Ecobee4 has an Amazon Alexa voice control feature. This is a thermostat that you can theoretically need to touch to set the perfect temperature for the house.

2. Nest Learning Thermostat

Nest is one of the first companies to show why a smart thermostat is so useful. So it is very reasonable to put the third-generation Nest Learning Thermostat on this list.



As its name suggests, Nest Learning Thermostat tracks your habits. When it knows what time of day you go home, when you leave and when you want your home at a certain temperature, it can begin to handle everything for you. After using for a while, you will hardly need to bother about your thermostat anymore.

Nest will even tell you if your heater has a problem. In the middle of winter, this is what you want to know as soon as possible.

3. Nest Thermostat E

The more affordable 'brother' of the Nest Learning Thermostat is the Nest Thermostat E, which still has many similar smart features. When it is discovered that you are out of the house, Nest Thermostat E will automatically turn off, saving you energy and money.



You can control this thermostat from your laptop, tablet or phone, so no matter where you are or what device you use, the thermostat is still at your fingertips. Nest Thermostat E also generates energy reports for you, so you can see how much you save with a few small changes.

4. Mysa Smart Thermostat

You can control this thermostat with iOS or Android device. In addition, it is also compatible with Amazon Alexa, Google Home, Apple HomeKit and even IFTTT.

5. Honeywell Lyric T5

If you are looking for a smart thermostat for your home, but don't want to spend too much money, this might be the best option for you. Honeywell Lyric T5 costs just over \$ 100 (2,300,000VND) but there are many important features you find in other thermostats on this list.



You can control this thermostat by day with flexible schedule of 7 days or by location with location feature. Honeywell Lyric T5 works with Amazon Alexa or Apple HomeKit, allowing it to integrate with other smart home devices. Honeywell Lyric T5 can also automatically determine if your home should be in heating or cooling mode and you don't have to worry about this.
