The EasyPC E790 Netbook has a large 7-inch 65K color TFT screen, 800 x 480 pixel resolution, uses Samsung 400 MHz / 533 MHz processor, 128 MB RAM memory, 2 GB internal memory, support for storage over SD memory card with a maximum capacity of 32 GB.

The device is equivalent to a notebook with dimensions of 213.5 x 145 x 32 mm, but fully integrated 3 USB ports, memory card slot, 3.5mm headphone jack, speakers and LAN port Wi-Fi 802.11b / g connection.

EasyPC E790 main feature is web surfing, support for watching YouTube videos, also capable of watching DivX video format. With a 3 cell 4,000 mAh battery, surfing the web and watching videos on the EasyPC E790 is about 10 hours continuously.



Currently the device is preinstalled with Microsoft Windows CE 5.0 operating system but with the above configuration EasyPC E790 can run well Google Android. According to Engadget, it is likely that this netbook will be upgraded and run the Android operating system when sold next month.
