The Dell OptiPlex 7070 Ultra is the first all-in-one PC with a modular design and can be upgraded. The tiny size machine, shaped like a long wooden stick, can slide into the back of the screen stand.

The OptiPlex 7070 Ultra weighs only 1.43 pounds and measures 10.09 x 3.78 x 0.78 inches.

The OptiPlex 7070 Ultra will go on sale for about 749USD (its total value depends on what components you buy with it) on September 24th.



When choosing to buy this tiny PC at the same time, you will have to choose a base that fits it. Fixed or adjustable feet are the best option, plus a VESA mount to attach it to the back of any VESA-compliant display on the market. The price of these components has not been disclosed.



Of course, the tiny PC will need one (or up to 3) screens, mice, and keyboards.
