

The best Portable PC applications of all time (Part 1)

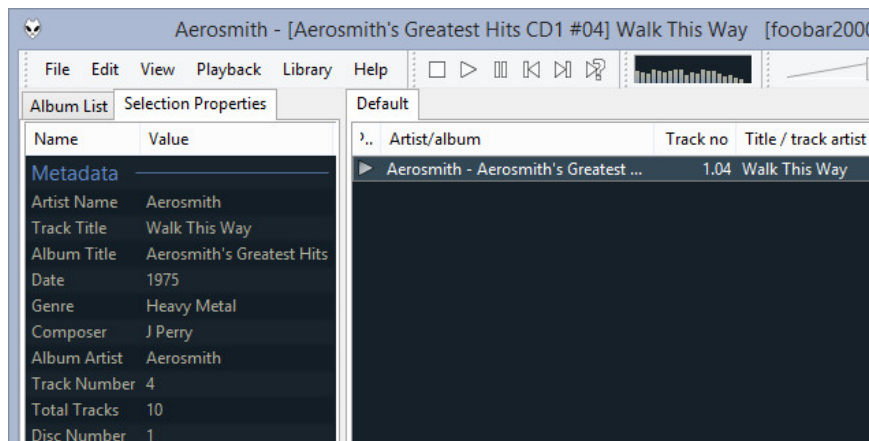
Portable application is a shortened version of the software, can run without installation on the server and does not change computer configuration information. In other words, you can run it, use it and no one will know you used it.

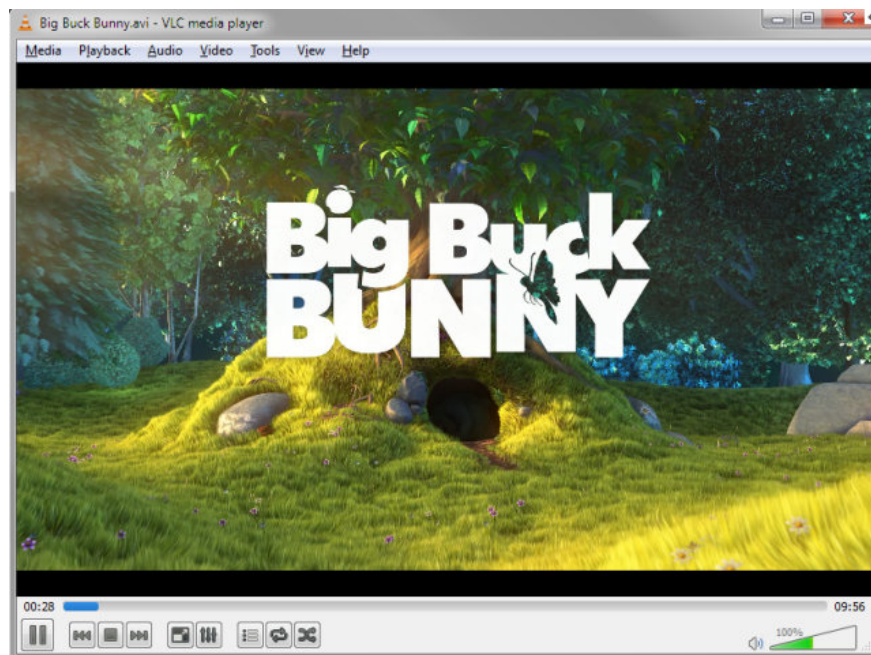
AIMP

VLC Player

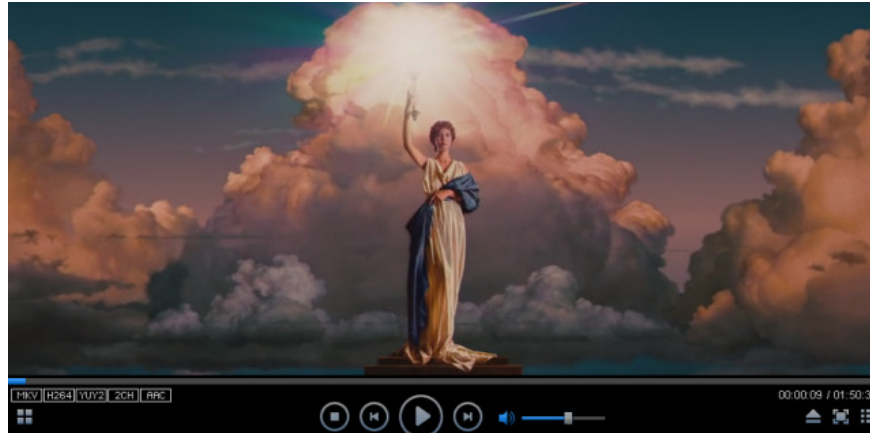

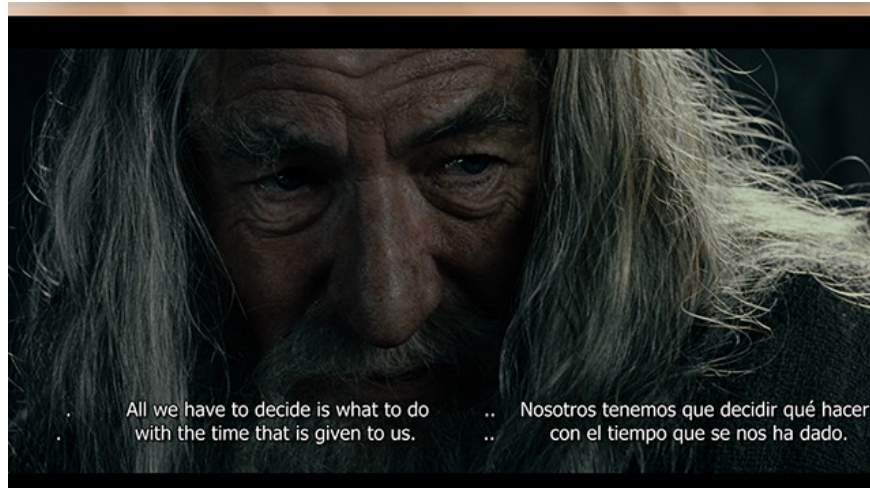
PotPlayer



PotPlayer is a multimedia program with many features, can play hundreds of different video and audio formats without the installed code, as well as streaming media and video DVDs. Other features include the ability to configure subtitles, adjust audio latency and subtitles, filter audio video frequencies, support playlists, etc.

Media Player Classic

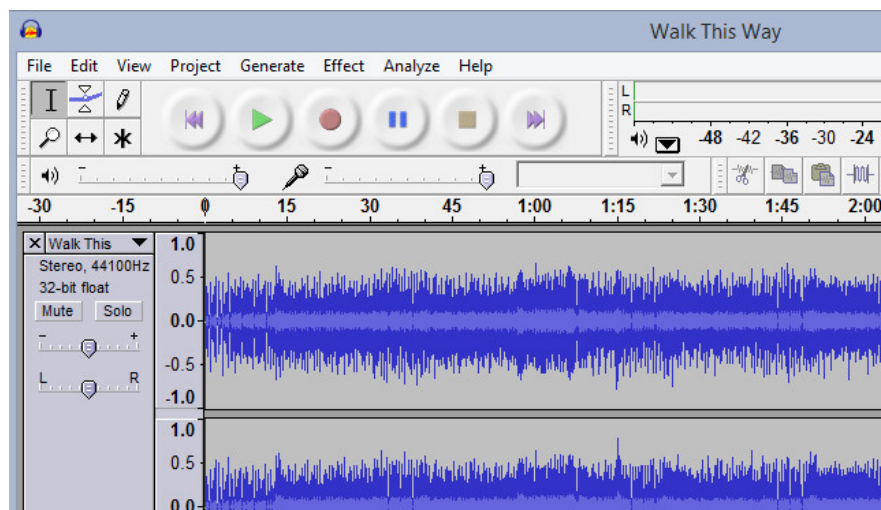

2. Video editing and extracting application

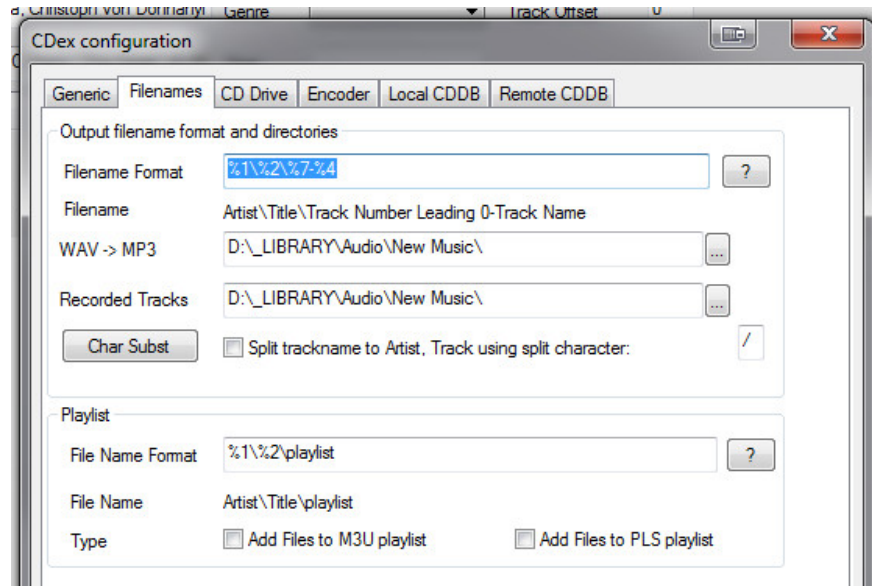
Audacity



If editing audio is what you need, Audacity should be at the top of your list of toolboxes. This is the easiest tool to cut, copy, merge, mix audio, record files directly, change the sound speed and pitch of your recordings and import / export some of the lesser known file formats. come. This is also the best tool for creating ringtones for smartphones as well as other uses that you don't think about.

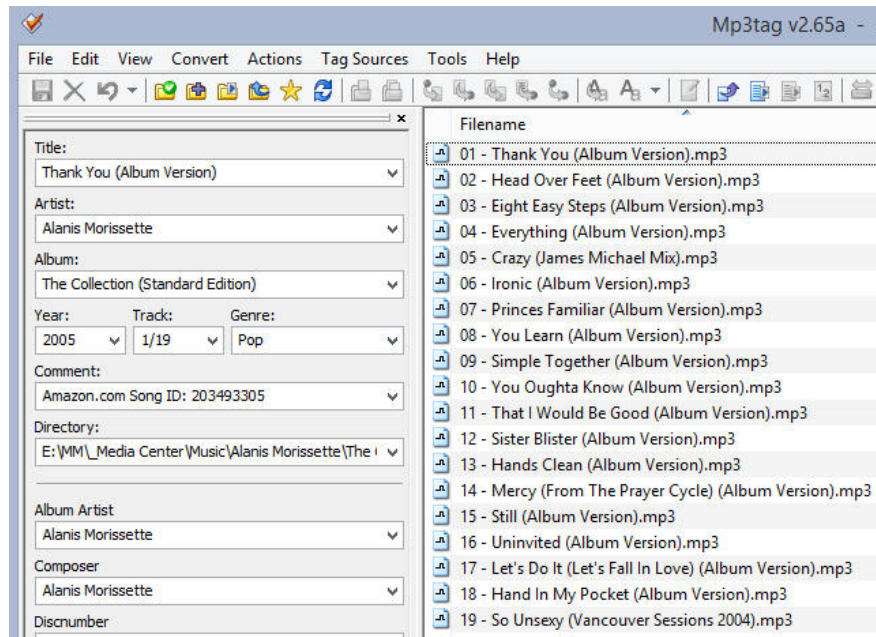
CDex



This is probably the best, easiest and fastest CD ripping app you ever know. It can rip disc into MP3 file format, along with metadata (by connecting to a "remote database"). You can add music to a new playlist and turn off the computer after the extraction process ends.

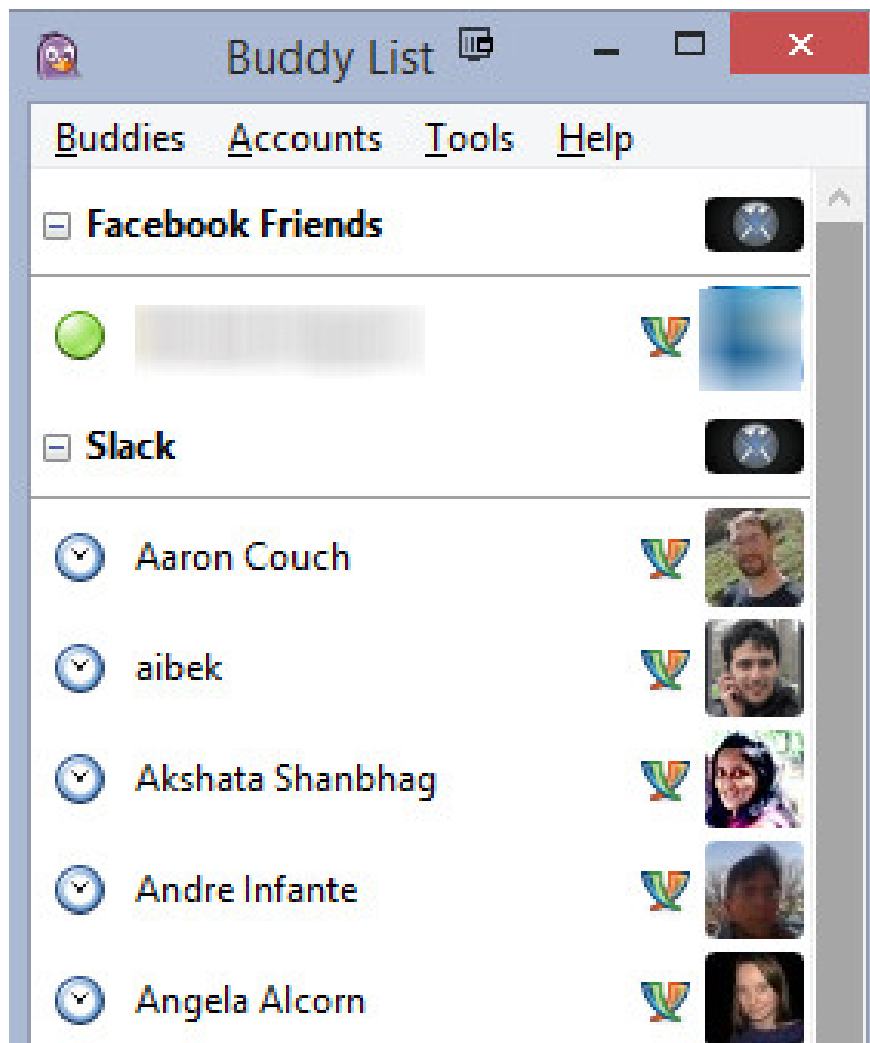


If CDex does not manage metadata for MP3 files, you should consider the Mp3tag editor. Just download the MP3tag related songs, and then you can edit the song title, singer / band, album name, add illustrations and save changes.

3. Chat application, chat

Pidgin

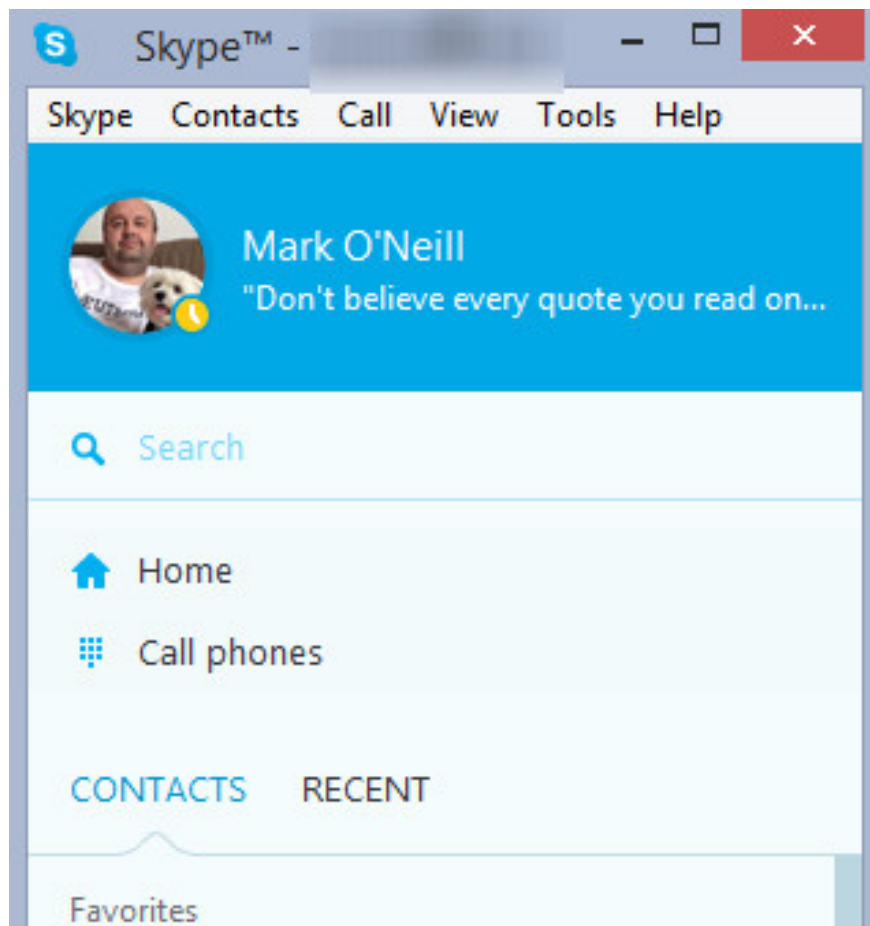


The demand for multi-protocol messaging programs is fuzzy when Google Talk combines with Hangouts and Skype merged with Windows Live Messenger, but there is still room for Pidgin. The XMPP protocol allows you to link accounts like Slack and you still use AIM, ICQ, IRC and Yahoo Messenger if you are one of the "old people" in the Internet community.

Skype

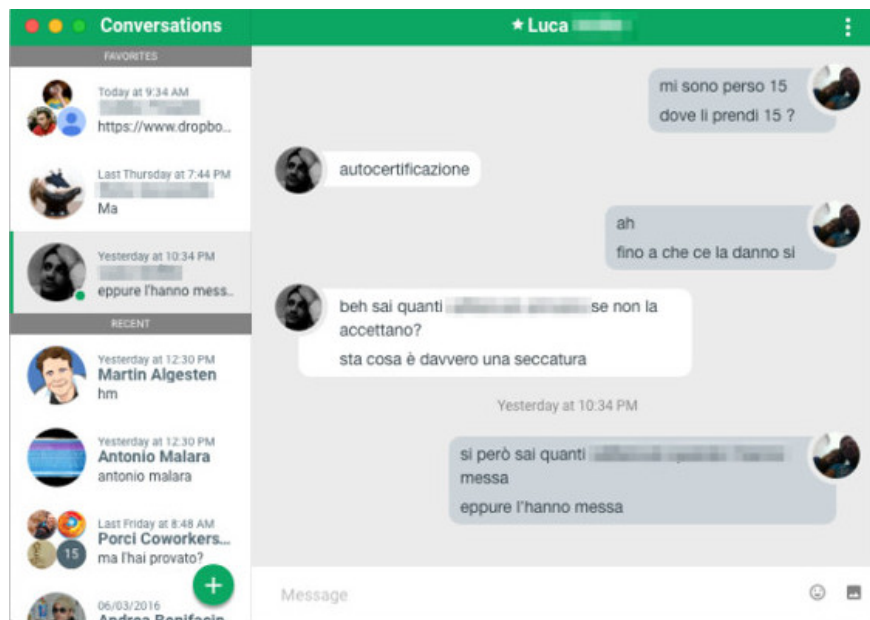


As the 'big dad' of all chat software, messaging, video calling, especially now has been taken care of by Microsoft. Now that Skype is integrated into the TV, you can access the XBox dialog and all Windows Live Messenger accounts via the Skype interface. Make free calls to other Skype users, make calls to landline and mobile phones with "cheap" prices and use Skype to send SMS (requires a credit card).

YakYak



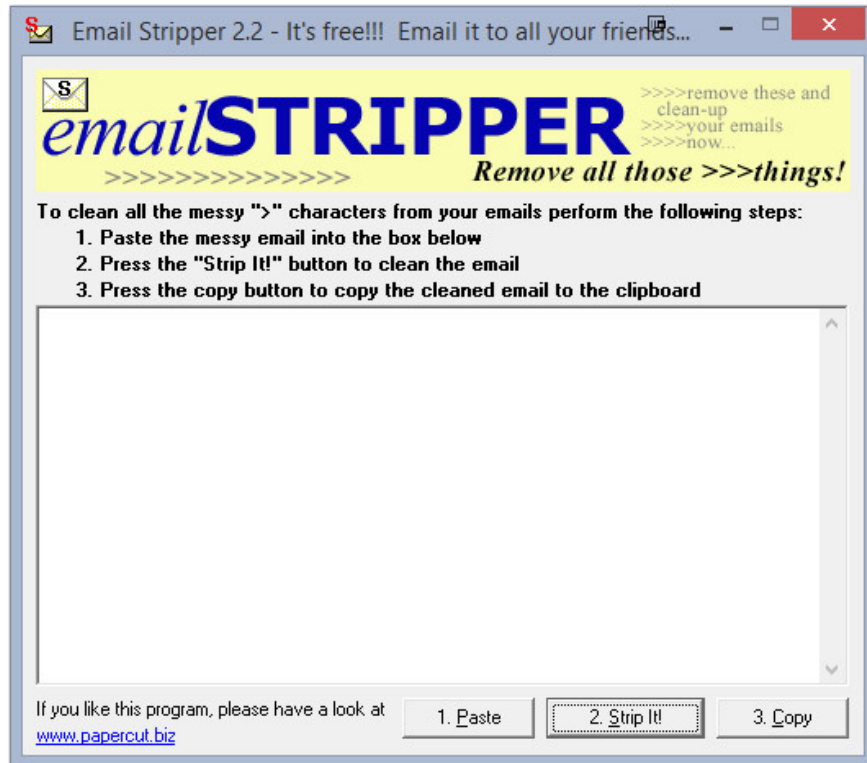
Google Hangouts receives support and criticism, but one of the things that keeps Hangouts is the lack of PC apps. So third developers have developed applications to fill this gap and the best one is probably YakYak (the name sounds terrible), but its software is great. .

It works like any other chat software for PC. Start a conversation, receive messages, receive notifications about new conversations, and send photos. Also integrated audio and video but must be opened on Google Chrome.

If you don't like the theme color, you can change it to blue or black. And this is a portable application, so there's no need to install it. Can this make you use Google Hangout?

A favorite app if you have relatives and friends who like to forward you an email string, with dashes. If you want to delete this email chain neatly and cleanly, then copy the text. When the text is inside the box, press 2. **Strip it!** And you will have a nice and clean text. Press 3. **Copy** to copy that text to the clipboard and ready to assign to a new email.
