He has a cognitive disorder, and can have 40 seizures a day as a result of the disorder. Tres was born with a large face gap, eyes away from each other, two separate nostrils, irregularly shaped heads, impaired cognition and continuous seizures.



Not only that, this boy also underwent reshaping the skull to reduce pressure on the brain.

According to reports from doctors, the boy was diagnosed with 14 different deformed manifestations, called diprosopus, cranial transcription, Greek called double-face skull.

According to his parents, Tres Johnson had 400 seizures every day and now reduced to 40 when his mother began to use marijuana to regulate seizures.

Brandy and Joshua's parents stated that because their child's condition was so rare, many medical professionals considered him an intensive researcher to save his life for a long time in the future.

The hope and the relentless efforts of doctors and scientists have helped the boy to reach the age of 13 as it is today.
