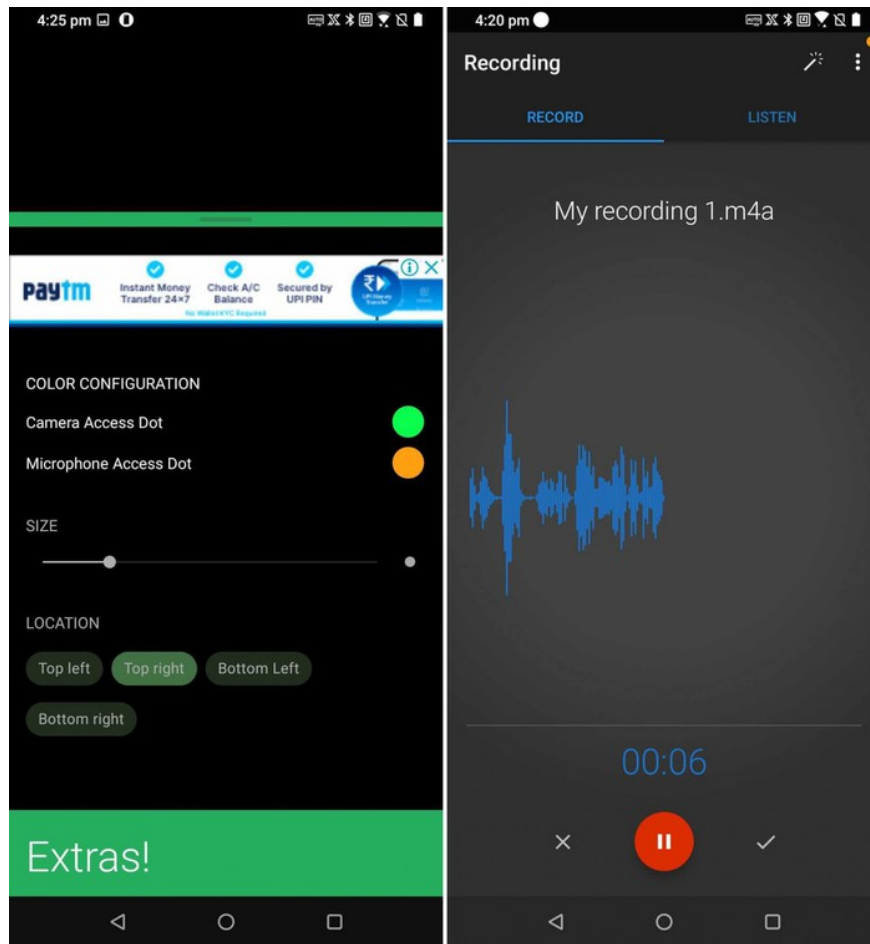
This free application simply displays a dot in the corner of the screen (left or right) to alert you when an application uses the camera or microphone. If a green or orange dot is detected on the phone screen, users should recheck active applications.



*The dot in the corner of the screen will alert users about whether an application is using a microphone or camera.*

According to the test, the application works quite effectively and as described by the developer. However, Access Dots currently only warns but does not specify the name of the application using the camera or microphone, hopefully in the future this feature will be updated.
