

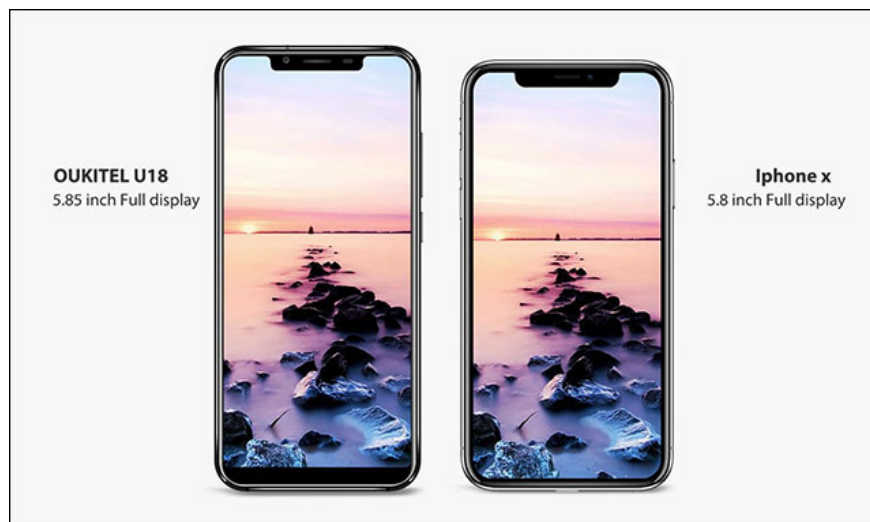
The copy of the iPhone X costs only \$ 159, the battery is super terrible

The phone runs 4.000mAh battery, no surprise if you know Oukitel because last year they also released a 10,000mAh K10000 Pro battery. Here are some other parameters:

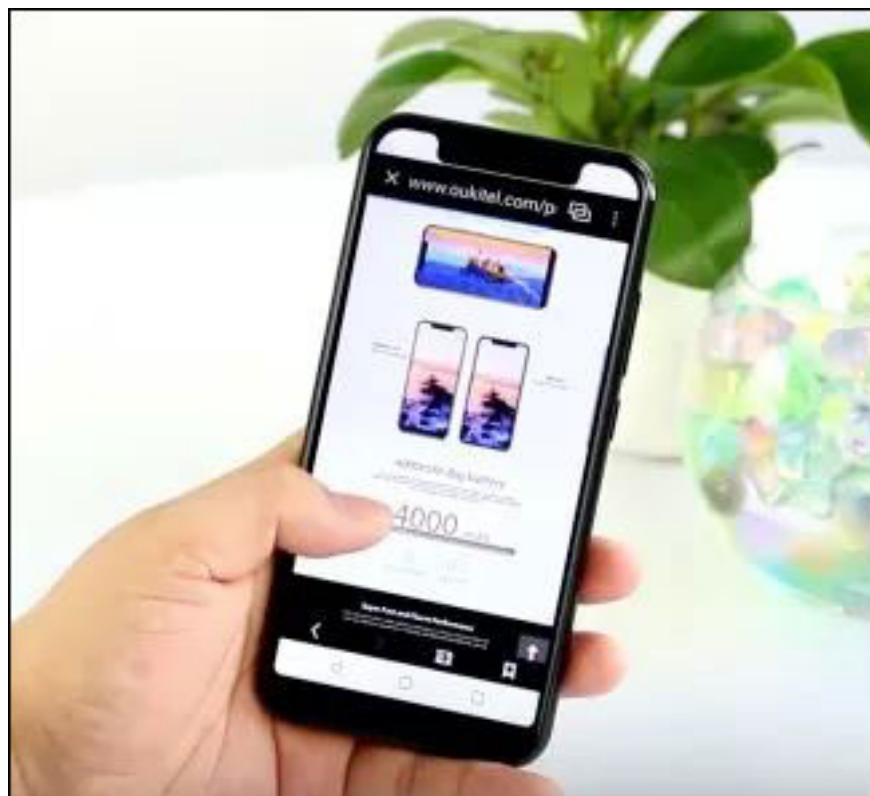
1. 5.8-inch screen, 21: 9 aspect ratio 720p resolution.
2. 4GB RAM and 64GB memory.
3. USB-C.
4. Android 7.0.
5. Fingerprint sensor behind the device.
6. 16 megapixel rear camera and 5 megapixel rear camera.
7. 13 megapixel front camera.
8. MediaTek MT6750T processor.
