Samsung Galaxy S10



Samsung Galaxy S10 is Samsung's strategic smartphone line in 2019 for the high-end segment. Galaxy S10 was officially unveiled at Samsung Unpacked event just before MWC just a few days.

Many of the significant improvements that Samsung has brought to the Galaxy S10, can be mentioned as larger and sharper screens, higher capacity batteries, new chips with more impressive performance, more cameras and both counts. Backward compatible wireless charging.

As mentioned, although it was announced a few days before MWC 2019 officially took place, the Galaxy S10 will still be one of the focal phones, attracting a lot of interest in all the team events. in the framework of the largest mobile exhibition in the world.

Nokia 9 PureView



While most of the smart phones, even in the high-end segment, are only equipped with the rear camera cluster, which includes about 3 sensors, this year, Nokia has made the world to once again mention their names. The Nokia 9 PureView with . 5 sensors for the rear camera cluster, arranged in a honeycomb style, allows users to create images that are "hegemonic" with just a small mobile device.

Considered to be the most powerful smartphone camera system ever, the 5 sensors of Nokia 9 PureView can collect up to 60 megapixels of image data, to create stunning photos with magnitude Extremely good details and dynamic range are also much stronger. Can Nokia 9 PureView lift mobile photography to a new level? Let's wait and see!

Microsoft HoloLens 2



MWC is primarily an event for new phone models to debut, however, that does not mean that other products brought to the event are not noticeable. On February 26, Microsoft officially launched HoloLens 2, the next version of the giant HoloLens product line of the US giant. This new virtual reality headset is still not ready for individual users (it is designed primarily for businesses and works best in an enterprise environment), but Microsoft has also adopted a lot of improvements. advance on HoloLens 2 compared to its predecessor. According to Microsoft, the key to making HoloLens 2's new is the improvements in wearable feel and comfort, helping users to have "real sunken moments" in their own space. HoloLens 2 is sleeker, lighter, easier to wear, feels more comfortable to wear and especially gives a wider view than the first generation HoloLens. Besides, this headset is also cheaper than its predecessor, at \$ 3,500 compared to \$ 5,000 for HoloLens 1.

HoloLens 2 will be sold in major consumer markets such as the United States, Japan, China, Germany, Canada, Ireland, France, Australia and New Zealand later this year.

Huawei Mate X

As a response to the newly launched Galaxy Fold of Samsung, China's largest smartphone maker, the world's second-largest Huawei recently officially launched its first folding smartphone screen called Mate X. .



According to experts, Huawei's Mate X is the best folding phone at MWC this year. Compared to Samsung's Galaxy Fold, Mate X has a larger screen, better design and faster 5G connectivity. In spite of this, Huawei Mate X is a beautiful view of the bright future of folding screen phones, with the ability to work and play comprehensively as well as flexible switching between smartphones and computers. Tablet, bringing extremely high convenience.

The only thing that makes Mate X difficult to be popular (at least this year) is the price of up to \$ 2,600 of this device - a figure that is not pleasant at all. Technology is an expensive 'play'.

Oppo 10x optical zoom



If you have to name the phone manufacturer that is "obsessed" by the optical zoom on mobile camera, that's Oppo. Remember the Chinese tech giant has stunned those attending MWC a few years ago with its 5x super-powerful optical zoom camera system, and this year, the company has returned to the big mobile exhibition. most on the planet to show optical zoom technology even more hegemonic than yours, up to 10x. This is a major breakthrough for cameras on smartphones because it allows users to capture images at a distance and still ensure the image quality. Actual testing shows that this technology certainly allows you to zoom in and out substantially closer to high definition. Of course this 'crazy' optical zoom technology is still being polished a lot through marketing tricks, but even so, this innovative mobile photography technology still deserves recognition. and it is possible to change the face of mobile photography in the future.

Huawei MateBook X Pro (2019)



One of the best notebooks of 2018, and even more "hegemony" in this year's version. In addition to the launch of the cult-pleasing Mate X phone, Huawei has brought the MWC 2019 a noticeable upgrade to its flagship laptop, Huawei MateBook X Pro (2019). This second generation Windows 10 laptop is as thin and light as before, and

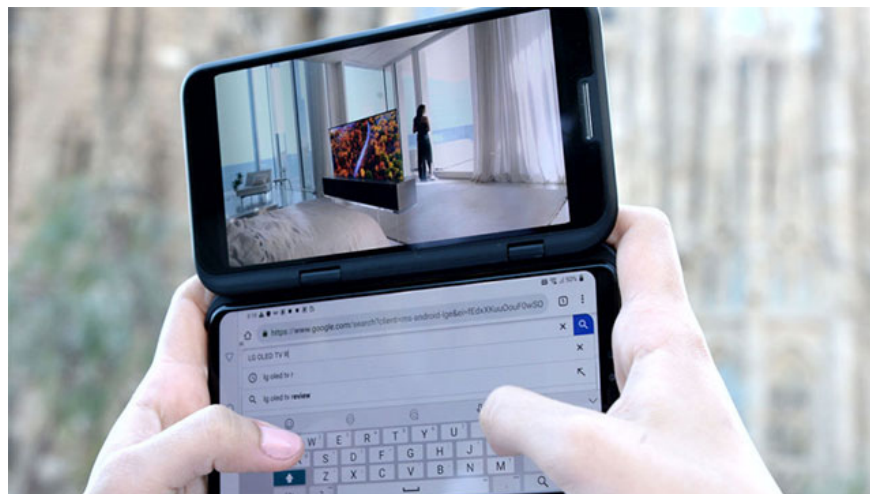

With the faster 8th generation Intel processor, more powerful NVIDIA graphics cards and new features allow for quick exchange of files from Huawei phones with just a tap of the palm, MateBook X Pro promises to once again become one of the best laptops of the year.

Samsung Galaxy S10 5G



5G phones are available in every corner of MWC. However, to choose the best 5G phone at the moment, there is probably no better name than Samsung Galaxy S10 5G. With a huge 6.7 inch screen in the body of a smartphone, carefully groomed rear camera, large capacity battery and finally a 5G connection, the Galaxy S10 5G is really a 'beast' in its cover. LG V50 ThinQ



At a time when everyone has to 'fever' on folding screen phones, another big name in smartphone village LG has decided to go another way by equipping the upcoming 5G flagship. equips with this extra screen is also remarkable. For example, you can slide content from one screen to another by swiping three fingers. This 'modular' design used to not bring much success to LG (LG G5), but the story on V50 ThinQ may be completely different. Let's wait and see.

Sony Xperia 1



Xperia 1 is Sony's best phone in recent years, and has also received a lot of attention by owning the same design as most other phones at MWC. It does not have a 'click hole' in the screen, as well as no 5G connection or foldable. But Xperia 1 has a super-long 4K HDR screen at 21: 9 ratio and 3 cameras on the back. It can be affirmed that Sony Xperia 1 is the most different designed smartphone at MWC this year.

Xiaomi Mi Mix 3 5G



If you think you'll have to spend at least \$ 1,000 on a 5G phone, you're wrong. Xiaomi's Mi Mix 3 5G is one of the few 5G phones announced at MWC that has an extremely affordable price: Only about \$ 680 - right under the manufacturer's "good, good, cheap" tradition China. This device is an improved version of Mi Mix 3 and has been upgraded from the original Snapdragon 845 chip to a stronger Snapdragon 855. In addition, design and appearance will not change much.
